Kyle Seager's 292 career doubles are now only 3 doubles away from tying Ichiro (295) for 3rd-most doubles in Mariners history...Hall of Famer Edgar Martinez holds the franchise record with 514 career doubles with Seattle.

**TONIGHT'S TILT...** the Mariners continue a 2-team, 6-game road trip tonight with the series opener against the Oakland Athletics...wrapped up a 3-game series yesterday against the San Diego Padres (0-3)...went 3-4 on the recent homestand vs. Cleveland (3-1) and Detroit (0-3)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT** Sports NW, as well as broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners are 7-8 in 15 series openers...have lost a season-high 6 consecutive games...Mariners are 9-5 in 14 one-run games...own a 6-7-2 series record in 15 series...are 10-6 in day games and 11-20 at night...are 12-12 at T-Mobile Park and 9-14 on the road...are 17-8 when scoring at least 4 runs and 4-18 when scoring 3 or fewer runs

- California Dreamin' The Mariners play their 6th of 12 consecutive road games against teams in the state of California...played a pair of games at Dodger Stadium from 5/11-5/12...wrapped up a 3-game series at San Diego (5/21-5/23)...start series in Oakland tonight (5/24-5/26), followed by a 7-game homestand and then a road series against Los Angeles-AL (6/3-6/6).

  Yesterday - Kendall Graveman was placed on the Injured List and RHP Wyatt Mills was recalled from
- Triple-A Tacoma.

  Young Man The Mariners have had the 2nd-youngest pitching staff (average age: 27.2 years) in the Majors this season, trailing only Cleveland (26.0)...the Mariners are tied for the 5th-youngest offensive team (27.4)...only Seattle and Cleveland rank in the top 5 youngest in both hitting and pitching.

  Swan Song Erik Swanson has yet to allow a run as a relief pitcher this season...allowed 1 earned run as a relief pitcher this s
- as a starter on May 8 at TEX...overall, has made 5 scoreless outings as a reliever, totaling 6.0 IP with 3
- walks and 6 strikeouts...has spun 4 consecutive scoreless outings (5/13-c).

  The R is Silent JT Chargois boasts a 2.08 ERA (2 ER, 8.2 IP) through his first 7 games with Seattle... the right-hander has walked 1 and struck out 9 since making his season debut on May 9.
- MLB Debuts 6 players have made their Major League debut with the Mariners this season: OF Taylor Trammell (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Will Vest (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Wyatt Mills (5/1 vs. LAA), RHP Logan Gilbert (5/13 vs. CLE), OF Jarred Kelenic (5/13 vs. CLE) and José Godoy (5/21 at SD).

(3/13 vs. CLE) and **Jose Goddy** (3/21 at 3D).

'SEA'TTLE...Kyle Seager is batting .452 (14x31) with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 23 RBI with runners in scoring position this season...his .452 average with RISP ranks 3rd in the Majors among players with at least 20 plate appearances with RISP (Akil Baddoo-DET, .467/7x15 and Austin Nola-SD, .467/7x15)... Seager's .935 slugging percentage with RISP leads the Majors, while his 1.422 OPS ranks 2nd to only Los Angeles-AL's Mike Trout (1.468 OPS).

THE HAMMER...Mitch Haniger is batting .257 (45x175) this season with 11 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 31 RBI, 16 walks and 45 strikeouts in 45 games...he has gotten on-base at a .314 clip, slugging .554 with an .869 OPS and a 146 OPS+ (roughly 46% better than league average)...Haniger leads the Mariners in hits (45), runs scored (32), home runs (13), RBI (31), total bases (97) and extra-base hits (25)...Haniger is 1 of 2 AL players (Nelson Cruz-MIN) to lead his team in hits, runs, home runs and RBI...the Mariners right fielder is the only AL player to lead his team in extra-base hits in addition to the aforementioned 4 categories.

#PITCHERSWHORAKE...Justin Dunn recorded his first career Major League hit in yesterday's game, an RBI double that scored Sam Haggerty...it was the 2nd hit by a Mariners pitcher in as many days, with Justus Sheffield recording his first MLB hit on Saturday at San Diego...it marks the first time that a Seattle pitcher has recorded a hit in back-to-back games since Aug. 4-5, 2015 at Colorado...Vidal Nuño III (Aug. 4) and Taijuan Walker (Aug. 5) recorded a single and double respectively...the Mariners next road series in a National League ballpark is a 2-game set from July 20-21 at Colorado.

