#### **INSIDE THE NUMBERS**

Robert Dugger is making his 2nd start of the season...tossed 3.0 scoreless innings with 1 walk and 4 strikeouts in his first start on May 16 vs. CLE, leading the Mariners to a 3-2 win against Cleveland starter Shane Bieber.

The Mariners lead the Majors with 45 players (25 pitchers) used this season, ranking ahead of Los Angeles-AL (44 players), Milwaukee (44 players) and Pittsburgh (43 players).

Mariners pitcher JT Chargois fielded an infield popup with a launch angle of 76 degrees in the 8th inning of last night's game, the 2nd-highest launch angle ever fielded by a Mariners pitcher in the Statcast era...he trails only **Marco** Gonzales who snagged a popup of 80 degrees on Aug. 8, 2020 vs. TEX.

Mitch Haniger's 143 OPS+ (Baseball-Reference) leads the Mariners and ranks T16th in the AL among qualified hitters...the last Seattle player to finish a season with an OPS+ of 140 or better was Nelson Cruz (149 OPS+) in 2017.

**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners wrap up the current 2-team, 6-game road trip today with the final game of a 3-game series against Oakland (2-0)...finished a 3-game series Sunday against the San Diego Padres (0-3)... following today's game, will return home to T-Mobile Park for a 7-day, 7-game homestand vs. Texas (4 G) and Oakland (4 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN** Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have won back-to-back games...own a 7-7-2 series record in 16 series, with a chance to secure their first series sweep of the season today...are 10-6 in day games and 13-20 at night...are 12-12 at T-Mobile Park and 11-14 on the road...are 19-8 when scoring at least 4 runs and 4-18 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 16-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- Fun in the Sun The Mariners are 10-6 (.625) in day games this season, compared to 13-20 (.393) at night...Seattle's .625 winning percentage in day games ranks T4th-best in the Majors (also: Toronto), trailing only San Francisco (13-5, .722), Tampa Bay (12-6, .667) and San Diego (10-5, .667).

- birthday today.

  Nous Aimons Ty Ty France is 3-for-8 with 1 double and 1 RBI since returning from the 10-day IL on May 24.

  Game-by-Game The Mariners won the 2nd game of a series in last night's game for only the 4th time
- this season, improving to 4-12 on the year in game 2 of series...are 8-5 in game 3 of series this year. **California Dreamin'** The Mariners play their 8th of 12 consecutive road games against teams in the state of California...played a pair of games (0-2) at Dodger Stadium...wrapped up a 3-game series (0-3) at San Diego...continue their series (2-0) in Oakland today, followed by a 7-game homestand and then a road series against Los Angeles-AL (6/3-6/6).

  Joy Division - Seattle plays its 3rd of 14 consecutive games against AL West opponents.
- MLB Debuts 6 players have made their Major League debut with the Mariners this season: OF Taylor Trammell (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Will Vest (4/1 vs. SF), RHP Wyatt Mills (5/1 vs. LAA), RHP Logan Gilbert (5/13 vs. CLE), OF Jarred Kelenic (5/13 vs. CLE) and José Godoy (5/21 at SD).

STREAKING...J.P. Crawford has hit safely in 5 consecutive games dating back to May 19...during that span, he is batting .421 (8x19), with 1 run, 3 doubles and 1 walk...the streak is tied for his second longest of the season, trailing only an 8-game streak from April 10-17...in 41 games since April 10, is batting .279 (38x136) with 16 runs, 9 doubles, 1 home run, 14 RBI and 14 walks...overall, Crawford holds a .328 onbase percentage this season, tied for 4th among all American League shortstops.

ROY STUFF...Kyle Lewis is batting .276 (21x76) with 8 runs scored, 1 double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, 14 walks and 2 stolen bases during the month of May...began the season batting .136 (3x22) in his first 6 games after returning from the Injured List...in 23 games since then, is batting .271 (23x85), improving his season batting average by 111 points from .132 to .243...since the beginning of the 2020 season, Lewis ranks 7th in Fangraphs WAR among all outfielders age 25 and younger, trailing Ronald Acuna Jr.-ATL (4.6), Trent Grisham-SD (4.1), Juan Soto-WSH (3.3), Kyle Tucker-HOU (2.7), Alex Verdugo-BOS (2.6) and Luis Robert (2.5).

THAT HURTS...the Mariners lead the American League with 15 players currently on the Injured List, ranking ahead of Toronto (10) and Tampa Bay (10)...the Mariners have had 20 players on the Injured list so far this season after tallying only 17 IL stints in 60 games during the 2020 season...since 2015, the Mariners have tallied 20+ players on the IL only one other time over the course of a full 162-game season: 2021 (21 players).

BULLISH 'PEN ... the Mariners bullpen has posted a 2.25 ERA (2 ER, 8.0 IP) with 4 walks and 11 strikeouts in the current series vs. Oakland, having received contributions from **Keynan Middleton** (1.0 ShO IP), **Anthony Misiewicz** (0.2 ShO IP), **Paul Sewald** (2.0 ShO IP), **Erik Swanson** (1.0 ShO IP), **Rafael Montero** (2.0 IP, 1 ER) and **JT Chargois** (1.1 IP, 1 ER)...the 'pen had posted a 7.92 ERA (22 ER, 25.0 IP) during the club's 6-game losing streak from May 17-23, which was snapped on Monday's series opener.

