WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers have won 3 of last 4 G, assured of a .500-or-better spring win pct. with last night's win...team is 3-3 in last 6 G and has won 8 of 12, going 9-4-1 in last 14 G, 10-5-1 in last 16 G, and 13-7-1 in last 21 G...at 13-9-3 (.591) overall this spring, team is 4th in Cactus League Standings behind KC (.636, 14-8-3), CHC (.619, 13-8-4), and OAK (.609, 14-9-2)...the 13 wins are T3rd-most on circuit...team has not finished more than 2 G above .500 in ST since 2009 (21-14-0)...team is 9-2-1 at home and 9-3-1 overall in Surprise...Texas has 3 ties this spring (last 3/13 at MIL), 4th time in 5 years (2017-21) for Texas to have at least 3 ties in ST, this after none in 2020.

ALL GOOD IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD: The Rangers posted a decisive win over the Kansas City Royals on Friday night, defeating their complex neighbors by an 8-1 margin at Surprise Stadium. The offense showed impressive discipline at the plate, matching its spring high with 8 walks (also 3/16 at SF) against just 5 strikeouts. Half of those walks came in the club's 5-run 2nd inning, which was highlighted by David Dahl's 3-run home run onto the berm in straightaway center field. Leadoff hitter Isiah Kiner-Falefa posted an RBI single in the 2nd before scoring on the home run, and also came around to score on Joey Gallo's sacrifice fly after singling in the 1st.

Texas pitchers recorded a spring-high 13 strikeouts. Starter Taylor Hearn (3.0 IP, 1 R-ER, 5 SO) recovered well after a troublesome 1st inning that saw him exit with 2 outs and re-enter the game to start the 2nd. Relievers John King (2.2 SHO IP, 3 SO) and Josh Sborz (1.0 SHO IP, 3 SO) delivered strong efforts out of the bullpen. Matt Bush (0.1 IP) and Ian Kennedy (0.2 IP) were also scoreless, as both entered mid-inning while working on back-to-back nights for the 1st time.

<u>VS. OAKLAND:</u> Today is the last of 2 exhibition meetings between the Rangers and A's, with Oakland posting a 6-0 shutout in 7 innings on 3/11 in Surprise...the Rangers narrowly avoided being no-hit in that game, as Andy Ibáñez's single with 2 outs in the bottom of the 7th marked the club's only hit...the divisional foes are once again slated for 6 series in 2021, though the 1st set is not until 6/21-24 in Arlington...Texas went 3-7 vs. OAK in '20, losing the season series for a 4th straight year.

• A pair of former A's are traveling with the Rangers today: CF Eli White (batting leadoff) and RHP Jharel Cotton (available out of bullpen)...INF Anderson Tejeda had a HR and 3 RBI in his ML debut on 8/6/20 at OAK.

<u>GIVE ME ALL THE 'B' GAMES:</u> The Rangers this morning were scheduled to play a 'B' game vs. KC at 10am AZ time on Nolan Ryan Field...probable pitching: RHP Jason Bahr, RHP Joe Gatto, RHP Yerry Rodriguez, RHP Ronny Henriquez vs. RHP Wade Davis, RHP Scott Barlow, RHP Jesse Hahn, RHP Brad Brach...TEX enters today 4-1-2 in 'B' games this spring (3-1-1 vs. KC).

THE GALLO UPDATE: Joey Gallo ranks among Cactus League leaders in HR (T3rd, 5) and RBI (T7th, 12)...the 12 RBI are tied with Adolis García for the club lead...Gallo had a walk, sac fly, and scored a run last night vs. KC...8 of his 11 spring hits have gone for extra bases (5 HR, 2 2B, 1 3B)...owns a .297/.400/.811/1.211 slash line, but is just 5-for-24 in his last 10 G to drop BA from .429...hit HR in 5 of his 1st 6 G this spring (last on 3/9 vs. CLE)...the club record for spring HR is 8 by Mark Teixeira in 2003...6 others are T2nd w/ 7 HR in one spring: Pete Incaviglia (1986), Ruben Sierra (1989), Dean Palmer (1994), Hank Blalock (2004), Kevin Mench (2006), Josh Hamilton (2009).

