## THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

 MAY 192002-Astros great RHP Larry Dierker has his number 49 retired by the club in a pregame ceremony at Minute Maid Park...Dierker had an amazing Astros career that spanned his entire adult life.... he entered the league as a 17 -year old phenom with the Houston Colt . 45 s and pitched 13 seasons in Houston...after his playing days concluded, Dierker spent 17 seasons (1979-96) as the club's color commentator on radio and television broadcasts... he then jumped from the booth to the dugout, managing the Astros from 1997-2001, which included four postseason appearances.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will try to even this series at a game apiece tonight behind RHP Zack Greinke...he'll be opposed by RHP Frankie Montas, who's making his second start against the Astros this season and the ninth of his career ( $5-3,3.27$ ERA).

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP Zack Greinke has made six regular season starts against the A's since joining the Astros in the 2019 season, posting a 4-1 record and a 2.00 ERA (8ER/36IP) in those contests.. he's already had a few notable starts against the A's in his Astros career: he won his 200th career game on Aug. 18, 2019 at OAK; he started Game 4 of the 2020 ALDS, won by the Astros to clinch the series; and he picked up his first career Opening Day win this season.

ASTROS+: The Astros (+55) run differential ranks third in the Majors, trailing the White Sox (+72) and Dodgers ( +59 )...in their last 25 games, the Astros are $16-8$ with a +56 run differential.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros had their season-best six-game winning streak snapped last night, but are still 17-8 dating back to April 22, and have won six of their seven series played since that date...the club's winning streak was the longest active in the Majors .

BEAT THE BEST: The Astros are 10-7 against teams with .500 -or-better records...in the Majors, only the Red Sox (9-6) and Blue Jays (13-9) have posted a better winning percentage against said opponents.

TAMING THE WEST: The Astros are 19-9 against the AL West this season, with winning records against all four divisional foes: OAK (5-3), LAA (6-3), SEA (4-3) and TEX (4-0)...the Astros are in the midst of 13 consecutive games against the AL West, going 6-2 so far.
vs. OAK: This series is the Astros first trip back to the Coliseum since sweeping a four-game series from the A's in Oakland on opening weekend...on the season, the Astros are 5-3 through the first eight games of a scheduled 19 between the two clubs.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros had their sixgame winning streak snapped last night by the A's, who scored one run in each of the last four innings for a 6-5 walkoff win...DH Yordan Alvarez hit a two-run double in the 1st and RF Kyle Tucker tacked on a long solo homer in the 4th, but the Astros weren't able to hold late...RHP Cristian Javier tossed 6.0 innings in his start, allowing three runs with nine strikeouts.

BOMBS AWAY!: RF Kyle Tucker hit his club-leading 10th homer of the season last night, a 459' shot to deep right field, the longest homer of his career....it was also the longest homer by an Astro this season, topping the 447 ft . shot by C Jason Castro on April 14 vs. DET, and the longest by an Astro since SS Carlos Correa hit a 461 ft . homer on Sept. 6, 2020 at LAA.

THE STAND: On Sunday, the Astros completed a season-long, 10-game homestand, in which they went 8-2 against TOR (2-1), LAA (2-1) and TEX (4-0)...this marked their best 10-game homestand since also going 8-2 in a 10-gamer from Aug. 19-29, 2019.

TONIGHT'S AVAILABILITIES: Astros pregame availabilities will be from 5:30-6:30 p.m. CT today with Dusty Baker available at approx. 5:30 p.m. CT... the postgame availabilities will be immediately after tonight's game and will be available at the same link:

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (221), OPS (.767), average (.268) and in hits (385), while ranking second in SLG (.434), tied for second in doubles (81) and third in OBP (.333)...they've also recorded the fewest strikeouts (295) in the Majors.

THE HITMAN: With two hits last night, 2B Jose Altuve moved into sole possession of fifth place on the franchise's all-time hits list.

STREAKING: 2B Jose Altuve has an active 12game hitting streak heading into tonight's game, in which he's hitting $.400(20 \times 50)$ with two doubles, three homers and eight RBI...Altuve's current streak ties as the longest in the Majors this season, and is his personal best since hitting safely in a career-long 19 straight games from July 2-28, 2017.

