Mitch Haniger's 148 OPS+ (Baseball-Reference) leads the Mariners and ranks 15th in the AL among qualified hitters. the last Seattle player to finish a season with an OPS+ of 140 or better was Nelson Cruz (149 OPS+) in 2017.

Jarred Kelenic's solo home run to lead off the 5th inning last night was Seattle's 300th hit as a team this season.

Mitch Haniger's 3rd inning single last night was his 400th career hit.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 2-team, 6-game road trip tonight with the second game of a 3-game series against Oakland (1-0)...wrapped up a 3-game series Sunday against the San Diego Padres (0-3)...went 3-4 on the recent homestand vs. Cleveland (3-1) and Detroit (0-3)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners improved to 8-8 in series openers with a 4-2 win last night...own a 6-7-2 series record in 15 series, with a chance to even their series record with a win tonight...are 10-6 in day games and 12-20 at night...are 12-12 at T-Mobile Park and 10-14 on the road...are 18-8 when scoring at least 4 runs and 4-18 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 15-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- France Is Back INF/DH Ty France was activated off the 10-day Injured List yesterday...he went 1-for-4 with a double last night in his first game action since May 13.
- Happy Birthday Donovan Walton celebrates his 27th birthday and Jake Fraley celebrates his 26th
- birthday today. **Yesterday** The Mariners claimed INF **Travis Blankenhorn** off waivers from Los Angeles-NL and assigned him to Triple-A Tacoma...INF/OF **Sam Haggerty** was placed on the 10-day Injured List (right shoulder inflammation)
- Century Mark Mitch Haniger has 100 total bases this season, which leads the Mariners, ranks T7th
- in the Majors and T5th in the American League.

 California Dreamin' The Mariners play their 7th of 12 consecutive road games against teams in the state of California...played a pair of games (0-2) at Dodger Stadium...wrapped up a 3-game series (0-3) at San Diego...continue their series (1-0) in Oakland tonight, followed by a 7-game homestand and then
- a road series against Los Angeles-AL (6/3-6/6).

 Joy Division Seattle plays its 2nd of 14 consecutive games against AL West opponents.

 MLB Debuts 6 players have made their Major League debut with the Mariners this season: OF Taylor Trammell (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Will Vest (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Wyatt Mills (5/1 vs. LAA), RHP Logan Gilbert (5/13 vs. CLE), OF Jarred Kelenic (5/13 vs. CLE) and José Godov (5/21 at SD).

BULLPEN STUDS...Erik Swanson threw a scoreless 8th inning last night, striking out the side...in 8 games (2 starts) this season, the right-hander has a 0.77 ERA (1 ER, 11.2 IP) with 5 walks and 12 strikeouts...Swanson has held opponents to a .083 batting average (3x36) with a .195 on-base percentage...right-hander **Keynan** Middleton threw a scoreless 9th inning last night, registering his 3rd save of the season...Middleton has a 3.29 ERA (5 ER, 13.2 IP) in 13 games this season...right-hander **JT Chargois** has a 2.08 ERA (2 ER, 8.2 IP) with 1 walk and 9 strikeouts in 7 games this season.

NUMBER ONE...Kyle Lewis went 1-for-2 with a home run, 2 RBI and 2 walks last night...became just the 2nd Mariners player this season to homer and draw multiple walks in a game (Mitch Haniger, Apr. 22 at BOS)...it was Lewis' 4th home run of the season and first since May 4 vs. Baltimore...since May 13, Lewis has reached base safely 20 times (8 H, 11 BB, 1 HBP) in his last 11 games...his 11 walks in that span rank T2nd in the Majors with Tommy Pham-SD, trailing only Yoán Moncada-CWS (14).

SLUGGING POSITION...the Mariners are slugging .476 (149 TB in 313 AB) with runners in scoring position this season, which ranks 2nd in the Majors (Los Angeles-AL, .494)...Mitch Haniger's 1st inning double last night with Jarred Kelenic on second base was Seattle's 40th extra-base hit with RISP, which ranks T7th in MLB...Seattle's 148 tOPS+ (Baseball-Reference) with RISP (roughly 48% percent better relative to their total OPS) ranks 1st in the Majors.

