### TODAY'S MEDIA SCHEDULE

Astros pregame availabilities will be from 2:30-3:30 p.m. CT with **Dusty Baker** at approx. 2:30 p.m. CT.

**LET'S PLAY TWO:** The Astros and A's, the top two teams in the AL West, will play their second double-header against each other this season with today's Game 1 beginning at 5:10 p.m. CT...carrying a five-game losing streak into today's games, the Astros will look to rebound behind **RHP Zack Greinke** in Game 1 and will likely go with a bullpen game in Game 2.

**BREGMAN'S BACK:** The Astros have activated **3B Alex Bregman** from the 10-day IL today...he will serve as the club's 29th player for today's doubleheader.

TODAY'S DOUBLEHEADER: Today's double-header will feature two 7.0-inning contests with the Astros serving as the home team in Game 1...the day game is a makeup of a scheduled game on Aug. 30 at Minute Maid Park, which was postponed following a positive COVID-19 test by a member of the A's traveling party...the Astros and A's also played a doubleheader earlier this season on Aug. 29 in Houston, a sweep by the Astros in a pair of close contests.

ASTROS DOUBLEHEADER HISTORY: Today will be the Astros 18th doubleheader since 2000, when Minute Maid Park opened, and their fourth this season...overall, the club has played 262 doubleheaders in it's franchise history...the Astros have had all three results in their three doubleheaders this season, a sweep (Aug. 29 vs. OAK), a split (Aug. 25 vs. LAA) and a loss (Sept. 5 at LAA)...prior to this season, the last time the Astros had four doubleheaders in a single year was back in 1985, when they played five.

HIRED GUN: RHP Zack Greinke has been with the Astros for 13 months since his acquisition, making 18 starts and posting a remarkable 11-1 record with a 2.97 ERA (36ER/109IP)...Greinke has tied the club record for most wins within a pitcher's first 12 decisions with the team (source: Elias Sports Bureau)...should he win today, he's be the first pitcher in club history to start his Astros career 12-1.

**DAUNTING TRIP UNDER WAY:** The Astros are in the midst of a three-city, 10-day, 11-game road trip that will feature one off day and two doubleheaders... the Astros, who are 5-14 on the road thus far this season, will play the second and third of five today in Oakland before completing the trip in Los Angeles with two against the Dodgers over the weekend.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** The Astros were shut out for the first time this season last night, dropping the opener of this five-game series to the A's by a score of 6-0...**RHP Cristian Javier** was solid in his start, but handed the loss, after allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the Astros had seven hits on the night, all singles, including a 2x4 performance by **SS Carlos Correa**.

YESTERDAY'S ROSTER MOVES: Prior to yesterday's game, the Astros recalled RHP Humberto Castellanos and RHP Chase De Jong from their alternate training site...they took the roster spots of RHP Chris Devenski (right elbow soreness) and LHP Blake Taylor (left elbow soreness), who were both placed on the 10-day IL...Taylor's IL stint was retroactive to Sept. 6.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad is currently made up of three in RHP Brandon Bailey, OF Chas McCormick and IF Nick Tanielu.

**PLAYER POOL ADDITIONS:** The Astros have added two to their 60-man player pool: **C Korey Lee** and **IF Jeremy Peña...**both guys have reported to the club's alternate training site in Corpus Christi, TX.

**QUICK STARTS:** The Astros lead the Majors in 1st-inning runs, posting a healthy 39 runs in the 1st inning thru their first 41 games...the Phillies and Mariners rank second in that category, scoring 32 apiece.

SELECT COMPANY: OF Kyle Tucker ranks fourth in the Majors in RBI with 37, trailing only 1B Jose Abreu (40), SS Fernando Tatis Jr. (39) and CF Mike Trout (38)...his 22 extra-base hits on the season rank tied for third in the AL along with Trout and trailing only Abreu (25) and OF Anthony Santander (25).

RISPY BUSINESS: OF Michael Brantley is hitting a sizzling .480 (12x25) with runners in scoring position, tops in the Majors...as a team, the Astros are hitting .281 with RISP, which ranks second in the AL.