KING TUCK: RF Kyle Tucker has been one of the Astros hottest hitters in their last 11 games, as he's hitting $.375(15 \times 40)$ with two doubles, a triple, five homers and 13 RBI in that time span....he's raised his season OPS over 275 points, from . 599 to .789 .

GOING FOR 800: RHP Joe Smith has made 799 apps., the most among active players, and is looking to become the 51 st pitcher in MLB history to reach 800 ... among relievers, Smith ranks 40th in MLB history in apps., one shy of RHP Francisco Cordero $(800 \mathrm{~g})$.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad consists of two: RHP Tyler Ivey and C Garrett Stubbs.

ON THE MEND: RHP Jake Odorizzi, on the IL with a right pronator muscle strain, made his first rehab start last night for Triple A Sugar Land, tossing 3.0 innings and 57 pitches....he followed LHP Framber Valdez, on the IL with a left index finger fracture, who made his first rehab start for Sugar Land on Monday, tossing 3.0 innings, allowing five runs (one earned) on seven hits with three strikeouts on 47 pitches.

KEEP CHUGGING: the future Hall of Famer is in his 18th Major League season...was the Astros Opening Day starter, his 5th Opening Day assignment (also, 2010, 2016, 2017, 2019).

- owns a share the club with 5 quality starts in his 9 turns so far this season... Houston is $7-2$ in his outings.
- is the only Astros starter to take every turn in the rotation this season... leads the club in starts (9) and innings (51.2)...ranks 9th in the AL in IP.
- tonight's start will mark the 469th of his Major League career, the most among active Major Leaguers...ranks 71st in MLB history in career starts...immediately trailing Vic Willis (471 starts) on that list.
vs. OAK: will face the A's for the 2nd time this season... has a career 2.77 ERA (36ER/117IP) vs. OAK with 101 strikeouts and and just 36 walks.. has gone 4-1 with a 2.00 ERA (8ER/36IP) in 6 regular season starts against the A's since joining the Astros....also started Game 4 of the 2020 ALDS vs. OAK (4ER/4.2IP) in the Astros 11-6 win, the series clincher.
- started against the A's this season on Opening Day, earning the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings, allowing just 3 hits and no walks with 4 strikeouts...the Astros won that game 8-1.
TRUE ATHLETE: has not committed an error since July 5,2019 vs. COL, going 35 consecutive starts and 205.1 innings without an error.
is 1 of 15 qualified AL pitchers without an error this season, successfully completing 5 putouts and 9 assists...leads all MLB pitchers with 3 double plays turned.
- went errorless in 2020 , while ranking $T-2 n d$ among AL pitchers in total chances (16), 2nd in putouts (9) and T-10th in assists (7).
WITH THE 'STROS: was acquired by the Astros from the D-backs along with cash considerations on July 31,2019 , minutes before the trade deadline... in exchange for Greinke, the Astros sent 4 prospects to Arizona: IF Seth Beer, RHP J.B. Bukauskas, RHP Corbin Martin and IF Joshua Rojas.
- in 31 regular season starts with the Astros since joining the club in 2019, has gone $14-5$ with a 3.72 ( 75 ER/181.1/P) and 159 strikeouts.
- since making his first start with Houston on Aug. 6, 2019, ranks among the top-10 AL pitchers in wins (3rd), innings (4th) and strikeouts (9th).
- per Elias Sports, became the 2nd pitcher in Astros history to win 11 of his first 12 decisions with the club, joining Juan Agosto.
THE 2020 CAMPAIGN: led the Astros with 12 starts, finishing 2nd among AL pitchers in Fangraphs WAR (2.1) behind only Shane Bieber (3.2).
- among AL pitchers, ranked 2nd in walks per 9.0 innings (1.21), 3rd in strikeout to walk ratio (7.44), T-4th in HR/9.0 innings (0.81), 10th in WHIP (1.13) and $\mathrm{T}-10$ th in innings pitched (67IP).
- posted a career-low $3.3 \%$ walk rate, as he walked just 9 batters in 67.0 innings pitched and 273 batters faced...walked 2 batters-or-fewer in all 12 of his starts.