MIGHTY MITCH...Mitch Haniger is batting .263 (47x179) this season with 12 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 32 RBI, 16 walks and 45 strikeouts in 45 games...he has gotten on-base at a .318 clip, slugging .559 with an .877 OPS and a 148 OPS+ (roughly 48% bester than league average)...Haniger leads the Mariners in hits (47), runs scored (33), home runs (13), RBI (32), total bases (100) and extra-base hits (26)...Haniger is 1 of 2 AL players (Nelson Cruz-MIN) to lead his team in hits, runs, home runs and RBI...he recorded both his 100th total base of the season and 400th career Major League hit with his 3rd inning single last night.

NOTHING GETS BY J.P....J.P. Crawford is tied for 2nd in the Majors with his 1.1 defensive WAR (*Baseball-Reference*), tied with Ryan McMahon-COL and trailing only Isiah Kiner-Falefa-TEX (1.2 dWAR)...Crawford also ranks 2nd in defensive assists (131) to Kiner-Falefa (149)...his 64 putouts are tied for 1st among MLB shortstops with Kiner-Falefa...Crawford's 7 defensive runs saved (*FanGraphs*) rank 2nd to Kiner-Falefa (8).

J.K. HOMERS, WALKS...Jarred Kelenic went 1-for-4 with a pair of runs scored, his 2nd career home run and a walk...his 5th inning solo home run came off Oakland starting pitcher Frankie Montas and was Kelenic's first home run since May 14 vs. Cleveland in his 2nd career game...at 21 years and 312 days old, Kelenic became the youngest Seattle player to homer and walk in the same game since José López (20 years, 294 days old) accomplished the feat on Sept. 13, 2004 vs. Anaheim.

SEAGER SPLITS...Kyle Seager is batting .229 (40x175) with 18 runs, 12 doubles, 1 triple, 9 home runs, 30 RBI, 1 stolen base, 17 walks and 45 strikeouts in 48 games this season...he's slugging .463 with a .764 OPS and a 117 OPS+ (roughly 17% better than league average)...Seager is batting .438 (14x32) with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 23 RBI with runners in scoring position this season, with his .438 average ranking 2nd in the Majors (Vladimir Guerrero Jr.-TOR, .457/21x46)...Seager's .906 slugging percentage with RISP leads the Majors, while his 1.380 OPS with RISP ranks 2nd in MLB (Mike Trout-LAA, 1.468)...in 24 road games this season, Seager is batting .300 (27x90) with 10 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 6 home runs, 20 RBI and 7 walks...his .611 road slugging percentage ranks 9th in MLB.

HIGHEST XBH%...5 (3 2B, 2 HR) of Seattle's 6 hits last night were of the extra-base variety...this season, 43.5% (131) of the Mariners 301 hits have gone for extra-bases (74 2B, 3 3B, 54 HR)...Seattle's 43.5% leads the Majors, ranking ahead of 2nd place Atlanta's 43.0% (156 XBH, 363 H)...the MLB total percentage this season is 35.8% (3,953 XBH, 11,034 H)...the Mariners highest XBH% over a full season came in 2019 at 39.9% (521 XBH, 1,305 H)...followed by the 1997 Mariners at 37.9% (597 XBH, 1,574 H) and the 1998 Mariners at 37.5% (583 XBH, 1,553 H)...Seattle's record for most XBH in a season is 607, accomplished in 1996.

AS YOU KNOW...Erik Swanson came into last night's game in the 8th inning and struck out the side after inheriting a baserunner and walking the first batter he faced, but...DID YOU KNOW?...that Swanson became the first Mariners reliever to inherit a baserunner with 0 outs and strike out the side since 2019?.. left-hander Tommy Milone on Aug. 4, 2019 at Houston was the last Seattle reliever to accomplish the feat before Swanson did it last night...Milone struck out the side in relief of Sam Tuivailala.

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT.

- 24-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make the 3rd start of his Major League career, his first vs. the Athletics.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau.
- Named to the Mariners 60-man roster prior to the start of the 2020 season...spent season playing at the Mariners Alternate site in Tacoma.
- In 2019, split season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/14), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 ER, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts in first professional season
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Con-
- Among all minor league pitchers in 2019, ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), T7th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners farmhands

LAST OUTING...L#2 in last start in Mariners 6-2 loss to the Tigers on May 19...allowed 3 earned runs on 4 hits while walking and striking out 2 in 2.2 innings.