ROAD WARRIOR...Kyle Seager has reached base safely in 20 of 23 road games this season, including 16 games with at least 1 hit...overall he is batting .314 (27x86) with 10 runs scored, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 20 RBI, 2 HBP, 7 walks and 1 stolen base in 23 road games...among American League leaders on the road, Seager ranks 2nd in doubles (8), 3rd in extra-base hits (15), T3rd in RBI (20), 6th in slugging percentage (.640) and T8th in home runs (6)...Seager's .640 road slugging percentage is +.334 points higher than his .306 slugging percentage at home.

TOUGH IN RELIEF...Kendall Graveman is 1-0 with 5 saves over 16.2 scoreless innings this season...in 14 relief appearances he has limited opponents to a .111 (6x54) average while walking 3 and striking out 17... among Major League relievers this season, Graveman ranks T1st in ERA (0.00), 3rd in WHIP (0.54), 3rd in lowest opponent slugging percentage (.130), lowest opponent on-base percentage (.172) and opponent OPS (.302).

EXTRA-BASE MADNESS...this season, 42.7% (126) of the Mariners 295 hits have gone for extra-bases (71 2B, 3 3B, 52 HR)...Seattle's 42.7% ranks 2nd in the Majors, trailing only Atlanta's 43.0% (156 XBH, 363 H)... the MLB total percentage this season is 35.7% (3,898 XBH, 10,907 H)...the Mariners highest XBH% over a full season came in 2019 at 39.9% (521 XBH, 1,305 H)...followed by the 1997 Mariners at 37.9% (597 XBH, 1,574 H) and the 1998 Mariners at 37.5% (583 XBH, 1,553 H)...Seattle's record for most XBH in a season is 607, accomplished in 1996.

BRING ON THE OFF DAY...the Mariners are in the 4th game of a stretch of 30 games over the next 31 days, May 21-June 20...their only day off during this stretch will be on Tuesday, June 7...the Mariners current stretch of 17 consecutive games May 21-June 6 is their longest stretch without a day off this season.

AS YOU KNOW...left-hander Yusei Kikuchi takes the mound tonight...he's allowed just 10 earned runs in 33.0 innings (2.73 ERA) across 6 career starts against the Oakland Athletics...the left-hander made his Major League debut against the A's at the Tokyo Dome on March 21, 2019, becoming the first Japaneseborn player to make his MLB debut on Japanese soil, but... DID YOU KNOW?...that Kikuchi has tossed a quality start in 4 of his 6 career starts against Oakland?...in his 2 starts against them last season, he combined for 12.0 scoreless innings, walking 4 and striking out 14...Kikuchi comes into tonight's start with a career-high quality start streak of 4 games...he boasts a 3.08 ERA (9 ER, 26.1 IP) with 8 walks and 33 strikeouts in that span, including a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 11 at Los Angeles-NL...Kikuchi will attempt to become just the 15th pitcher this season to toss 5 consecutive quality starts.

#### **ABOUT KIKUCHI...**

- 29-year-old left-hander is making his 9th start of the season, his 50th Major League start and his 7th career start against the Oakland Athletics
- Signed with Seattle on Jan. 2, 2019...is signed through 2021 with options through 2025.
- Native of Morioka, Japan...pitched for Hanamaki Higashi High School. Was the top pick in the 2009 NPB Draft by the Saitama Seibu Lions of Japan's Pacific League.
- In 7 seasons with Seibu, was 69-45 with a 2.69 ERA (286 ER, 956.1 IP) with 879 strikeouts and 363 walks in 148 games (144 starts)...had 13 complete games, including 7 shutouts.
- Resides in Tokyo, Japan with wife, Rumi (married in 2016), and son, Leo...Rumi previously worked as a broadcaster for NHK TV.

**LAST OUTING**...spun his 4th consecutive quality start on May 17 vs. Detroit, tossing 6.0 IP and allowing 3 runs with 4 walks and 8 strikeouts...left the game after the left the game trailing 0-3 after the 6th inning having thrown 96 pitches (60 strikes).

