## THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY **MAY 20**

2019 - RHP Ryan Pressly tosses a scoreless inning in the Astros 3-0 win over the White Sox to extend his scoreless innings streak to 39.0 innings and 40 appearances, which dates back to Aug. 15, 2018...the streak of 40 straight scoreless appearances is a Major League record, while his streak of 39.0 consecutive scoreless innings is a franchise record and ties as the second-longest by a reliever in MLB history.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros will try to win the rubber game of this three-game series in Oakland today behind rookie RHP Luis Garcia...he'll be opposed by LHP Cole Irvin, who's gotten roughed up in two starts against the Astros this season, to the tune of an 0-2 record and a 7.45 ERA (8ER/9.2IP).

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Luis Garcia, who was ranked as the Astros No. 6 prospect entering the season, has been solid in his brief Major League career, posting a 3.23 ERA (17ER/47.1IP) in 13 career regular season games (seven starts)...he's allowed a .195 opponent batting average and a .681 OPS, while allowing just 33 hits in his 47.1 innings pitched.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros are 18-8 dating back to April 22, and have won six of their seven series played since that date...additionally, the Astros have won seven of their last eight contests, including a sixgame winning streak from May 11-16.

WHERE WE STAND: The Astros are seven games above .500, which matches their season high, and in second place in the AL West, a half game back of Oakland...a win today would move the Astros into first place for the first time since April 8, when they were 6-1.

TAMING THE WEST: The Astros are 20-9 against the AL West this season, with winning records against all four divisional foes: OAK (6-3), LAA (6-3), SEA (4-3) and TEX (4-0)...the Astros are in the midst of 13 consecutive games against the AL West, going 7-2 so far.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the Majors in runs (229), average (.271) and in hits (400), and rank second in OPS (.771), second in SLG (.435), tied for second in doubles (83) and third in OBP (.336)...they also ave the fewest strikeouts (303) in the Majors.

COLISEUM KINGS: This series is the Astros first trip back to the Coliseum since sweeping a four-game series from the A's in Oakland on opening weekend... on the season, the Astros are 6-3 against the A's, which includes a 5-1 record at the Coliseum, where they've outscored Oakland 48-16 (+32).

WINSDAY: A close game last night turned into a romp after Houston scored three in the 7th and 8th en route to an 8-1 victory in Oakland...RHP Zack Greinke was magnificent, tossing 8.0 innings, allowing just one run with a season-high eight strikeouts...1B Yuli Gurriel had a huge game, going 4x5 with two doubles and four RBI...2B Jose Altuve got the scoring started with a leadoff homer on the first pitch of the game.

LEADOFF HOMER CLUB: Including the leadoff homer by 2B Jose Altuve last night, the Astros have continued to pile up leadoff home runs in their franchise history, hitting 190 total, which ranks third in the Majors since Houston debuted as a franchise in 1962...dating back to 1990, the Astros lead the Major Leagues in that category, thanks in large part to 2B Craig Biggio (53), CF George Springer (39) and Altuve (16).

ASTROS+: The Astros (+62) rank second in the Majors in run differential, trailing CWS (+73)...in their last 26 games, the Astros are 18-8 with a +63 differential.

BOMBS AWAY!: 2B Jose Altuve hit his 138th career home run last night, which tied him with Jose Cruz for ninth in home runs in Astros history...Altuve is now just one home run shy of tying Bob Watson (139) for eighth on that all-time list.

THE HITMAN: With another two hits last night, 2B Jose Altuve moved closer to tying Cesar Cedeño for fourth place on the franchise's all-time hits list.

STREAKING: 2B Jose Altuve has an active 13game hitting streak heading into today's game, in which he's hitting .393 (22x56) with two doubles, four homers and nine RBI...Altuve's current streak is the longest in the Majors this season, and is his personal best since hitting safely in a career-long 19 straight games from July 2-28, 2017.

M-V-PIÑA: 1B Yuli Gurriel ranks second in the Majors in RBI (36), trailing only Trey Mancini (38), and tied for first in doubles (15)...among AL players, Gurriel ranks third in hits (51), third in OBP (.408), fourth in batting average, and fifth in OPS (.984).

GOING FOR 800: RHP Joe Smith has made 799 apps., the most among active players, and is looking to become the 51st pitcher in MLB history to reach 800... among relievers, Smith ranks 40th in MLB history in apps., one shy of RHP Francisco Cordero (800g).

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad consists of two this trip: RHP Tyler Ivey and C Garrett Stubbs... announced yesterday, Ivey will join the active roster tomorrow and make his Major League debut in a start.

MINOR LEAGUE REPORT: Astros minor league affiliates went 1-1 last night...updates on each club:

- Triple A Sugar Land (7-5) was off yesterday and will play their Home Opener tonight vs. El Paso.

- Class A Asheville (6-7) downed Greenville, 6-3...C Korey Lee went 2x3 with a homer and three RBI

LAST START - 5/15 vs. TEX: allowed 1 run on 5 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts in 5.0 innings...hasn't allowed more than 3 runs in any of his 7 career starts...earned his first career win becoming the third Astros pitcher to do so this season joining RHP Bryan Abreu and LHP Kent Emanuel.

**ABOUT GARCIA:** second-year, rookie swingman entered the season ranked as the Astros No. 6 prospect...has toggled between the rotation and bullpen this season, making 6 starts and 2 relief appearances...is making his 5th turn in the rotation in place of **RHP Jake Odorizzi**, who was placed on the IL on April 26.

- in his limited MLB action, he's posted a .155 opponent batting average, a .583 opponent OPS and has allowed just 33 hits in 47.1 innings... has really stymied right-handed hitters, holding them to a .130 (12x92) average and a .499 OPS.
- vs. **OAK:** is facing the Athletics for the 2nd time in his career...in his only appearance...he tossed 5.0 shutout innings, allowed just 1 hit with 2 walks and struck out 4.
- **PITCHING ARSENAL:** his cutter has been the one of his best pitches this season...has thrown it 18.6% of the time...opponent are 3x27 (.111) with 12 strikeouts...has a whiff rate of 55.7 % on the pitch along with a 27.9 put away percent.
- **GARCIA'S 2020:** is coming off a season that saw his stock rise from a relatively unknown minor leaguer to the club's No. 6 prospect, per MLB.com... after pitching in A ball in 2019, Garcia impressed so much at the club's ATS last summer that he ended up debuting for the Astros in September and eventually making a postseason start for the club.
- **POSTSEASON ACTION:** was on the Astros rosters for last year's ALDS and ALCS...made one appearance in the postseason, as he started Game 5 of the ALCS vs. TB, an eventual Astros 4-3 win...tossed 2.0 hitless and scoreless innings, walking two batters with one strikeout.
- prior to Garcia, the last American League pitcher to make his first-career postseason appearance as a starter in an LCS game was Cleveland's Ryan Merritt in Game 5 of the 2016 ALCS at TOR (0ER/4.1IP).
- became the youngest pitcher in Astros history to start a potential elimination game in the postseason...previous youngest was Lance McCullers
  Jr. (24 years, 30 days) in Game 7 of the 2017 WS at LAD (0ER/2.1IP).
