HOME STRUGGLES: The O's have dropped four-straight home games and eight of nine overall at Oriole Park this season...Their one win is the fewest home wins by a team in the majors, and they are 14-28 at home since the beginning of the 2020 season.

- ⚾ Orioles pitchers have surrendered 18 home runs at Oriole Park, in nine games, tied for the most home runs allowed at home in the AL (OAK, in 14 games).
- ⚾ The Orioles 6.00 team ERA (50 ER/75.0) at home is the highest in the majors...Their starters ERA at home is 7.51 (32 ER/38.1 IP).

TAKING ON THE ATHLETICS: The Orioles and Athletics finish their three-game series this afternoon; they'll already wrap up their season series next week, when the O's travel out to Oakland for a three-game set next weekend, April 30 - May 2.

- ⚾ The Orioles have lost eight-straight games against Oakland, dating back to April 9, 2019; are 1-8 against the A's since the beginning of 2019.
- ⚾ The eight-game losing streak is tied for the second-longest in O's history to the A's (three other times), trailing only a club record nine-game losing streak from May 5, 2008 - August 10, 2009.
- ⚾ **INF/OF Trey Mancini** has slashed .333/.417/.571 with three home runs in 12 career games at home against the Athletics.

HAPPY JOHN MEANS DAY: LHP John Means will be making his team-leading fifth start this afternoon...His 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP) is the lowest by an O's pitcher in their first four starts of the season since RHP Dylan Bundy in 2018 (1.40 ERA).

- ⚾ His 1.52 ERA leads the AL (among qualifiers) and ranks as the fourth-best in baseball.
- ⚾ His 23.2 IP, 23 strikeouts, and 0.93 WHIP lead all O's starters.

FACING THE SOUTH PAWS: The Orioles have gone 1-6 against left-handed starters this season...In the first eight games of the season, the O's hit .303 (23-for-76) against lefties and in 10 games since, they are hitting .230 (32-for-139).

- ⚾ Six O's are batting .300-or-better against left-handers this season...As a team, the O's are batting .256 (55-for-215) against lefties, the fourth-highest average in the AL and the eighth-highest in the majors.
- ⚾ Against lefties, the O's have posted a 20.82 PA/BB ratio (229/11), the lowest in the majors.

NOT LEAVING THE YARD: The Orioles have gone three-straight games with out homering... Their 17 home runs are the fewest in the AL and tied for the fourth-fewest in the majors...They have gone homer-less in nine games this season, going 4-5 in these games.

- ⚾ The O's 35 doubles are the fourth-most in the AL and tied for the fifth-most in the majors.

NOT AN EASY ROAD: Entering play today, the O's have played the third-hardest strength of schedule in the majors, according to *Baseball-Reference*...Only the Seattle Mariners and Colorado Rockies have had a tougher path so far.

- ⚾ The Orioles next five series opponents (NYY, OAK, SEA, BOS, NYM) have a combined .570 (57-43) winning percentage.

DE-PEN-DABLE: The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 3.19 ERA (28 ER/79.0 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL and sixth-lowest in the majors...At home, the bullpen has posted a 4.42 ERA (18 ER/36.2 IP) compared to a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) on the road.

- ⚾ The bullpen threw a season-high 121 pitches in last night's game (7.1 IP); their most in a game since last year on August 16 vs. WSH (156 pitches, 8.1 IP).
- ⚾ The O's bullpen has posted a combined 1.4 wins above average, according to *Baseball-Reference*, the fourth-highest number in the majors.
- ⚾ RHP César Valdez has recorded four saves in five opportunities; tied for the most saves in the AL...Valdez has allowed a .224 opponent slugging percentage since joining the Orioles on August 29 last season (17 games); this is the second-lowest opponent slugging percentage by an AL pitcher in this stretch (min. 20.0 IP).
- ⚾ RHP Adam Plutko has worked 12.0 innings in relief, posting a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP)...His innings out of the bullpen are tied for the seventh-most in the AL.
- ⚾ LHP Paul Fry has appeared in a team-high-tying nine games (Armstrong)...His nine games are tied for the second-most by a left-handed pitcher in the AL...He has not allowed a run since his 2021 debut on 4/5 at NYY (eight games - 7.0 IP); the eight-straight games without allowing a run is tied for the longest active streak in the AL.

ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER HIT: OF Cedric Mullins has hit safely in 15 of his 19 starts this season...He's batted lead off in all of his starts, batting .368 (7-for-19) in the first inning of these games; his seven hits are tied for the most in the majors in the first frame.

- ⚾ His 25 hits on the season are tied for the fifth-most in the AL.
- ⚾ Is batting .385 (10-for-26) against left-handed pitching, tied for the third-most hits against lefties in the majors; in Spring Training he became a full-time left-handed hitter after switch hitting his entire professional career.