THAT'S QUALITY...has recorded a quality start in 4 consecutive outings dating aback to April 29 at Houston...the 4 game streak is tied for the 6th-longest active quality start streak in the Majors and is tied for the longest of Yusei's career (also: 4 GS, May 3-19, 2019).

W #1...had one of best starts of his career, tossing 7.0 shutout innings and allowing just 1 hit at HOU on April 29 in 1-0 SEA win...had a no-hitter thru 6 1/3 innings in notching his 1st W of season...allowed only a Correa opposite field double tossed season-high 95 pitches...has worked 6+ inning in 4 of 5 GS.

SEASON OPENER...ND in 2021 debut on 4/2 vs. SF...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 3 ER on 6 hits 1 walk with a career-high tying 10 strikeouts...left the game with the score tied 3-3 after the 6th inning in 3-6 Mariners loss.

TAKKKKE A SEAT...set a career high with 11 strikeouts May 11 vs. Los Angeles-NL while tossing 6.1 innings and allowing 3 earned runs on 6 hits with 1 walk...first Mariners pitcher to record 11 strikeouts in a game since James Paxton did it on July 1, 2018 against Kansas City.

START ME UP...Yusei has made 49 career starts with Seattle in his 3-year Major League career...he is currently ranks 13th in starts as a Japanese-born pitcher in the Major Leagues...he trails Mac Suzuki (1996-2005), whose 67 starts are currently 12th-most...Hideo Nomo hold the record for a Japanese-born pitcher with 318 career MLB starts...Kikuchi's 49 starts trail Hisashi Iwakuma's 136 starts (2012-17) for most in Mariners club history.

(NO) THANKS FOR YOUR SUPPORT...since start of 2020 season, Kikuchi has the lowest run support average among all qualified AL starters...he has received just 2.88 runs per game over that span...he has made 17 starts since beginning of 2020 season, and the Mariners scored 2 runs or less in 11 of them and 1 run or less in 7 games...6 runs of support Aug. 27, 2020 at SD was most runs of support he has received over this span.

2020 RECAP...went 2-4 with a 5.17 ERA (27 ER, 47.0 IP) with 20 walks and 47 strikeouts in 9 starts during his second Major League season...tossed at least 6.0 innings in 4 starts, including 3 of his last 4 starts to end the season.

# SMALL BALL...Kikuchi was 1 of 10 players in MLB to make 9-or-more starts and allow 3 or less home runs in 2020...the others include Justus Sheffield-SEA (10 GS, 2 HR), Max Fried-ATL (11 GS, 2 HR), Randy Dobnak-MIN (10 GS, 3 HR), Dallas Keuchel-CWS (11 GS, 2 HR), Brad Keller-KC (9 GS, 2 HR), Corbin Burnes-MIL (9 GS, 2 HR), Spencer Turnbull-DET (11 GS, 2 HR), Zack Wheeler-PHI (11 GS, 3 HR) and Steven Brault-PIT (10 GS, 2 HR).

HISTORIC DEBUT...with his start March 21, 2019 at Oakland in the Tokyo Dome, became the first Japanese-born player to make his Major League debut in Japan...was just his second career start (3rd appearance) as a professional in the Tokyo

COMPLETELY KIKUCHI... recorded his first career complete game shutout on August 18, 2019 at Toronto, pitching 9.0 scoreless innings and allowing only 2 hits and 1 walk with 8 strikeouts...he became just the 14th pitcher (done 17x) in club history to throw a complete game shutout within his first 30 career starts (last: Mike Montgomery, 6/30/15 at SD)...was the 4th Mariners pitcher since 2000 to throw a complete game shutout within his first 30 career starts (also: Mike Montgomery, Roenis Elías, and Gil Meche).

EARLY YEARS...the native of Morioka, Japan, pitched for Hanamaki Higashi High School...helped lead his high school to a runner-up finish at the national high school invitational in April and to the semifinals in the national championship in August before being the top pick in the 2009 NPB Draft...made his professional debut for Seibu's minor league team in 2011 and also pitched with Melbourne in the Australian Winter League that year.

JAPAN CAREER...was a 3-time NPB All-Star (2013, 2017 and 2018)...in 2017, led the Pacific League in ERA (1.97) and wins (16)...posted a 69-45 mark with a 2.69 ERA (286 ER, 956.1 IP) over 7 seasons with the Saitama Seibu Lions in Japan's Pacific League.
