LEADING OFF: Today, the Angels play the eighth (2-5) of 10 games on a homestand against the Cleveland Indians (1-3), Minnesota Twins (1-1 doubleheader split), Oakland Athletics (0-2; May 21-23) and Texas Rangers (May 25-26)...Angels went 2-4 on last road trip to Houston (1-2) and Boston (1-2), earning their victories in the first and last games of the trip... LAA was 2-5 on last homestand against the Tampa Bay Rays (0-4) and Los Angeles Dodgers (1-1).

WELCOME BACK FANS1: Friday, the Angels announced Angel Stadium will return to full capacity beginning June 17 vs. Detroit...Single game tickets for all remaining regular season home games will go on sale to the general public on Friday, May 28th at 9:00 a.m. PT...Registered users on Angels.com will have access to a special presale beginning Thursday, May 27th at 9:00 a.m...Beginning on June 17th, in accordance with the updated California and MLB health guidelines, guests will be required to wear a mask unless they are prepared to provide proof of full vaccination or a recent negative Covid test...A complete listing of protocols and stadium policy information is available at <u>angels.com/protocols</u>.

EACH MIND MATTERS: May is Mental Health Awareness Month...Angels players will wear green bracelets today to help raise awareness for mental health and well-being... Today's Rally Monkey giveaway item is sponsored by the Orange County Health Care Agency and features a green ribbon on the monkey's jersey to help promote mental health awareness...Please visit EachMindMatters.org for more information.

<u>RO SHOW</u>: Friday night, Jose Rojas registered his first two career outfield assists...He was the first Angels outfielder with multiple assists in a game since Justin Upton on April 18, 2018 vs. Boston...Rojas also has hit 11 doubles, which is tied for the most in Angels history after 32 career games (also, Howie Kendrick and John Doherty).

ROSTER MOVES: Yesterday, the Angels reinstated RHP Junior Guerra from the injured list...Following Friday night's game, LHP Dillon Peters was optioned to Triple-A Salt Lake.

WINS AND LOSSES: Angels have fallen to a season-low eight games under .500 (19-27)...Halos look to avoid being swept for a second time this season (swept by Rays in four game series May 3-6)...LAA stayed at or above .500 through their first 18 games of a season for the first time since 2005, but have been under .500 since May 3.

FOUR SCORE: Angels are 18-8 when scoring 4+ runs this season and are 1-19 when scoring three-or-fewer.

LEAGUE LEADERS:

Shohei Ohtani leads the Majors in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (104)...He is tied for second in the Majors (leads A.L.) with 14 home runs and three triples...He's also sixth in slugging (.619), tied for seventh in runs scored (32) and is tied for eighth in RBI (34).

Jared Walsh ranks eighth in the American League in batting average (.318) and OPS (.943), is tied for eighth in hits (50) and is 10th in RBI (32).

THAT'S RIGHT: Angels have recorded 15 of their 19 wins this season in games against a right-handed starting pitcher... Halos are 4-10 this season when the opposing primary pitcher is left-handed (4-7 vs. left-handed starters; plus **three** games where left-handed primary pitcher followed a right-handed starter).

TROUT TO THE IL: Tuesday, the Angels placed OF Mike Trout on the injured list with a right calf strain...An estimated return to play is 6-8 weeks...At the time of his IL placement, he led the Majors in OBP (.466) and OPS (1.090) and ranked fourth (led A.L.) in slugging percentage (.624).

HOO-RAY GOOSE: This week, **Phil Gosselin** earned his Bachelor's Degree in Economics from the University of Virginia...Gosselin remains the Cavaliers all-time single-season hits leader (100 in 2010) and ranks seventh in school history in career doubles (50) and ninth in career stolen bases (48).

GLOVE HURTS: Angels have made a Major League leading 38 errors this season, but have gone errorless in nine of last 13 games...Halos are 4-16 when committing an error in 2021... LAA has had five games this season with 3+ errors (most in Majors)...Halos committed 36 errors during 60-game 2020 season.

VS. OAKLAND: Today's game marks the third (0-2) of 19 meetings this season between the Angels and A's (10 at Angel Stadium & nine at the Coliseum)...Angels look to avoid being swept by A's in a three-game series for the first time since Sept. 4-5, 2019 at the Coliseum...Last time A's swept three-game series at Angel Stadium was April 9-11, 2013.

AGAINST THE A's: In 35 career games against the A's, David Fletcher is batting .320 (40/125) with seven doubles, one home run and 10 RBI...Shohei Ohtani has hit eight career home runs against the A's, which is tied for his most against any opponent (also has 8 HR vs. Texas).

GET READY FOR TAKEOVER: Tuesday's game vs. Texas will be the second "Player Takeover" television broadcast of the season on Bally Sports West...Mark Gubicza and José Mota will be joined by Angels Hall of Famer Bobby Grich on the television call.

