Since joining the Mariners on Sept. 4, Ty France has hit safely in 10 of 11 games on the road, batting .311 (14x45) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 3 RBI and 3 walks.

With 498 career extra-base hits (280 2B, 13 3B, 205 HR), Kyle Seager is only 2 XBH away from becoming the 4th player in Mariners history to tally at least 500 extra-base hits with the club... he will join Edgar Martinez (838), Ken Griffey Jr. (788) and Jay Buhner (557).

TODAY'S TILTS...the Mariners continue a 3-day, 4-game road trip (0-1) to wrap up the season with today's doubleheader against Oakland...recently concluded a four-team, 10-game, 10-day homestand/road trip vs. Oakland (1-1), at San Francisco (0-2) at San Diego (1-2) and vs. Houston (2-1)...tonight's game will be televised by **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast on **710 ESPN** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

SCHEDULE NOTES... The Athletics will be designated as the home team for Game 1 (originally scheduled game) of today's doubleheader and the Mariners will be the home team for Game 2 (rescheduled game)...Game 2 will begin approximately 30 minutes after the completion of Game 1.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 3-3 over their last 6 games...they are 6-7 in their last 13 games, 12-10 since Aug. 30 and 17-13 since Aug. 21.

- **Taxi Squad** - LHP **Aaron Fletcher**, RHP **Seth Frankoff**, C **Joe Hudson**, INF **Donovan Walton** and RHP **Art Warren** are on the Mariners taxi squad on the final road trip.
- **Ribeyes** - **Kyle Seager** ranks T10th in the American League with 37 RBI this season.
- **France Stays Hot** - since joining the Mariners, **Ty France** has reached base safely via hit, walk or HBP in 18 of 20 games (9/4-c), batting .293 (22x75) with 8 runs scored, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 10 RBI, 6 walks and 1 HBP.
- **J.P. Getting Hot** - **J.P. Crawford** has hit safely in each of his last 4 games, including 2 games with multiple hits during that span...overall is batting .353 (6x17) during the 4-game stretch.
- **Sliders** - Opponents are batting .179 (12x67) off **Justus Sheffield's** slider this season, while **Justin Dunn** has limited opponents to a .143 (6x42) clip against his slider.
- **Catch Us If You Can** - the Mariners rank 5th in the Majors with 47 stolen bases this season, trailing only San Diego (52\3) and Miami (50), Kansas City (49) and Tampa Bay (48)...**Dylan Moore** leads the Mariners with 12 stolen bases, followed by **J.P. Crawford** (5), **Tim Lopes** (5) and **Kyle Seager** (5)...overall, the Mariners 12 players with at least 1 stolen base this season rank T5th in the Majors (also: Chicago-NL & Tampa Bay), trailing only Cincinnati (15), Texas (15), San Diego (14) and Miami (13).

ALL ROOKIE TEAM...on Wednesday, **Justus Sheffield** and **Kyle Lewis** were named to the **MLB Pipeline 2020 All-Rookie Team**...Lewis received first team honors as an outfielder, while Sheffield was named to the second team as a starting pitcher...the Mariners are one of three American League teams to have both a position player and a starting pitcher listed on the All-Rookie teams, joining Chicago-AL (Luis Robert-OF & Sixto Sanchez-SP) and Oakland (Sean Murphy-C and Jesus Luzardo-SP).

TWO GAMES IN ONE DAY...the Mariners are scheduled to play their third doubleheader (0-0-2) of the season today...marks the Mariners first time playing at least 3 doubleheaders in a season since 1986 when the club went 0-2-1 in three doubleheaders...overall, is the 9th time in club history that the Mariners have played at least 3 doubleheaders (most: 10, 1998)...dating back to 2009, the Mariners have split each of their last 9 doubleheaders, including both of their doubleheaders this season...overall, the Mariners are 12-18-46 in 76 doubleheaders in club history.

NICE STRETCH...the Mariners starters have allowed 1 run or less in 5 of their last 6 starts...during this stretch, the starters have gone 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA (5 ER, 36.0 IP), while limiting opponents to a .206 (26x126) batting average with 13 walks and 27 strikeouts...over their last 4 games (9/21-c), Mariners starters have allowed only 1 earned run in 24.1 innings pitched with 7 walks and 16 strikeouts, including scoreless starts from **Marco Gonzales** (8.0 IP), **Nick Margenivius** (6.0 IP) and **Yusei Kikuchi** (6.0 IP)...dating back to the 2nd inning of Ljay Newsome's start vs. Houston on Tuesday, Mariners starters have combined to toss 15.1 consecutive scoreless innings (9/22-c).

