TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue the current 7-day, 7-game homestand with the 1st of 3 games vs. the Oakland Athletics...began the homestand with a 4-game series sweep of the Texas Rangers (4-0)... following Wednesday's series finale, will embark on an 11-day, 10-game road trip at Los Angeles-AL (4 G), Detroit (3 G) and Cleveland (3 G)...today's game will be televised on **ROOT Sports NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners have won a season-high 4 consecutive games...have won 6 of their last games...own an 8-7-2 series record...are 11-7 in day games and 16-20 at night...are 16-12 at T-Mobile Park and 11-15 on the road...are 21-8 when scoring at least 4 runs and 6-19 when scoring 3 or fewer runs... are 19-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **Our House** The Mariners are 16-12 (.556) at home this season, compared to 11-15 on the road... Seattle pitchers have posted a 3.56 ERA (100 ER, 253.0 IP) at home, while holding a 5.23 ERA (120 ER, 206.2 IP) on the road...Seattle's 3.56 home ERA is 4th-best in the American League.
- **Brooms -** The Mariners are coming off a 4-game series sweep vs. Texas, their first series sweep of the season. **First Pitch Strikes** the Mariners rank 4th in the American League with a 61.4% first pitch strike rate, trailing only Oakland (62.8%), Tampa Bay (62.0%) and New York (61.8%).
- Control the Zone Mariners hitters are batting .247 when ahead in the count this season, compared to .155 when behind in the count...are batting .227 when the count is even.

  Fun in the Sun The Mariners own a 11-7 (.588) record in day games this season, tied for the the 4th-
- best day record in MLB (also: Toronto), trailing only San Francisco (15-6, .714), Tampa Bay (15-6, .714)
- and Milwaukee (15-8 (.652). **Prospecting** The Mariners will field 2 of the top 30 prospects (via *MLB Pipeline*) in Major League baseball during today's game: **Jarred Kelenic** (#4) and **Logan Gilbert** (#27). **Fanning the Flames** - The Mariners are 8-1 when there are more than 9,000 fans at T-Mobile Park this
- ..are 8-11 with less than 9,000 fans in attendance.

WINNING STREAK...the Mariners have won a season-high 4 consecutive games...marks the first time the Mariners last won 4+ consecutive games since Aug. 30-Sept. 7, 2020, when they won a 2020 season-high 6 consecutive games...Seattle's active 4-game game winning streak is tied for the longest active streak in the Majors (also: Chicago-AL, Tampa Bay, New York-NL and Milwaukee)...during the streak, the Mariners are batting .242 (29x120), with 5 doubles and 6 home runs and 8 walks, while averaging 3.75 runs/game.

FOR STARTERS...excluding the bullpen day on May 26 in Oakland, the Mariners starting rotation has allowed 2 runs or less in 6 consecutive starts...in the those 6 starts Seattle starters are 4-0 with a 2.10 ERA (8 ER, 34.1 IP) with 8 walks and 27 strikeouts...Mariners starting pitchers have allowed 3 runs or less in 10 consecutive starts at T-Mobile Park, and 14 of their last 15 home starts...during that 15-game span (5/2-current), Seattle starters have posted a 2.88 ERA (25 ER, 78.0 IP) with 26 walks and 73 strikeouts.

BRING ON THE WEST...after going 6-14 vs. American League West opponents to begin the 2020 season, the Mariners are 26-14 over their last 40 games vs. the division (8/21/20-c)....today marks the 8th of 14 consecutive games for the Mariners against AL West Division opponents (6-1)...overall this season, the Mariners are 12-8 against AL West opponents...are 4-2 in series against the AL West this season...went 4-5-3 in series against the AL West in 2020, posting a 20-20 record overall.

MEMORIAL DAY...the Mariners have won 7 consecutive games on Memorial Day dating back to 2013... did not play on Memorial Day in 2020 due to the postponement of the season...today marks the 2nd matchup between the A's and the Mariners on Memorial Day (previous: 2009 in Oakland)...overall, Seattle holds a 28-12 (.700) all-time record on Memorial Day...the Mariners have been off on Memorial Day 5 times: 1979, 1993, 1996, 2002 and 2003.

HEAT UP THE BATS...the Mariners have tallied 6+ hits in 9 consecutive games and are batting .242 (71x293) with 17 doubles, 9 home runs, and 19 walks during that span (5/22-c)...the .242 average since May 22 ranks 8th-best in the Majors...prior to May 22, Seattle was batting just .197 (277x1407) in 45 games, ranking last in the Majors...in the 9 games since May 22, the Mariners have raised their season batting average by 8 points from .197 to .205.

