LAST NIGHT IN OAKLAND • BOX SCORE • PLAY-BY-PLAY

The Padres claimed Game 1 of the series last night against the A's, shutting them out 7-0 (SD's 3rd shutout of 2020 and the 2nd time OAK had been shutout)...starter **Zach Davies** (now 6-2) worked 7.0 innings of scoreless ball, allowing 4 hits on 4 walks with 5 strikeouts...Davies' 2.23 ERA is the 8th-lowest in the Majors this season, and his 6 wins tie for 2nd most.

- ▶ In his MLB debut, **Luis Campusano** homered for his 1st hit in the 8th inning, and the Padres also saw HRs from **Fernando Tatis Jr.** and **Manny Machado**...the duo hit back-to-back HRs last night for the 3rd time this year (SD's 5th back-to-back overall).
- ▶ After not advancing a runner past 2B on Thursday @ LAA, the Padres went 4-for-10 last night with RISP.
- ▶ The Padres are 12-2 in series openers and 7-1 in series openers on the road.

STARTING OFF WITH A BANG **Luis Campusano** made his MLB debut last night, hitting an opposite-field HR in the 8th for his 1st big league hit, becoming the 15th Padre in team history to have his 1st-career hit go for a home run (first since **Patrick Kivlehan** in 2016).

1ST, 2ND & 3RD TIME THROUGH The 1st time facing the opposing starter, the Padres have hit .253, the 2nd time through they've hit .270 and the 3rd time through they've hit .315.

ROLLIN' ROLLIN' ROLLIN' The Padres have won 4 of their last 5 games and 13 of their last 17 games since Aug. 17...their .765 winning percentage in that time ties for the 3rd-best in baseball... San Diego's 24 wins on the season are 2nd-most in the National League behind LAD's 30.

FOR THE SERIES The Padres won last night against Oakland for the 1st time since June 18, 2015 @ OAK...the Friars are looking for their 1st series win vs. the A's since they took 2 of 3 from June 27-29, 2006 in SD and their 1st ever series win @ OAK.

CHECK THE LEADERBOARD The Padres lead MLB in OPS (.826), SLG (.487), runs scored (229), runs per game (5.73), RBI (222) and total bases (653)...Rank T-1st in XBH (147) and 2nd in HR with 72 (LAD's 75).

HISTORIC Shortstop **Fernando Tatis Jr.** has hit 14 homers through the Padres 1st 40 games, tying with Albert Pujols (in 2001) for the 2nd-most HR in a team's 1st 40 G of any player who is 21-or-younger (in the Modern Era, since 1900)...Eddie Matthews has the most with 15 in 1953... Tatis also has 41 runs scored, and he's the 1st player with as many homers and runs scored through the 1st 40 games of a season since Lance Berkman in 2008 (14 HR, 43 R).

FOR STARTERS Padres starters have a 1.46 ERA in the 7 games this roadtrip with 2 HR allowed and 34 SO against 9 walks...SD starters have worked 6.0+ IP in 4 of the last 5 games, and the Padres are 18-11 when their starters go at least 5.0.

2 OUT RBI The Padres have logged 101 2-out RBI this season, leading all of MLB...the next most are the Dodgers' 88 2-out RBI.

BACK ON TRACK 24-year-old Chris Paddack got back in the win column last Sunday at Coors Field, allowing no earned runs across 6.0 innings behind a season-high punchouts in SD's 13-2 victory.

- ▶ It was the 1st time he's allowed zero earned runs and no home runs since his Opening Day start vs. ARI on July 24.
- ▶ He began the season 2-0 with a 2.65 ERA through his 1st 3 starts, and is now 1-3 with a 5.61 ERA through his last 5 starts.
- ▶ A winning decision today would mark just the 2nd time in his career he has earned a win in 2 straight starts... won 3 straight from April 24-May 6, 2019.

NOTHING EASY Has posted 42 strikeouts to 8 walks for a 4.86 SO/BB ratio...among all ML pitchers who have made at least 7 starts with 35.0 IP the 5.25 SO/BB ratio ranks 11th in the majors and 5th in the NL.

