YESTERDAY IN ANAHEIM . BOX SCORE . PLAY-BY-PLAY

The Padres fell 2-0 last night to the Angels, splitting the brief 2-game set in Anaheim...Starter **Mike Clevinger** made his Padres debut and pitched 6.0 innings and allowed 2 runs (earned) on 7 hits with 2 strikeouts and 1 walk.

 No Padre reached 3B last night, and the team was shut out for the 2nd time this season (also Aug. 12 @ LAD).

ROSTER MOVES Today, the Padres placed RHP **Luis Perdomo** on the 10-Day IL with a right forearm inflammtion, transferred LHP **José Castillo** to the 45-Day IL and selected the contract of 21-year-old catcher **Luis Campusano** (#21) from the Alternate Training Site.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW C Luis Campusano's 1st apperance will be his MLB debut...his highest level of play is Single-A Lake Elsinore in 2019 (where he won the California League batting crown and was named the League's Co-MVP)...he'll be the 5th Padre in 2020 to make his MLB debut, and he'll be the Major League-leading 6th Padre who is 21-or-younger to make his MLB debut since the start of the 2019 season (joining Fernando Tatis Jr., Josh Naylor, Andres Muñoz, Adrian Morejon, and Luis Patiño).

VS. OAKLAND The Padres are playing the A's for the 1st time since July 4, 2018 in Oakland...SD has lost their last 4 games vs. the A's with their last win against them coming on June 18, 2015 @ OAK...San Diego is 4-11 all-time against the A's on the road.

THE SWINGIN' FRIARS Despite going scoreless last night, the Padres lead MLB in runs scored (222), runs per game (5.69), RBI (215), XBH (141) and OPS (.837) and SLG (.484)...Rank 2nd in HR with 69 (LAD's 70).

STATCASTED As a team, SD batters lead the Majors in exit velocity (89.9 mph), and they rank 2nd in hard hit ball (95+ mph) with 415 (behind LAD's 432).

EXTRA EXTRA READ ALL ABOUT IT Yesterday @ LAA, the Padres snapped their streak of having at least 1 XBH in 46 straight games since September 21, 2019, tying for the 9th-longest XBH streak in franchise history...San Diego's 141 extra-base hits this year lead all of baseball.

BOUNCE BACK The Padres were shut out last night for the 2nd time this season, but in games following losses, San Diego leads MLB in AVG (.285), OBP (.356), SLG (.552) and OPS (.908).

SWING-AND-MISS % Padres batters have a National League best 23.2 swing-and-miss percentage, ranking behind Houston (22.7) for the best in MLB.

COMPARE AND CONTRAST In the Padres 1st 23 games to start the 2020 campaign, they went 11-12 for a .478 winning %, scored 4.65 runs per game, had a 23.5 strikeout percentage, and hit .229...in their 16 games since, San Diego has gone 12-4 for a .750 winning %, scored a MLB-leading 7.19 r/g, had the lowest SO percentage in MLB (18.4%) and had a MLB-leading .307 AVG.

FOR STARTERS San Diego starters have worked 6.0+ innings in 3 of the last 4 games...**Zach Davies** has worked at least 5.0 innings in each of his 7 starts entering tonight's game, including a career-high-tying 8.0 IP on Aug. 22 vs. HOU....the Padres are 17-11 when their starters go at least 5.0, and in those 28 games this year, starters have a 2.98 ERA.

WHAT A RELIEF The Padres have won 12 of their last 16 games, and in that time, SD relievers have claimed 8 of those wins, posting a 3.00 ERA since August 17 (had a 6.48 bullpen ERA in their 1st 23 games)...the SD bullpen hasn't allowed a single HR in 12 straight since Aug. 20.

STAY HOT Davies aims for his 4th consecutive win tonight vs. the Oakland A's in what will be his 2nd career start vs. OAK...his lone start vs. the A's came on June 7, 2016 while with MIL, tossing 7.0 innings of 2-hit, 2-run ball in MIL's 5-4 victory.

MLB Debut

- A winning decision tonight would match the career-high 4 decisions he won in 4 straight outings from June 25-July 14, 2017.
- ▶ He's the 1st Padre this season to earn the win in 3 straight outings, and only 17 other pitchers this season have earned the win in at least 3 consecutive outings this year...a win tonight would match the 4 that CWS Dylan Cease and LAD Clayton Kershaw have won, behind only MIN Randy Dobnak's 5 and CHC Yu Darvish's 6.

SUPPORTIVE SQUAD Davies tossed a career-high-tying 8.0 innings (3x) in SD's 13-2 victory Aug. 22 vs. HOU, his first 8.0 inning effort since June 2, 2019 @ PIT...the 7 strikeouts were his most since also striking out 7 on July 23, 2019 vs. CIN.

- Davies received all 13 runs of support in the victory, marking the most a Padres hurler has received since Cal Quantrill got 14 runs of support on May 25 last season @ Toronto.
- It was T-3rd most runs of support a Padres starter has gotten in a single outing since the 2015 season... Odrisamer Despaigne got 14 runs of support on April 20, 2015 @ COL and Tyson Ross also got 13 runs of support on August 3, 2015 @ MIL.
- So far in 2020, his 8.06 run support average is the highest among all qualifying NL pitchers and 2nd-highest among all ML starting pitchers, trailing only HOU Frember Valdez (8.34).

LET'S TALK RANKINGS Among all qualifying ML pitchers, Davies currently ranks T-4th in wins (5), T-6th in WHIP (0.90), 9th in opponent OPS (.552), 12th in BB/9 (1.96), T-12th in opponent AVG (.189) and 14th in ERA (2.61).

WHY CHANGE WHAT'S WORKING? Among all ML pitchers who have thrown at least 500 total pitches on the season, Davies' 40.7 percent change up usage is the highest rate in baseball...opposing hitters have posted a .176 AVG against the pitch and it has produced a 36.1 whiff %.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME Davies has posted a 3.25 ERA on the road compared to a 1.32 ERA at Petco Park...his 1.32 mark at home is 9th-best ERA among all ML pitchers who have made at least 2 starts in their home park.

SPEAKING OF PETCO Davies has now made 6 career starts at Petco Park...he is 5-0 with a 2.83 ERA (11 ER, 35.0 IP) at the friendly confines of Petco.

Among all pitchers who have made at least 6 career starts in Petco Park, he joins Jason Jennings as the only 2 pitchers with a 1.000 winning %...his 2.83 ERA at Petco ranks 24th.

▶ Dinelson Lamet joins Davies in the group, making the Padres the only team to have 2 different starting pitchers with a sub-.200 opponent AVG and sub-1.00 WHIP.

CUTTING THE CHEESE Davies' cutter has 5.9 inches of vertical movement so far in 2020, which is T-3rd most movement of any cutter in the majors (min. 50 occurrences).

HE'S ZACH, AND HE'S RELIABLE Since 2017, Davies ranks in the top 25 among all National League pitchers in wins (34, T-12th), ERA (3.79, T-13th), and starts (84, T-18th).