<u>HEY BABE:</u> Shohei Ohtani is the first player to make multiple pitching starts in a season while also leading MLB in home runs since Boston's **Babe Ruth** in 1919...Three of Ohtani's pitching starts this year have come while he held at least a share of the Major League home run lead.

MAKE IT MAJOR: Mike Trout is one of six Major League players featured in large photos outside of Major League Baseball's new headquarters in New York City...The building is located directly across the street from Radio City Music Hall.

RANGERS ON DECK: Following an off day tomorrow, the Angels will conclude the homestand with a pair of games against the Texas Rangers...The 2021 season series is tied 3-3...Rangers won two of three games at Angel Stadium from April 19-21 and Angels won two of three games at Globe Life Field from April 26-28.

Went 2-0 with a 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP - 3 ER) in three starts vs. Oakland in 2020

TODAY'S GAME: Making ninth start of the season and fifth at home...Is in seventh Major League season and second with Angels.

- SUPPORT ME: Has received an average of 1.66 runs of support per nine innings this season, which is lowest two total runs while Bundy was in the game across his last five starts (24.1 IP) and none in his last three. ...LAA has scored SEEKING A 'W': Has gone eight straight starts without a winning decision...The streak marks second-longest
- winless drought of career (had 9 start winless streak from Sept. 18, 2018 Apr. 28, 2019 for Orioles).
- AST TIME OUT: Charged with loss in last start on May 15 at Boston after tossing 4+ innings and allowing season-high seven earned runs on eight hits with two walks and three strikeouts...Marked most runs allowed since July 12, 2019 for Baltimore vs. Tampa Bay (also 7 R).
- "K" NOTES: Recorded 700th career strikeout on April 19 at Texas (vs. Joey Gallo)...Tallied 10 strikeouts in home start on April 6 vs. Houston, which marked ninth career 10+ strikeout game and fourth with Angels.
- THREE AND OUT: Has held opponents batting third in the order to a .209 (70/335) average for his career... Opposing hitters in the third batting order position were 3-for-31 (.097) last season, but they are 7-for-22 (.318) this year.
- KEEP IT IN THE YARD: In his career, Bundy is 25-13 with a 2.21 ERA (313.1 IP 77 ER) in games where he does not allow a home run (67 games, 46 starts), compared with a 19-40 record and 6.48 ERA (410 IP 295 ER) when yielding at least one homer (79 games, 76 starts).
- GOOD DAY: Since 2020, is 4-3 with a 3.92 ERA (59.2 IP 26 ER) and 66 strikeouts across 10 starts in day games, compared with a 2-5 record and 4.93 ERA (49.1 IP - 27 ER) and 52 strikeouts in nine night games.
- VS. OAKLAND: In eight career games (seven starts) against the Athletics, is 4-1 with a 3.45 ERA (44.1 IP 17 ER) and 59 strikeouts...In his three starts against the A's last year, was 2-0 with a 1.40 ERA (19.1 IP - 3 ER), 23 strikeouts and two walks...Worked seven scoreless innings in last home start vs. A's on Aug. 11, 2020.
- AT ANGEL STADIUM: Is 4-6 with a 5.88 ERA (75 IP 49 ER) in 15 career games (14 starts) at the ballpark...After four starts this year, is 0-2, with a 7.08 ERA (20.1 IP 16 ER)...In seven home starts at The Big A last season, was 3-3 with a 4.38 ERA (37 IP 18 ER)...In four games (three starts) at Angel Stadium, while pitching for Baltimore, went 1-1 with a 7.64 ERA (17.2 IP 15 ER) and 17 SO.
- OPENING DAY STARTER: Made second career Opening Day start (first with the Angels after previously getting the nod in 2018 with Baltimore)...Became the Angels sixth different Opening Day starter in the last seven years (2020-Andrew Heaney, 2019-Trevor Cahill, 2018 & 2016-Garrett Richards, 2017-Ricky Nolasco, 2010-15-Jered Weaver).
- **2020 RECAP:** Finished ninth in American League Cy Young Award voting...Ranked among A.L. leaders with six wins (T4th), a 1.04 WHIP (5th), a .208 (51/245) batting average against (6th), a 3.29 ERA (65.2 IP 24 ER) (9th) and 72 strikeouts (T9th)...Recipient of 2020 Nick Adenhart Award, which is voted on by Angels players to recognize the top pitching performer for the season.
- YEAR TWO HALO: Acquired by Angels from Baltimore on Dec. 4, 2019 in exchange for RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Isaac Mattson, RHP Kyle Brnovich and RHP Zach Peek.
- CAREER NOTES: Made Major League debut for Baltimore Sept. 23, 2012 at 19 years, 313 days old...Native of Tulsa, OK...Originally selected by Orioles in first round (fourth overall) in 2011 First-Year Player Draft... Ranked as Orioles #1 prospect according to Baseball America, from 2012-16.