THE BULLY-PEN...the Mariners bullpen has posted a 1.48 ERA (4 ER, 24.1 IP) with 10 walks and 29 strikeouts over the last 7 games (5/24-current)...in that span, the 1.48 ERA by Seattle relievers leads the American League, ranking ahead of Oakland's 1.50 ERA (3 ER, 18.0 IP)...the Mariners have used 10 different relievers during that 7-game stretch: Rafael Montero (4.0 IP), Paul Sewald (4.0 IP), Keynan Middleton (3.2 IP), Robert Dugger (3.1 IP), JT Chargois (2.2 IP), Erik Swanson (2.1 IP), Yohan Ramirez (2.0 IP), Wyatt Mills (1.2 IP) and Daniel Zamora (1.1 IP).

TOM MURPH'S A's...Tom Murphy has reached base safely in all of his 11 career games against Oakland, including hits in 9 of those 11 games...in 9 games against Oakland as a Mariner, is batting .333 (9x27) with 2 runs scored, 1 double, 1 home run, 3 RBI, 3 walks, a .387 on-base percentage and a .481 slugging percentage (.869 OP)...has appeared in 2 games (1 start) vs. the A's this season, going 1-for-5 with 1 run, 1 double, 1 RBI and 1 walk.

<u>HE'S BACK</u>...**Ty France** has reached base safely in 7 consecutive games since returning from the 10-day Injured List on May 24...during that span, is batting .375 (9x24) with 1 run, 2 doubles, 5 RBI, 2 walks, a .423 on-base percentage and a .458 slugging percentage (.881 OPS)...leads the Mariners in batting average (.375), hits (9) and RBI (5) and doubles (T1st, 2) during that span, while his .375 batting average also ranks tied for 6th in the American League (5/24-c).

TOTALLY KYLE...Kyle Lewis has hit safely in 8 of his last 9 games (5/22-c), batting .294 (10x34) with 7 runs, 1 double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI, 2 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch during that span...in the month of May, the center fielder is batting .274 (26x95) with 13 runs scored, 2 doubles, 3 home runs, 8 RBI and a team leading 14 walks in the month.

AS MAY YOU KNOW...the Mariners have allowed 2 runs or fewer in each of the 4 games during the current winning streak (5/27-c), but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...the current 4-game stretch marks the longest streak of 2 or fewer runs allowed by Mariners pitchers since July 25-28, 2019 (4 G)?...<u>the Mariners have tallied 5+</u> consecutive games allowing 2 runs or fewer only 9 times in club history (last: 6 G, June 23-28, 2012)... Seattle recorded a club record 7 consecutive games allowing 2 runs or less from May 16-22, 2011...during the current 4-game stretch, opponents are batting just .180 (22x122) against Mariners pitchers.

#### ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT ...

- 24-year-old right-handed pitcher is scheduled to make the 4th start of his Major League career, his second consecutive vs. the Athletics
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob
- Named to the Mariners 60-man roster prior to the start of the 2020 season...spent season pitching at Mariners Alternate site in Tacoma.
- In 2019, split season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/14), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 ER, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts in first professional season.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitche of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Among all minor league pitchers in 2019, ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), T7th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners

**LAST OUTING**...ND, leaving with 4-2 lead after 4.0 innings due to pitch count May 25 at OAK...allowed a pair of runs, and threw 32 pitches, in 2nd inning then retired 7 of last 8 BF (1 HB)...did not issue a walk for 2nd time in 3 GS.

MLB DEBUT...made his MLB debut on May 13 vs. CLE...threw 4.0 innings and allowed 4 earned runs on 5 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts and 2 home runs in 4-2 loss...was tagged with the loss...tossed 71 pitches (52 strikes) and two wild pitches...notched his first career strikeout in the 3rd inning (Céasar Hernández)...became the 42nd Mariners pitcher to start in MLB debut, the first since Justin Dunn, Sept. 12, 2019 vs. CIN.

STINGY...has allowed 3 runs or less in 27 of 30 professional appearances (2 of 3 Big League starts), including 21 appearances of 2 runs or less, 16 1-run appearances and 10 scoreless outings...tallied 3 consecutive scoreless outings from Aug. 13-24, 2019, spanning 17.0 IP, while walking 5 and striking out 22...held opponents to a .145 batting average against during that span.

LAST MILB OUTING...earned his 1st win of the minor league season in last outing on May 7 vs. El Paso Chihuahuas...tossed 5.0 innings and allowed 1 run on 4 hits and no walks with 5 strikeouts in 8-2 Rainier win...left game with 3-1 lead after the 5th inning having thrown 77 pitches (47 strikes).

PROSPECT PEDIGREE...is rated as the No. 28 overall prospect on MLB Pipeline's 2021 Top-100 Prospects List...is the highest rated pitching prospect to appear for the Mariners since Taijuan Walker (No. 4) made his debut in 2013 season.

2021 SPRING TRAINING RECAP...made 1 Cactus League start in this spring against the Los Angeles Angels...threw 2.0 innings, giving up 1 earned run on 2 hits with 4 strikeouts.