WHO'S ON FIRST, WHAT'S ON SECOND: The Orioles recorded their second-straight game with at least 10 hits and zero home runs last night, their third time overall this season (also: 4/4 at BOS)...It was the second-straight night they lost after out-hitting their opponent, now 5-2 on the season when doing so...On the season, the O's as a team have a .278 on-base percentage, the second-lowest in the majors (DET - .267)...Their team .637 OPS also ranks as the second-lowest in the majors (DET - .634).

- ⚾ The O's have walked 48 times this season, the fewest in the AL and tied for the second-fewest in the majors; Maikel Franco and Cedric Mullins lead the club with 8 walks.

LAST START: Did not earn a decision through 7.0 scoreless innings, giving up just three hits and two walks with a season-high nine strikeouts...The nine punchouts are tied for the second-most in his career (also 9/26/20 at TOR, 6.0 IP), behind a 12-strikeout performance on 9/20/20 vs. Tampa Bay (5.2 IP)...With multiple walks in three-straight contests (since 4/7), Means tied his career-long streak with two-or-more walks (last: 5/12-5/24/19)...In addition to Opening Day on 4/2 at Boston, this was his second start of the season where he did not allow a run through 7.0 innings...Means is the only pitcher in Major League Baseball this season with two scoreless outings of at least 7.0 innings; 26 other pitchers have had one such start.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY: Celebrated his 28th birthday yesterday...Has made one career start on his birthday in 2019 vs. Chicago-AL, in which he earned the win, throwing 5.0 innings and allowing one run on four hits and one walk, while striking out six.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Means' only career appearance vs. the Athletics was his first Major League start on 4/9/19...He suffered the loss on 4/9/19 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, allowing five runs (one earned) on four hits and one walk with one strikeout through 3.0 innings.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Will be making his third-straight start against an American League West opponent after previously facing the division five times in 2019...This season, Means has not earned a decision, and has pitched to a 2.25 ERA (3 ER/12.0 IP) with four walks, and 14 strikeouts...Over his career, Means is 2-2 against the AL West with a 1.99 ERA (9 ER/40.2 IP), 10 walks, and 32 strikeouts...Five of his seven starts against the division have been at Oriole Park at Camden Yards, where he is 2-2 with a 2.60 ERA (8 ER/27.2 IP).

STRIKE 'EM OUT: Has recorded four-or-more strikeouts in a career-high eight-straight games since 9/8/20...10 of his 23 strikeouts this year (43.5%), and 88 of 190-career strikeouts (46.3%) have come via the 4-seam fastball...According to *Baseball Savant*, his fastball spin rate ranks in the 82nd percentile among active Major League pitchers, averaging 2418 rpm.

MEANS BUSINESS: On 4/2 at BOS, Means became the 17th pitcher in Major League history, and first Oriole, to toss at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits in a start on Opening Day; he is the third pitcher in Major League history to do so without issuing a walk, joining Irv Young (1906) and Jordan Zimmermann (2019)...It was the second time in his career he did not allow a run in a start (last: 6/28/19 vs. CLE, 5.0 IP, H, BB, 5 SO)...Means is the first pitcher in Orioles history to work at least 7.0 innings, while allowing one or fewer hits, and no runs in a start at Fenway Park...He joined Mike Mussina (5/30/97) and Jim Palmer (5/12/67) as one of three Orioles to throw at least 7.0 innings, allowing one or fewer hits, no runs, and no walks in a start overall.

STREAK SNAPPED: Allowed three runs on 4/13 (G1) vs. Seattle, snapping a stretch of six-consecutive starts with one run-or-fewer since 9/8/20...This is tied with Hall of Famer and current Orioles broadcaster, Jim Palmer (5/20-6/10/78), for the longest such streak in Orioles history.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Means went 2-4 with a 4.53 ERA (22 ER/43.2 IP), seven walks, 42 strikeouts, and a .220 opponents' batting average in 10 starts during last year's shortened season...Had a solid final four outings, going 2-1 with a 1.52 ERA (4 ER/23.2 IP), three walks, and 30 strikeouts...Was the only Orioles pitcher to record double-digit strikeouts in a game when he struck out a career-high 12 batters on 9/20 vs. Tampa Bay...Struck out seven-straight Rays batters in the same game to match the Orioles' club record for consecutive strikeouts set by Sammy Stewart in 1978...Led the team in strikeouts (42), tied RHP Alex Cobb for most starts (10), and finished second in innings pitched (43.2).

 Harvey earned his first win since 7/13/19 vs. Seattle in his fourth start of the 2021 season on 4/20 at Miami, snapping a career-long five-game losing streak...Against the Marlins he allowed three runs on eight hits with no walks and four strikeouts...It was his first outing without giving up a walk since he did not allow a free pass in four-straight appearances (one start) from 9/3-9/15/20...Harvey has made four career starts against New York-AL in which he is 1-0 with a 1.63 ERA (5 ER/27.2 IP), five walks, and 26 strikeouts...He last faced the Yankees on 4/22/19 in Los Angeles-AL.
