TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and A's play game two of a three-game weekend series. the Giants lost a 6-0 decision last night and are winless in four games against their Bay rivals, being outscored by a 36-16 margin.

THE GIANTS: Enter today's games having lost four of their last six games...SF has scored one run or fewer in all four of those losses.
ON THE MOUND: RHP Kevin Gausman will make his first start since Sept. 7 vs. Arizona...the Giants' right-hander missed his last turn through the rotation due to right elbow tightness...Gausman is $1-2$ with a 3.13 ERA in five career starts against the A's.
ABOVE AND BELOW .500: The Giants are 5-15 (.250) against teams above .500, tied with the Rangers for the lowest win pct. in MLB...however, SF has the fourth-highest win pct. against teams under .500, going 20-10 (.667) (Stats, LLC).

HITTING THE LONGBALL: The Giants played their 50th game of the season last night and although they did not hit a home run, they still have posted one of the highest home run totals at that juncture in franchise history...the team has hit 65 homers through 50 games this year for the fourth-highest total in franchise history behind the 2001 team ( 74 homers in first 50 games), 2000 team ( 71 homers) and 1958 club ( 70 homers).
HITTING LEFTIES: The Giants have the fifth-best OPS among MLB teams against left-handed pitching at .839...only the White Sox (.915), Tigers (.875), Phillies (.856) and Nationals (.850) have a better OPS against lefties than the Giants.

FINAL COUNTDOWN: Just 10 games remain on the regular-season schedule for the Giants -two at Oakland, four vs. Colorado and four vs. San Diego.
JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco has posted a 24-11 (.686) record when they score four-or-more runs in a game, compared to a 1-14 record when they score three-or-fewer runs.
GIANT OFFENSE: San Francisco enters today's game ranking third in the NL in team batting average (.266), fifth in extra-base hits (169) and sixth in OPS (.783)... last year, the Giants ranked 22nd in extra-base hits (493), 27th in team batting average (.239), 28th in OPS (.694)
WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants committed 21 errors in 155.0 innings in their first 18 games this season from July 23-August 10, the most miscues in MLB during that span...however, beginning August 11, SF has made a total of just 15 errors over their last 32 games and 276.1 innings, the fewest errors in the National League.
IN THE PEN: SF's bullpen has held opponents scoreless in 16.2 innings in their last three games and have posted a 1.65 ERA (9er, 49.0ip) in their past 12 contests...in fact, beginning August 19, the Giants' bullpen ERA of 1.94 is the second-best in MLB behind Oakland $(1.89)$

ROUGH ON THE ROAD: The Giants are just 9-16 (.360) on the road this season for the third-lowest road winning percentage among NL teams ahead of the Pirates (5-20, .200) and Diamondbacks (9-19, .321) ...SF has lost their last five games away from Oracle Park.

## ON THIS DATE: SEPTEMBER 19, 1998

The Giants scored seven runs in the 3rd inning, and six more in the 4th, as they defeated the Dodgers by a score of 18-4. Bill Mueller and Jeff Kent hit grand slams in the two frames, just the second time in $\mathrm{Gi}^{-}$ ants history that two players hit grand slams in a game (April 26, 1970 was the other)

## MANAGER GABE KAPLER

- Is in his first season as the skipper of the Giants after being named the 39th manager in club history on November 12, 2019.
- Spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as the skipper of the Philadelphia Phillies, going 161-163 (.497) in his two seasons.
The 2020 campaign marks his fourth season managing and his third at the Major League level...he managed Class A Greenville in the Boston Red Sox organization in 2007.
Prior to joining the Phillies, Kapler was the Director of Player Development for the Dodgers from November 2014 until being hired by Philadelphia in October 2017

From 2015-2017, the three seasons Kapler was at the helm of the Dodgers Player Development, the Dodgers minor league affiliates went a combined 1,299-1,128 (.535) ...the .535 winning pct. was fourth-best among MLB teams in that time

- Had a 12-year career as a player from 1998-2010, suiting up for Detroit (1998-99), Texas (2000-02), Colorado (2002), Boston (2003-06), Milwaukee (2008) and Tampa Bay (2009-10) ...a former 57th-round pick in 1995, Kapler hit . 268 over his 1,104 career games

STRIKEOUTS A PLENTY: Through his first eight starts, Gausman has struck out 60 batters...his 60 punchouts through his first eight starts are the most by a Giants pitcher through their first eight starts with the team since the club moved west in 1958...full chart to the right courtesy of Stats, LLC.
SWING AND MISS: Opposing batters have swung and missed at 33.3\% of Gausman's pitches this season, the sixth-highest total of any NL pitcher (min. 45.0ip)...NYM's Jacob deGrom leads the NL with a 40.9 swing and miss percentage.

K/BB: His 5.17 K/BB ratio is sixth-best in the NL (min. 45.0ip)... the Cubs' Kyle Hendricks leads the NL at 8.71.