START ME UP...Mariners starters have recorded 25 quality starts this season with the starters going 16-2 when allowing 3 runs or less and tossing at least 6.0 innings...the Mariners 25 quality starts this season are T5th-most in the Majors (also: Houston), trailing only Cleveland (37), Chicago-NL (30), Colorado (27) and Cincinnati (26)...**Marco Gonzales** and **Justus Sheffield** are T9th in the American League with 6 quality starts this season...dating back to Aug. 30, the Mariners are 10-1 when their starter recorded a quality start.

GOLD GLOVE CALIBER...**Kyle Seager** has not made an error over his last 28 games (8/23-c), successfully converting each of his 66 total chances (15 PO, 51 A)...**J.P. Crawford** has not made an error over his last 30 games (8/15-c), successfully converting each of his 124 total chances (44 PO, 80 A)...**Evan White** has not made an error over his last 46 games (7/29-c), successfully converting each of his 342 total chances (314 PO, 28 A)...overall this season, Crawford ranks 2nd among American League shortstops with 5 Defensive Runs Saved, trailing only Carlos Correa-HOU (8)...White has tallied 6 Defensive Runs Saved this season, the most by any AL first basemen...Seager has made 21 out of zone plays this season, the most among AL third basemen.

STOP IT!...since Aug. 15, the Mariners lead the Major Leagues in fielding percentage with a mark of .992 over that span...in their last 36 games, the Mariners have successfully converted 1,237 (932 PO, 305 A) of 1,247 total chances, committing only 10 errors...during this stretch, the Mariners rank ahead of Houston (.991), Kansas City (.991) and Tampa Bay (.989)...overall this season the Mariners have committed just 22 errors total, the 3rd-fewest in the Majors (Houston, 18; Minnesota, 20)...the Mariners .989 fielding percentage (22 E, 1,978 TC) is 3rd-best in the Majors this season, trailing only Houston (.991) and Minnesota (.990).

ROY...**Kyle Lewis** ranks among American League rookie leaders in nearly every offensive category: runs scored (1st, 37), hits (1st, 54), walks (1st, 33), batting (1st, .271), on-base percentage (1st, .372), slugging percentage (1st, .452), OPS (1st, .834), multi-hit games (1st, 15), times on base (1st, 87), total bases (1st, 90), *FanGraphs* WAR (1st, 1.8), home runs (T1st, 11), RBI (2nd, 28) and extra-base hits (T2nd, 14).

AS YOU MAY KNOW...Mariners starters rank T5th in the American League with a 1.24 WHIP this season...

BUT DID YOU KNOW?...the 1.24 WHIP by Mariners starters in on pace to be tied for the 3rd lowest mark in Mariners history (also: 2011), trailing only the clubs from 2014 (1.18) and 2012 (1.23)...**Marco Gonzales** leads 2020 Mariners starters with a 0.91 WHIP, ahead of **Justus Sheffield** (1.29), **Yusei Kikuchi** (1.30) and **Justin Dunn** (1.33)...with his 0.91 WHIP, Marco is currently on pace to post the lowest single season WHIP in club history, ahead of Felix Hernandez in 2014 (0.92) and Cliff Lee in 2010 (0.95).

ABOUT SHEFFIELD...

- 24-year-old left-hander is making his 17th career Major League start...
• Justus ("justice") Kane Sheffield...resides in Tullahoma, TN.
• Acquired in trade from New York-AL along with Erik Swanson (rhp) and Dom Thompson-Williams (of) in exchange for James Paxton (lhp) on Nov. 19, 2018.
• Has been a top-10 organizational prospect according to Baseball America since making his professional debut in 2014...
• Made his Major League debut with the Yankees on Sept. 19, 2018 vs. Boston.
• Native of Tullahoma, TN...selected by Cleveland in the 1st round (31st overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft out of Tullahoma (TN) High School...
• Began his pro career with Cleveland after being selected by the Indians with the 31st overall pick in the 2014 MLB Draft...

LAST START...W #4 in his last start, a 4-1 Mariners win Sept. 19 at San Diego... allowed just 1 run on 6 hits in 6.0 IP (2 BB, 5 K)...only run allowed came in 3rd inning, when Pads had 3 of their 6 hits off him...

LATELY...since Aug. 9, is 4-1 with a 2.74 ERA (13 ER, 42.2 IP) with 40 strikeouts and 12 walks in 7 starts...has logged 6 quality starts over this span...

DOMINATE THE ZONE...Sheffield's 63.3 first-pitch strike percentage is 10th-best among all left-handers this season (min. 50.0 IP).

NICE STRETCH...recorded 3 consecutive quality starts, Aug. 9-22...over that span, went 2-0 with a 1.00 ERA (2 ER, 18.0 IP) with 16 strikeouts and 2 walks in 3 starts.

ROOKIE LEADER...among American League rookie pitchers (min. 45.0 IP), ranks 2nd in ERA (3.75), 3rd in lowest opponent batting average (.246), T2nd in wins (4), 4th in strikeouts (47), T3rd in starts (9) and 3rd in innings pitched (50.1).