MIGHTY MITCH...Mitch Haniger is batting .257 (47x183) this season with 12 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 32 RBI, 16 walks and 45 strikeouts in 45 games...he has gotten on-base at a .315 clip, slugging .546 with an .862 OPS and a 143 OPS+ (roughly 43% better than league average)...Haniger leads the Mariners in hits (47), runs scored (34), home runs (13), RBI (32), total bases (100) and extra-base hits (26)...Haniger is 1 of 2 AL players (Nelson Cruz-MIN) to lead his team in hits, runs, home runs and RBI.

NOTHING GETS BY J.P....J.P. Crawford is tied for 2nd in the Majors with 6 Defensive Runs Saved (Fangraphs), tied with Kyle Tucker-HOU and trailing only Isiah Kiner-Falefa-TEX (8 DRS)...Crawford also ranks 2nd in defensive assists (133) to Kiner-Falefa (149)...Crawford's 66 putouts are tied for 1st among MLB shortstops with Miguel Rojas...Crawford has not committed an error over his last 39 total chances, spanning 11 games... is 1 of 8 qualified Major League shortstops to have not committed an error in that span (May 13-c).

HIGHEST XBH%...this season, 42.6% (133) of the Mariners 312 hits have gone for extra-bases (76 2B, 3 3B, 54 HR)...Seattle's 42.6% ranks 2nd the Majors, trailing only Atlanta's 42.9% (159 XBH, 371 H)...the MLB total percentage this season is 35.8% (4,033 XBH, 11,257 H)...the Mariners highest XBH% over a full season came in 2019 at 39.9% (521 XBH, 1,305 H)...followed by the 1997 Mariners at 37.9% (597 XB 1,574 H) and the 1998 Mariners at 37.5% (583 XBH, 1,553 H)...Seattle's record for most XBH in a season is 607, accomplished in 1996.

**BRING ON THE OFF DAY**...the Mariners are in the 6th game of a stretch of 30 games over the next 31 days, May 21-June 20...their only day off during this stretch will be on Tuesday, June 7...the Mariners current stretch of 17 consecutive games May 21-June 6 is their longest stretch without a day off this season.

#### ABOUT DUGGER ...

- 25-year-old right-hander is making his 8th appearance and 2nd start of the season for the Mariners...has not faced the Oakland Athletics.
- Aquired via waivers from Miami on Dec. 7, 2020
- Born in Tucson, AZ...attended Tomball HS (Tomball, TX)...pitched two years at Cisco Junior College before transferring to Texas Tech, where he earned Honorable mention All-Big-12 in his one season with the Red Raiders.
- Selected by Seattle in the 18th round of the 2016 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Texas Tech.
- Traded to the Miami Marlins along with Crhis Torres an Nick Neidert in exchange for Dee Strange-Gordon on December 7, 2020.

**LAST START**...his last start came on May 16 vs. Cleveland, tossing 3.0 scoreless innings with no hits allowed, 1 walk and 4 strikeouts in his first career start in a Seattle uniform...was Dugger's first start since July 26, 2020 in his season debut with Miami.

MULTI-INNING MANIA....Mariners relievers have recorded 18 relief appearances of 2.0 innings or more without allowing a run....Dugger has achieved this feat twice, the last on May 13 against Cleveland...Mariners are tied for most individual relief outings (18) of at least 2.0 scoreless innings in the Maiors with Texas.

#### **DUGGER VS. OAKLAND**

Dugger is making his 1st career appearance against the Athletics...has also never faced any of Oakland's current offensive players.

ALTERNATE SITE... Dugger began the 2021 season at the Alternate Training Site... was recalled on April 15 as the 27th man for a double-header against the Orioles...recalled from Alternate Training Site on April 26, making his season debut that night in relief.

MARINERS DEBUT...Made his Mariner debut on April 26 against Houston...Worked 2.0 scorless innings, allowing just 2 hits.

**2020 RECAP**... Posted a 12.66 ERA (15 ER,10.2 IP) with 4 strikeouts and 3 walks in 4 games with Miami last season...was recalled on July 26 for his first stint with the big league club.

**BACK IN COLLEGE**...pitched in relief for Texas Tech against an Oklahoma State team that featured current Mariners teammate Donovan Walton, who batted thrid and played Shortstop for the Cowboys...Dugger got Walton to fly out to right field to start the 6th inning.

FIRST MLB START...Made Major League debut on August 5, 2019 against New York-NL while with Miami...worked 5.0 innings, allowing 6 earned runs on 5 hits, walked 4 while striking out 3.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER...Dugger has appeared in 91 games across 4 minor league seasons, making 72 starts...has a 26-24 overall record, with a 3.84 ERA (184 ER, 431.1 IP)...struck out 417 batters while only walking 124...has been named a mid-season All-Star three times (2017 with Clinton, 2018 with Jupiter and 2019 with Jacksonville.)

**CAREER**...has appeared in 18 career games (9 starts, 9 relief appearances) with Miami (2019-20) and Seattle (this season)...is 0-4 with a 6.67 ERA (43 ER, 58.0 IP) with 23 walks and 44 strikeouts in his Major League career.

#### TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP CHRIS FLEXEN (4-2, 5.09)