TAKING HOME THE HARDWARE...during the 2019 season, was named Pitcher of the Week twice en route to being named an All-Star for both the California (Single-A) League and Texas (Double-A) League, as well as an MiLB.com Organizational All-Star...rated as the #4 Prospect in the Texas League and the #7 Prospect in the California League by Baseball America following the season.

ALMOST A DOZEN...tallied a career-high 11 strikeouts on May 19, 2019 with Modesto at the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes...tossed 7.0 scoreless innings and allowed only 2 hits without issuing a walk...has struck out at least 5 batters in 22 of 27 career minor league starts

PITCHER OF THE YEAR ... received the Jamie Moyer Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award following the 2019 season... was honored in a pregame ceremony at T-Mobile Park along with other minor league award winners in the Mariners farm system on Sept. 27, 2019.

2019 RECAP...made his professional debut, splitting the season between A West Virginia (4/4-5/1), High-A Modesto (5/2-7/13), and Double-A Arkansas (July 15-end), going 10-5 with a 2.13 ERA (32 Er, 135.0 IP) in 26 combined starts in first professional season...limited opponents to a .198 (95x481) average, while walking 33 and striking out 165...among all minor league pitchers (min. 125.0 IP), ranked 3rd in ERA (2.13), 5th in average (.198), T7th in strikeouts (165), while his 10 wins were 2nd-most among all Mariners farmhands

AMONG STETSON ROYALTY...Gilbert is 1 of 4 active Stetson University players in the Major Leagues, joining Jacob deGrom, Corey Kluber, and Patrick Mazeika, which places Gilbert alongside 2 Cy Young Award winners...was the first pitcher from Stetson to be taken in the 1st round, and 1st Hatters 1st-rounder since 2003 (Brian Snyder)...drafted as highest pick in Stetson history at #14...during his 3 seasons with Stetson, Gilbert was 23-3 with a 2.48 ERA... started in 33 of his 52 appearances, and pitched a total of 250.2 innings for the Hatters...ranks 1st in Stetson history for lowest opponent batting average (.201), 2nd in most strikeouts per 9 innings (11.24), 4th in most strikeouts (313), and 1st in most strikeouts looking (84)...in final season with the Hatters, he ranked 1st in the nation in fewest hits allowed per 9 innings (5.4), 2nd in total strikeouts (163), 4th in ERA (2.72), and 4th in WHIP (0.80).

<u>CAREER</u>...selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau...has appeared in parts of 2 Minor League seasons in the Mariners organization (2019 & 2021), going 11-5 with a 2.12 ERA (33 ER, 140 IP) with 33 walks and 170 strikeouts in 27 career starts.

#### TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: LHP MARCO GONZALES (1-3, 5.40)

29-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 6th start of the season tomorrow night v.s Oakland, but his first since April 27 at HOU...was placed on 10-day I.A pril 29 with a left forearm strain and has missed 29 games heading into today...L#3 in last start, April 27 at HOU (6.0,5,2,2,3,4)...was 1-2, 2.50 (5 ER, 18.0 IP) in last 3 GS prior to IL stint...W#1 on April 15(#1) at BAL (5.0,3,2,2,2,5,HR); allowed 2R in HR in 1st but retired 12 of last 13 BF in 2nd-5th...L#1 April 8 at MIN (4.1,9,7,7,2,6,HB,2HR)...ND in Opening Night start on April 1 vs. SF (6.0,8,5,5,3,2,3HR); made 3rd Opening Day start in his career...is the 4th Mariners pitcher in history to make 3 or more Opening Night starts, joining Félix Hernández (11), Randy Johnson (6) and Jamie Moyer (4)...2020: Went 7-2 with a 3.10 ERA (24 ER, 69.2 IP), 64 strikeouts and 7 walks in 11 starts...led AL in walks-per-9.0-innings with a mark of 0.90 (7 BB, 69.2 IP) and strikeout-to-walk ratio with a mark of 9.14 (64 K, 7 BB)...among AL leaders, also ranked T2nd in wins (7), 3rd in WHIP (0.95), 7th in innings pitched (69.2), 8th in ERA (3.10), 79th in quelity starts (6) and 10th in opponents average against (222), was one of four pitchers to rank among the top-10 AL leaders in wins innings pitched and ERA initial Shape Rice. 10th in opponents average against (.222)...was one of four pitchers to rank among the top-10 AL leaders in wins, innings pitched and ERA, joining Shane Bieber-CLE, Gerrit Cole-NYY and Lance Lynn-TEX...CAREER: Drafted by St. Louis with 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University...made MLB debut with the Cardinals on June 25, 2014 at Colorado...was acquired from STL on July 21, 2017 in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill... is 42-30 with a 4.16 ERA (252 ER, 545.0 IP) with 443 strikeouts in 101 games (93 starts) in parts of 7 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c)...vs. OAK: Is 5-3, 3.92 (28 ER, 64.1 IP) in 11 G, 10 GS, vs. the A's...has 5 quality starts in his 10 career GS.
