YESTERDAY IN OAKLAND ▪ BOX SCORE ▪ PLAY-BY-PLAY

The Padres fell 8-4 yesterday afternoon to the Oakland Athletics, forcing today's rubber match...both teams collected 11 hits, and the Padres saw a double and a home run from C **Austin Nola** (his 1st homer as a Padre and his 1st HR since Aug. 24 @ SD), and both **Wil Myers** and **Fernando Tatis Jr.** added doubles of their own.

- ▶ Starter **Chris Paddack** worked 4.2 innings and was saddled with the loss, allowing 4 runs (earned) on 7 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts.
- ▶ The Padres bullpen allowed 4 earned runs for the 1st time in 9 games, and **Luis Patiño's** homer allowed marked the 1st HR the bullpen had given up in 13 games (since August 20 vs. TEX).

WINNIN' San Diego's 24 wins on the season are 2nd-most in the National League behind LAD's 30...The Padres have won 4 of their last 6 games and 13 of their last 18 games since Aug. 17.

CUE THE RUBBER MATCH Padres are 2-3 in rubber games this year, and they look to take their 8th series overall and 4th series on the road with a win today...the Friars are looking for their 1st series win vs. the A's since they took 2 of 3 from June 27-29, 2006 in SD and their 1st ever series win @ OAK.

CHECK THE LEADERBOARD The Padres lead the Majors with a .957 OPS with RISP this season, and they also have a National League-leading 100 hits with RISP...overall, the Padres lead all of baseball in runs scored (233), RBI (226), OPS (.825), runs per game (5.68), and total bases (670)...Rank T-1st in XBH (151) and 2nd in HR with 73 (LAD's 75).

WAR WHAT IS IT GOOD FOR? The Padres have a collective 9.6 WAR per FanGraphs, which is the highest of any team this season...**Fernando Tatis Jr.'s** 2.8 WAR this year also leads MLB, and **Jake Cronenworth's** 1.3 WAR leads all National League rookies.

STRIKE THROWERS San Diego hurlers lead the Majors in 1st-pitch strike percentage (63.4).

FOR STARTERS The San Diego rotation has the 6th-best ERA in the Majors (3.68), their 198 strikeouts tie for 4th most, their 25 home runs allowed tie for 4th fewest, and they have the 8th-lowest opponent OPS (.693).

1ST, 2ND & 3RD TIME THROUGH The 1st time facing the opposing starter, the Padres have hit .256, the 2nd time through they've hit .265 and the 3rd time through they've hit .313.

UP NEXT The Padres will face the Rockies at Petco Park for a 3-game set following today's game, and as a team, San Diego has slashed .309/.351/.531 against their mountainous foe in 2020 with 47 runs scored, 46 RBI, and 79 hits, all of which are the Padres most against any 1 team this year...it's SD's 1st matchup vs. COL at home this year, having gone 4-3 @ Coors Field, and in their last 4-game series @ Coors Field, Padres pitchers posted a 1.02 ERA (4 ER, 35.1 IP) with 1 HR allowed...it was the lowest ERA of any team @ Coors (including the Rockies) in any 4-game series (since '95)...in the 4 G, SD also hit .368/.401/.599 with 11 2B, 3 3B, 6 HR and 32 RBI.

SHORT MEMORY, SHORT REST After tossing just a combined 2.2 innings in his previous 2 stats on Aug. 21 vs. HOU and Aug. 27 vs. SEA, Richards allowed just 1 hit across 3.2 innings in SD's 6-0 victory last Monday at Coors Field.

- ▶ It marked just his 2nd career start vs. the Rockies and at Coors Field, with both of those outings coming this season...he is now 0-0 with a combined 3.86 ERA (4 ER, 9.1 IP) with 10 SO and 1 BB vs. the Rockies at Coors Field
- ▶ It was just the 3rd time in his career he's made a start on 4 days of rest-or-fewer...in such starts, he has now posted a combined 1.84 ERA (3 ER, 14.2 IP) while going 0-1.

SPIN CITY Richards' curveball has an average spin rate of 3,339 RPM, the highest spin rate of any pitch this season, ahead of CIN Lucas Sims curveball (3,339 RPM).

- ▶ His curveball this season has an average vertical movement of 11.2 inches, tied for the most movement of any pitcher's curveball (min. 30 occurrences).

SNEAKY HEAT The velocity on his four-seamer ranks in the 82nd percentile (95.1 mph)...among all ML pitchers who have thrown at least 100 four-seam fastballs, his 2,616 average spin rate ranks 5th and is in the 97th percentile.

LIKING THIS NL STUFF Now has a 2.36 ERA (34 ER, 129.2 IP) and a .217 opponent AVG in 28 career appearances (21 starts) against National League opponents.

- ▶ Since 2011, when Richards made his 1st career start vs. an NL opponent, his 2.36 ERA vs. the NL ranks 2nd among all ML pitchers who have made at least 15 starts across 100.0+ IP, behind only Clayton Kershaw (2.25 in 236 starts).
- ▶ His 2.55 ERA vs. the NL West since 2011 ranks 6th among all ML pitchers (min. 70 IP, 10+ starts).

NOT TOO SHABBY IN THE AL, EITHER Has made 153 appearances (105 starts) vs. American League opponents, and is 40-37 with a 3.89 ERA (285 ER, 658.2 IP).

FINAL TUNE UP Richards took the mound for the Padres 1st of 2 exhibition games on July 20 against his former club, the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim. He allowed 1 unearned run across 5 hits and 1 walk while striking out 5 in the Padres' 1-0 defeat.

ALL HAIL, KING RICHARDS! Made his Padre debut and his 1st-career appearance in a non-Angels uniform on September 16, 2019 at MIL, working 3.2 IP of 3-run ball in SD's 5-1 loss. The start marked his return from Tommy John surgery, which he underwent in July 2018 (Dr. Neal ElAttrache).

RESULTS From 2014 through 2018, Richards posted the 3rd-lowest ERA (3.15) among all qualifying AL starters behind Corey Kluber (2.85) and Chris Sale (2.85). He also ranked 3rd in opponents average (.220) over that time frame, trailing Sale (.213) and Blake Snell (.218).

NO LONG BALLS HERE Among all American League pitchers from 2011-18 (min. 700.0 IP), Richards allowed the 2nd-fewest HR per 9.0 IP (0.75), trailing only Justin Masterson's 0.64 ratio.

BRINGING THE CHEDDAR Finished tied for 3rd among all AL starters in 2018 in average fastball velocity (95.8 MPH) with Blake Snell, trailing only Luis Severino (97.6 and Gerritt Cole (96.5).

- ▶ Has allowed zero earned runs in 9 of his 14 outings this year, allowing just 5 hits, 2 walks (.156 AVG) and 11 SO in those outings...has posted a 24.55 ERA (10 ER, 3.2 IP) and a .421 opponent AVG in the other 5 appearances.
- ▶ Has retired the 1st batter in 11 of his 14 outings this season (.214 AVG).
- ▶ The opposition is hitting .207 (6-29) with no runners on base, but opponents are hitting .318 (7-22) with runners on and .333 (6-18) with RISP.

- ▶ Among all ML pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sinkers, four-seamers or two-seamers, the 98.4 average mph on his sinker is tied with Jacob deGrom's 4-seamer for the 2nd-highest average velocity in the majors, behind only Brusdar Graterol's sinker (99.1 mph).