VS. THE A'S: This five-game series is the third and final series of the season between the Astros and A's... unfortunately for Houston, of the 10 games scheduled between these two teams, only two were at Minute Maid Park, in which the Astros went 2-0...the Astros are 0-4 so far this season at The Coliseum...Houston has won five straight season series against the A's (2015-19) and will need to go 3-1 over the remainder of this series to at least split the 10 contests in 2020.

FIVE-GAME ODDITY: Per Elias, this series is the Astros first five-game series since 2005, when the club played the Reds in five straight games from June 30-July 3, with the Astros going 3-1-1...that series was scheduled to be a four-game set, but Game 1 was called in the 7th tied 2-2 and was replayed as part of a doubleheader that weekend...since the game went 7 innings, it still counted as an official game.

LAST START - 9/3 vs. TEX: tossed 6.0 innings, allowing 3 runs on 6 hits with 9 strikeouts in Houston's 8-4 win...tallied a season-high 9 strikeouts, his most since a 9-strikeout game on Sept. 25, 2019 at SEA.

Low-Hit CG: 1, 8/3/09 at SEA

has recorded a quality start in 5 of his last 6 starts, recording a 2.42 ERA (10ER/37.1IP) with 38 strikeouts.

GREINKE DAY: the 6-time All-Star and 36-year-old right-hander is set to make his 9th start of the season, and the 456th start of his Major League career...has the most starts among active pitchers with 456, ahead of his teammate Justin Verlander (454).

- · is coming off a 2019 season that saw him win his 2nd Silver Slugger award, and 6th Rawlings Gold Glove Award.
- is in his first full-season with the Astros...was acquired by the Astros along with cash considerations on July 31, minutes before the trade deadline... in exchange for Greinke, the Astros sent 4 prospects to Arizona: IF Seth Beer, RHP J.B. Bukauskas, RHP Corbin Martin and IF Joshua Rojas.
- vs. OAK: will face the A's for the 3rd time this season...has a career 2.74 ERA (32ER/105IP) with 91 strikeouts and and just 35 walks...is on an active 3-game winning vs. the A's since joining the Astros last season.
- HOT START: ranks 6th in the AL in ERA behind Shane Bieber (1.25), Dallas Keuchel (2.19), Dylan Bundy (2.49), Lance Lynn (2.67) and Kenta Maeda (2.77).
- ranks among the AL leaders in HR per 9.0 innings (0.39, 2nd), walks per 9.0 innings (1.36, 2nd), WAR (1.8, 3rd, Fangraphs), WHIP (0.97, 5th), and hard-hit ball rate (36.9%, 8th).
- has gone his first 8 starts without receiving a losing decision.

**KEEP IT INSIDE:** in his first 6 starts in 2020, he didn't allow a home run.

- became the first Astros pitcher to not allow a homer over his first 6 starts of a season since 2015 (Dallas Keuchel)...the last to do so over his first 7 starts of a season was Wandy Rodriguez in 2009 (8 starts).
- marked the 4th-longest streak of consecutive starts without a HR in his career, his longest since going 8 straight during the middle of the 2015
- WITH THE 'STROS: has made 18 regular season starts for Houston since joining the club in July of 2019, going 11-1 with a 2.97 (36ER/109IP) and 96 strikeouts.
- since making his first start with Houston on Aug. 6, 2019, ranks among the top-5 AL pitchers in wins (T-1st), ERA (3rd) and innings pitched (4th).
- the Astros have gone 12-6 in his 18 starts.
- TOP-25 WITHIN SIGHT: ranks 26th all-time in MLB history in strikeouts (2,666)...trails David Cone for 25th all-time (2,668).
- COOPERSTOWN BOUND?: is 1 of 3 pitchers in MLB history with at least 6 All-Star appearances and 6 Rawlings Gold Glove Awards, along with Greg Maddux and Bob Gibson.
- is 1 of 3 pitchers in MLB history who have won a Cy Young, Gold Glove and Silver Slugger...also Fernando Valenzuela and Orel Hershiser.
- is 1 of 12 pitchers in MLB history to record at least 1,000 strikeouts in both the American League and National League...also Nolan Ran, Randy Johnson, Gaylord Perry, Fergie Jenkins, Pedro Martinez, Jim Bunning, Cy Young, David Cone, A.J. Burnett, Dennis Martinez and Max Scherzer.