- ▶ Dinelson Lamet's 3.80 ratio ranks 22nd, making the Padres 1 of only 4 staffs (also: CHC, CIN and CLE) in the majors with multiple starters in the top 25 in SO/BB ratio (min 7 starts, 35.0 IP).
- ▶ None of his free passes have come vs. right-handed batters...he has faced the most right-handed batters (75) in the majors in without issuing a walk, ahead of Kenta Maeda's 61.

WHEN IT MATTERS MOST With no runners on base, opponents are hitting .283 (28-99) against Paddack...but when runners do get on base, he is limiting the opposition to a .227 clip (15-66)...with RISP/2 out, opponents are hitting .231 (3-13).

3RD TIME THROUGH Has faced 34 hitters on his 3rd time through a line up, and the opposition is hitting 10-33 (.303) with 1 walk.

- ▶ The 1st time through, opponents are hitting .288 (19-66) and the 2nd time through they are hitting .212 (14-66)/

2-2? 3-2? NO PROBLEM After a 2-2 count, he's limiting the opposition to a .100 clip (4-40)...on full counts, opposing hitters are 2-15 (.133).

THE HOME RUN CONUNDRUM His 10 HR allowed are tied with 3 others for the 4th-most in the majors.

- ▶ 3 of his 10 home runs allowed in 2020 have come on the 1st pitch, while 3 have also come with 2 strikes.
- ▶ In 2019, 2 home runs came on the 1st pitch and 10 came with 2 strikes, including 3 on an 0-1 count and 4 on 0-2 counts.

LET'S GET CURVEY His curveball has an average vertical movement of 5.5 inches, the 3rd-highest movement on a curveball among Padres pitchers...teammate Garrett Richards curveball ranks 1st in the majors in average vertical movement (11.1 inches).

FIRST THINGS FIRST His 71.4 1st pitch strike % in 2019 led the majors (min. 140.0 IP), ahead of Max Scherzer (70.4), Madison Bumgarner (69.5) and Masahiro Tanaka (68.7).

- ▶ Through his 1st 8 starts in 2020, he has a 64.2 1st pitch strike %.

OPENING DAY NOD Paddack took the mound for his 1st career Opening Day start on July 24 at Petco Park vs. ARI, tossing 6.0-shutout innings of 4-hit ball in SD's 7-2 victory.

- ▶ With former Padre rookie left-hander **Eric Lauer** getting the Opening Day nod last season, it became just the 2nd time in 100 years of a team starting either a rookie or a 2nd-year pitcher on opening day in back-to-back seasons (also the 1996-7 Royals with **Catfish Hunter** in '96 and **Jim Nash** in '97).

- ▶ Has allowed zero earned runs in 9 of his 14 outings this year, allowing just 5 hits, 2 walks (.156 AVG) and 11 SO in those outings...has posted a 24.55 ERA (10 ER, 3.2 IP) and a .421 opponent AVG in the other 5 appearances.
- ▶ Has retired the 1st batter in 11 of his 14 outings this season (.214 AVG).
- ▶ The opposition is hitting .207 (6-29) with no runners on base, but opponents are hitting .318 (7-22) with runners on and .333 (6-18) with RISP.
- ▶ Relies on 3 pitches: slider (51.3%), four seamer (47.4%) and changeup (1.3%)...has an overall 34.6 whiff % this year, which ranks in the 87th percentile among all ML pitchers.

- ▶ Among all ML pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sinkers, four-seamers or two-seamers, the 98.4 average mph on his sinker is tied with Jacob deGrom's 4-seamer for the 2nd-highest average velocity in the majors, behind only Brusdar Graterol's sinker (99.1 mph).
- ▶ His 101.7 mph sinker (a ball to Christian Walker on August 8 vs. ARI) is the 4th-hardest thrown pitch in the majors this season.
- ▶ His .417 opponent AVG is the 3rd-highest among all ML pitchers (min. 40 batters faced), trailing only KC Matt Harvey (.462) and BOS Kyle Hart.
- ▶ Relies on 4 pitches: sinker (68.1%), slider (27.2%), changeup (4.3%) and four-seamer (0.4%).
