THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY MAY 18

2015-RHP Lance McCullers Jr. makes his Major League debut in a start at Minute Maid Park opposite the A's... he tosses 4.2 innings, allowing one run on three hits with five strikeouts, but does not factor into the decision in the Astros 2-1 loss...McCullers strikes out DH Billy Butler to end the 1st inning for his first career strikeout.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will open their sixgame road trip tonight looking to extend their winning streak to seven games behind RHP Cristian Javier. he'll be opposed by LHP Sean Manaea, who's making his third start against the Astros this season and the 16th of his career (3-6, 3.50 ERA, 32ER/82.1IP).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Cristian Javier, who finished third in AL Rookie of the Year voting last season, has continued his success into 2021, as he currently ranks fifth in the AL in opponent batting average (.174) and seventh in WHIP (0.97) (min. 35 IP)...the Astros are 5-2 in his seven starts this season and 12-5 in his 17 career starts.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros have won a sea-son-best six straight games and are 17-7 dating back to April 22, winning six of seven series played since that date...the club's winning streak is the longest active in the Majors and is two wins shy of matching their season-long winning streak of 2020 (eight games).

WHERE WE STAND: The Astros passed the quarter mark of the season on Sunday at a season-high seven games above .500 and in second place in the AL West, a half game back of Oakland...the last time the Astros were within a half game of first was on May 1 and the last time they were in first place was on April 8.

BEAT THE BEST: The Astros are 14-9 against teams with .500 -or-better records...in the Majors, only the Red Sox (11-7) have posted a better winning percentage against said opponents, while only the Brewers (15-11) have posted more wins then the Astros against a winning opponent.

TAMING THE WEST: The Astros are 19-8 against the AL West this season, with winning records against all four divisional foes: OAK (5-2), LAA (6-3), SEA (4-3) and TEX (4-0)...the Astros are in the midst of 13 consecutive games against the AL West, going 6-1 so far.
vs. OAK: The Astros are returning to the Coliseum tonight for the first time since sweeping a four-game series from the A's in Oakland on opening weekend... on the season, the Astros are 5-2 through the first seven games of a scheduled 19 between the two clubs.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad consists of two: RHP Tyler Ivey and C Garrett Stubbs.

SUNDAY, FUNDAY: The Astros scored four runs in the 8th inning on Sunday in Houston for a 6-2 win, finishing off a four-game sweep of their intrastate rivals...1B Yuli Gurriel, had the go-ahead swing, a well-struck sac fly, while RF Chas McCormick drove in two more to provide the Astros with some cushion... RHP Lance McCullers Jr. pitched another great game, tossing 6.0 scoreless frames in his start.

THE STAND: The Astros just completed a sea-son-long, 10-game homestand, in which they went $8-2$ against TOR (2-1), LAA (2-1) and TEX (4-0)...this marked their best homestand since also going 8-2 in a 10-gamer from Aug. 19-29, 2019.

TONIGHT'S AVAILABILITIES: Astros pregame availabilities will be from 5:30-6:30 p.m. CT today with Dusty Baker available at approx. 5:30 p.m. CT... the postgame availabilities will be immediately after tonight's game and will be available at the same link: - Meeting ID: 94386598455

ASTROS+: The Astros (+56) run differential ranks second in MLB, trailing the White Sox (+73)...in their last 24 games, the Astros are 16-7 with +57 differential.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros offense leads the Majors in batting average (.266), while ranking second in hits (372), second in SLG (.432), tied for second in runs (216), third in OPS (.765), third in OBP (.333) and tied for third in doubles (78)...they've also recorded the fewest strikeouts (289) in the Majors.

STREAKING: 2B Jose Altuve has an active 11game hitting streak heading into tonight's game, in which he's hitting .400 (18x45) with two doubles, three homers and eight RBI...Altuve is looking for his first streak of $12+$ games since hitting safely in a career-long 19 straight games from July 2-28, 2017.

UP THE LISTS: 2B Jose Altuve ( 137 HR ) ranks 10th in homers in Astros history and is closing in on two players ahead of him.... with one homer, Altuve would tie Jose Cruz (138) for ninth place, and with two homers, he would tie Bob Watson (139) for eighth place.

GOING FOR 800: RHP Joe Smith has made 799 apps., the most among active players, and is looking to become the 51 st pitcher in MLB history to reach $800 \ldots$ among relievers, Smith ranks 40th in MLB history in apps., one shy of RHP Francisco Cordero $(800 \mathrm{~g})$.