BATTING NOTES: Offense has a .300 BA (52-173) in last 5 G, averaging 6.8 runs per game during that span...team's .260 overall BA is 8th in the Cactus League, and club is among CL leaders in 3B (T1st, 8), SB (3rd, 22), OPS (4th, .815), SLG (5th, .468), OBP (5th, .347)...HR in 11 of last 12 G....Adolis García is tied with Joey Gallo for the team RBI lead with 12 - T7th in the CL - this despite only 3 starts in 'A' games...hits/RBI in 4 straight at 6-for-8 to raise spring BA to .478 (11-23)...**Isiah Kiner-Falefa** (.385/.455/.564/1.019) has multiple hits in 3 consecutive games, as he is batting .462 (12-26) in his last 8 games to raise his batting average from .231 to a spring-high .385...has team-high 15 H, and  $5\,BB/5\,SO...$  Nick Solak is among club leaders in H (2nd, 12), HR (2nd, 4), and RBI (3rd, 9)...has yet to go consecutive games without a hit this spring...3 of 4 long balls have been opposite field blasts...has multiple hits in 3 of his last 6 games at 6-for-20 with 2 HR, a 2B, and 3 RBI...**Leody Taveras** had his 7-G hit streak snapped last night, but drew 2 BB to extend on-base streak to 8 G at .370 (10-27) to rise from .077 to .282... INJURIES: OF/DH Khris Davis (Grade 2 left quad strain) exited game Tues. vs. LAA in the 1st inning after legging out a bunt single...will likely miss 3-4 weeks...RHP José Leclerc (right elbow soreness) has returned to Texas to be examined by Rangers Team Physician Dr. Keith Meister, it was announced on Monday...the expectation is that he will miss extended time...first reported symptoms after his outing on 3/18 vs. CIN...RHP Jonathan Hernández has a low grade UCL sprain in his right elbow, it was announced on 3/9...will be shut down for 4 weeks, at which point he will be re-evaluated and may begin a throwing program...3B Josh Jung (stress fracture in left foot) had successful surgery performed on Monday by foot specialist Dr. Keith Heier...as part of the procedure, a screw was inserted into the foot...estimated recovery time is 6-8 weeks...OF Willie Calhoun (groin strain) felt discomfort following game 3/8 at CHC...has shown improvement and begun light running...is unlikely to be ready for Opening Day...C Sam Huff (Grade 2 left hamstring strain) will likely remain with minor league group when Major League camp breaks in order to build up baseball endurance...RHP Demarcus Evans (right lat strain) is scheduled to throw off a mound soon and will not be ready for the start of the season...LHP Joely Rodríguez (ankle sprain) is throwing bullpens and was slated to face hitters this week...expected to miss start of season and will likely not be ready until mid-April...LHP Brock Burke (left shoulder surgery) continues to progress.

MISCELLANEOUS: The Rangers on Wednesday announced that the club has exercised a 2022 contract option on Manager Chris Woodward...following the latest roster moves on Wednesday, Texas has 41 players remaining in Major League camp...RHP Kyle Gibson will be the club's 11th different Opening Day starter in the last 12 seasons, with Cole Hamels (2016 and 2018) the only repeat starter during that span...Texas is 1-4 in its last 5 road games...club has scored 6+ runs in 4 straight contests...the Rangers were shut out in other trip to Mesa, 3/8 at CHC (9-0 loss in 7 innings).

SCHEDULED STARTER: #44 KYLE GIBSON (0-0, 0.00) Named as the club's Opening Day starter by manager Chris Woodward on 3/16, and it will be the 1st such assignment of Gibson's career...is slated to pitch opener on 4/1 at KC, as this will be his final tuneup before that outing...last pitched in a B game on Mon. vs. KC...only blemish on his line was a 2-R HR by KC's M.J. Melendez, as Gibson whiffed multiple batters in each frame...posted 4.0 SHO IP w/6 K's in last 'A' outing on 3/17 vs. ARI...pitched in a B game on 3/12 vs. CWS at Nolan Ryan Field in Surprise (2.2 IP, 0 R)...made spring debut with start on 3/1 vs. SF (1.0 IP, 0 R), inducing a GIDP after allowing 1st 2 batters to reach...the 33-year-old enters his 2nd season with the Rangers after signing a 3-year contract through 2022 on 12/6/19... is seeking to bounce back from an up-and-down Rangers debut in 2020, when he posted the American League's 2nd-highest qualifying ERA...had spent his entire 10-year professional career in the Twins organization before signing with Texas...also that year, was bothered much of the season by an ulcerative colitis condition that he continues to manage...from 2014-19, produced 10-or-more victories 5 times and recorded 6 consecutive years of 25-or-more starts.