MLB DEBUT...made his MLB debut on May 13 vs. Cleveland to open the current homestand...threw 4.0 innings and allowed 4 earned runs on 5 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts and 2 home runs in 4-2 loss...was tagged with the loss...tossed 71 pitches (52 strikes) and two wild pitches...threw his first career strikeout in the 3rd inning against Céasar Hernández...became the 42nd Mariners pitcher to start a Major League debut and the first since Justin Dunn on Sept. 12, 2019 vs. Cincinnati.

LAST MILB OUTING ... earned his 1st win of the minor league season in last outing on May 7 vs. El Paso Chi-huahuas...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed 1 run on 4 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts in 8-2 Rainier win over the Chihuahuas...left the game with a 3-1 lead after the 5th inning having thrown 77 pitches (47 strikes).

PROSPECT PEDIGREE...is rated as the No. 28 overall prospect on MLB Pipeline's 2021 Top-100 Prospects List...is the highest rated pitching prospect to appear for the Mariners since Taijuan Walker (No. 4) made his debut in the 2013 season.

2021 SPRING TRAINING RECAP...made 1 Cactus League start in this spring against the Los Angeles Angels...threw 2.0 innings, giving up 1 earned run on 2 hits with 4 strikeouts.

TAKING HOME THE HARDWARE...during the 2019 season, was named Pitcher of the Week twice en route to being named an All-Star for both the California (Single-A) League and Texas (Double-A) League, as well as an MiLB. com Organizational All-Star...rated as the #4 Prospect in the Texas League and the #7 Prospect in the California League by Baseball America following

STINGY...has allowed 3 runs or less in 25 of 27 professional appearances, including 20 appearances of 2 runs or less, 16 1-run appearances and 10 scoreless outings...tallied 3 consecutive scoreless outings from Aug. 13-24, 2019, spanning 17.0 IP, while walking 5 and striking out 22...held opponents to a .145 batting average against during that span.

ALMOST A DOZEN...tallied a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 19, 2019 with Modesto at the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed only 2 hits without issuing a walk...has struck out at least 5 batters in 22 of 27 career minor league starts.

GILBERT vs. OAKLAND

Gilbert is making his first career appearance against Oakland... has never faced any Oakland batters

PITCHER OF THE YEAR...received the Jamie Moyer Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award following the 2019 season...was honored in a pregame ceremony at T-Mobile Park along with other minor league award winners in the Mariners farm system on Sept. 27, 2019.

2019 RECAP...made his professional debut, splitting the season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/13), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 Er, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts professional season...limited opponents to a .198 (95x481) average, while walking 33 and striking out 165...among all minor league pitchers (min 125.0 IP), ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), T7th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners farmhands

AMONG STETSON ROYALTY...Gilbert is 1 of 4 active Stetson University players in the Major Leagues, joining Jacob deGrom, Corey Kluber, and Patrick Mazeika, which places Gilbert alongside 2 Cy Young Award winners...was the first pitcher from Stetson to be taken in the 1st round, and 1st Hatters 1st-rounder since 2003 (Brian Snyder)...drafted as highest pick in Stetson history at #14...during his 3 seasons with Stetson, Gilbert was 23-3 with a 2.48 ERA... started in 33 of his 52 appearances, and pitched a total of 250.2 innings for the Hatters...ranks 1st in Stetson history for lowest opponent batting average (.201), 2nd in most strikeouts per 9 innings (11.24), 4th in most strikeouts (313), and 1st in most strikeouts looking (84)...in final season with the Hatters, he ranked 1st in the nation in fewest hits allowed per 9 innings (5.4), 2nd in total strikeouts (163), 4th in FRA (2.72) and 4th in WHIP (0.80) 4th in ERA (2.72), and 4th in WHIP (0.80).

CAREER...selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau...has appeared in parts of 2 Minor League seasons in the Mariners organization (2019 & 2021), going 11-5 with a 2.12 ERA (33 ER, 140 IP) with 33 walks and 170 strikeouts in 27 career starts.
