YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers beat the Giants, 13-7, in Phoenix.....Milwaukee recorded 17 hits, including 12 for extra bases (7 doubles, 2 triples, 3 HR).....**C Omar Narváez (#1)**, **RF Avisaíl García (#2)** and **LF Christian Yelich (#1)** all hit solo homers.....**1B Zach Green** went 2-for-2 with 2 runs, a double, triple and 2 RBI.

WHAT'S BREWING?: INF Orlando Arcia is batting .375 (6-for-16) with 3 RBI in 6 games.....**C Mario Feliciano** is 4-for-7 (.571) with a double, 2 triples and 5 RBI in 6 games.....he has 2-run triples in each of his last 2 games.....**OF Derek Fisher** is batting .294 (5-for-17) with 1 HR and a team-leading 6 RBI in 7 games.....**OF Avisaíl García** is batting .500 (7-for-14) with 2 HR and 4 RBI in 6 games.....**OF Garrett Mitchell**, seeing his first career professional action, is 4-for-9 (.444) with 3 RBI in 8 games.....**C Omar Narváez** is batting .455 (5-for-11) with 1 HR and 2 RBI in 5 games.....**C Manny Piña** is 5-for-9 (.556) with 1 HR and 3 RBI in 4 games.....**OF Tyrone Taylor** is batting .500 (6-for-12) with a solo homer in 6 games.

NEW RULES: The following rule modifications were made by Major League Baseball for 2021 Spring Training games:

Length of Games: Games scheduled between 2/28-3/13 may be five to seven innings in duration.....games scheduled thereafter may be seven to nine innings.

Ending Innings Unilaterally: For games between 2/28-3/13, "retiring the side" shall be relaxed, such that defensive managers may end an inning prior to three outs following any completed plate appearance, provided the pitcher has thrown at least 20 pitches.

Substitutions: The substitution rules shall be relaxed, allowing for re-entry for all pitchers.

Three-Batter Minimum: The three-batter minimum rule will be enforced during Spring Training games beginning 3/14.

THE ROSTER: The Brewers currently have 61 players in Major League camp, including 32 pitchers, 6 catchers, 12 infielders and 11 outfielders.....there are 21 non-roster invitees, including 12 pitchers, 1 catcher, 5 infielders and 3 outfielders.

THE NEW BREW: OF Jackie Bradley Jr. (free agent), INF/OF Tim Lopes (claimed off waivers from Seattle), C Luke Maile (free agent), INF/OF Daniel Robertson (free agent) and 2B Kolten Wong (free agent).

LHP Brett Anderson, 33, will make his second Spring Training start today.....Anderson went 4-4 with a 4.21 ERA in 10 starts during his first season with Milwaukee.....the team went 5-5 in his starts.....he made 4 quality starts..... he re-signed with the Brewers as a free agent on 2/22/21.....he has also pitched for Oakland (2009-13, 2018-19), Colorado (2014), Los Angeles-NL (2015-16), Chicago-NL (2017) and Toronto (2017).