EXTRA, EXTRA? NOT HERE...has allowed only 6 extra-base hits (4 2B, 2 HR) this season...among all pitchers with at least 45.0 innings pitched this season, his 6 extra-base hits allowed are the 2nd-fewest in the Majors (see box at right).

HE'LL REMEMBER HIS FIRST...recorded first career win in Mariners 5-3 triumph vs. Colorado on Aug. 9...spun 6.0 4-hit innings with 7 strikeouts and didn't issue a walk:

- Became the first Mariners starter to log a win in his age 24 season or younger since Andrew Moore recorded 1 win in 2017...Félix Hernández holds the club record with 71 wins through his age 24 season.
• Was followed in the rotation by Justin Dunn, who earned his first Major League win the very next night in Texas, becoming the 1st set of Mariners starting pitchers to record their first MLB wins in consecutive starts.

SEASON DEBUT...took the loss on July 28 at the Angels, tossing 3.0 innings and allowing 4 runs with 4 walks and 2 strikeouts...faced the minimum through the first two innings before allowing 2 runs in the third...left the game in the 4th after allowing the first two batters to reach base...both scored on 3-run HR to first batter faced by the bullpen.

SUMMER CAMP RECAP...tied Kendall Graveman for the team-lead during Summer Camp with 13 strikeouts over 9.0 innings (3 G)...allowed just one run on four hits and did not walk a batter.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP...in 3 Cactus League appearances (2 starts), posted a 2.25 ERA (2 ER, 8.0 IP) and allowed just 5 hits with 12 strikeouts (team-best) and 0 walks...held opponents to a .179 batting average.

2019 RECAP...went 0-1 with a 5.50 ERA (22 ER, 36.0 IP) with 18 walks and 37 strikeouts in 8 games (7 starts) with the Mariners in 2019.

WELCOME TO SEATTLE...acquired in trade from New York-AL along with Erik Swanson (rhp) and Dom Thompson-Williams (cf) in exchange for James Paxton (lhp) on Nov. 19, 2018.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW...made his Major League debut with the Yankees on Sept. 19, 2018 vs. Boston, tossing a scoreless 9th inning...made his debut at 22 years, 129 days of age...selected from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Sept. 18.

CAREER...in parts of 3 Major League seasons with New York-AL (2018) and Seattle (2019-c), is 4-4 with a 4.65 ERA (46 ER, 89.0 IP) with 84 strikeouts and 39 walks in 20 games (16 starts).

24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 10th start of the season today against the A's...ND in last start, 9/20 at SD, despite starting game with 5.2 no-hit innings; allowed a 2-out double followed by a 2-strike 3-run HR in 6th to end day (5.2,2,3,3,4,6,HR); Seattle eventually lost 7-4 in 11 innings...ND in 7-3 Mariners win Sept. 13 at AZ, allowing 1 run on 1 hit while striking out 5 and walking 5 in 2.0 innings; threw 66 pitches (33 strikes)...W#3 in Mariners 4-3 win over Texas on Sept. 6 (6.0,4,2,2,4,4,2HR)...ND in Mariners 2-1 win at LAA on Aug. 30 (6.0,1,0,0,4,6); tossed 12.0 scoreless innings over 2 starts (8/23-30)...W#2 in 4-1 Mariners win, on Aug. 23 vs. Texas, tossing 6.0 scoreless innings while allowing just 1 hit and 1 walk while striking out 6...W#1 on 8/10 at TEX (6.0,7,2,2,3,2)...L#1 on 8/4 vs. LAA (4.0,3,3,3,4,4,HR-2), allowing all 3 runs in the 1st inning... in his first start of the season, 7/29 at LAA, tossed 3.0 innings and allowed 3 runs (2 earned) with 3 walks and 2 strikeouts...2019: Made 4 abbreviated starts at the Major League level, allowing 2 earned runs over 6.2 innings pitched (2.70 ERA) with 5 strikeouts, 9 walks and 2 hits allowed...2019 AA RECAP: Spent the season with AA Arkansas, going 9-5 with a 3.55 ERA (52 ER, 131.2 IP) with 158 strikeouts and 39 walks in 25 starts...was named a mid-season and post-season All-Star in the Texas League after he finished the year leading the Texas League in wins (9), strikeouts (158) and WHIP (1.19)...joined teammate Evan White and prospect Jarred Kelenic in Cleveland as members of the AL Futures Game roster; he struck out 1 batter in 1.0 scoreless inning in the game...vs. OAK: Will be making his second career start against Oakland: Worked 2.0 shutout innings (0 hits, 1 walk, 3 strikeouts) Sept. 29, 2019 in 3-1 Mariners win in Seattle.