ON THE MEND: LHP Framber Valdez, on the IL with a left index finger fracture, made his first rehab start yesterday in Game 1 of the Triple A Skeeters DH, tossing 3.0 innings, allowing five runs (one earned) on seven hits with three strikeouts on 47 pitches...RHP Jake Odorizzi, on the IL with a right pronator muscle strain, will start for the Skeeters tonight.

MINOR LEAGUE SIGNINGS: The Astros signed minor league free agents RHP Jon Olczak and RHP Daniel Procopio...Olczak will go to Double A Corpus Christi, while Procopio will head to Class A Asheville.

MINOR LEAGUE REPORT: Only the Astros Triple A affiliate was in action yesterday, with Sugar Land being swept in a doubleheader...updates on each club: Triple A Sugar Land (7-4) lost Game 1, 6-4 , and Game 2,5-4, yesterday...CF Jose Siri hit a grand slam in the nightcap and is hitting .429 (18×42) with five doubles, four homers and 24 RBI in 10 games this season.
Double A Corpus Christi (4-7) will open a home series with Arkansas tonight.
Class AAsheville (4-7) will open a series vs. Greenville tonight with RHP Chandler Casey on the mound. - Fayetteville (6-6) will open a series at Augusta tonight.

LAST START: $5 / 13$ vs. TEX: allowed 3 runs on 4 hits with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts in a career-high tying 7.0 innings...notched his 2nd quality start of the season, other, was on April 27 vs. SEA...retired 15 of the last 16 batters he faced.
ABOUT JAVIER: the 24 -year-old right-hander is set to make his 8 th start of the season and the 18th of his MLB career.

- has posted incredible numbers on the season, a 3-1 record, a 3.08 ERA (13ER/38IP) and 44 strikeouts...also has posted a 0.97 WHIP and a .174 opponent average....among AL pitchers with $35+$ innings on the season, ranks 13th in ERA, 7th in WHIP and 9th in SO/9.
- in his career at Minute Maid Park, has posted a $6-1$ record in 11 appearances ( 10 starts)....owns a 2.31 ERA (15ER/58.1IP), a 0.86 WHIP and a .147 opponent batting average at the venue.
GONE STREAKING:extended his scoreless innings streak to 21.0 innings prior to the Meadows homer on May 2 at TB...his streak tied as the longest in the Majors this season, also reached by RHP Corbin Burnes (MIL)...it marks the longest streak by an Astro since RHP Ryan Pressly also posted a 21.0 -inning streak in 2019....t's also the longest by an Astros starter since RHP Lance McCullers Jr. posted a $22.0-$-inning streak back in 2017.
VS. OAK: is making his third start of the season and his 5th start in his career in the regular season...has a career 4.86 ERA (9ER/16.2IP) with 19 strikeouts and a. 200 opponent batting average...in 2021 vs. OAK, he's recorded a 2.08 ERA with 11 strikeouts and a 0.92 WHIP in 2 starts.
- in his last start, he tossed 5.0 scoreless innings with 3 hits, 2 walks ans 7 strikeouts.
JAVIER IN APRIL: made four starts in April, two before and two after a short stint down at the Astros Alternate Training Site (April 10-22).
- on April 22 vs. LAA, recorded his first 8 outs via the strikeout while working around a 1st-inning walk and a 3rd-inning double...per STATS, the last Astros pitcher to record his first eight outs in a game by strikeout was LHP Jim Deshaies on Sept, 23,1986 vs. LAD.
- on April 27 vs. SEA, tossed a career-high 7.0 scoreless innings allowing just 2 hits with 6 strikeouts...tossed a career-high 107 pitches, marking the 1st time he's ever thrown 100 pitches...extended his scoreless innings streak against the Mariners to 14.0 innings.
JAVIER'S ROOKIE SEASON: had a breakout 2020 rookie season that culminated with a 3rd-place finish in the 2020 AL Rookie of the Year voting...led AL rookies in ERA (3.48) and opponent batting average (.188)...named the Astros Rookie of the Year by the Houston chapter of the BBWAA.
- in 10 starts in 2020 , went $5-2$ with a 3.68 ERA (21ER/51.1IP), 18 walks and 48 strikeouts.
SECRET WEAPON: went $2-0$ with a 2.89 ERA (3ER/9.1IP), 5 walks and 13 strikeouts across 5 postseason outings in 2020, all of which were in relief.
- joined Charlie Morton (2017) as the only pitchers in Astros history to record two wins in series-clinching games in a single postseason...was the winning pitcher in the Astros ALDS Game 4 victory over the A's, and their Wild Card Series Game 2 win over the Twins.
