HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs conclude their 6-game trip with a 2-game series @ A's.

- ◆ The D-backs have lost a club-record 17 consecutive road games.
- ◆ **Ketel Marte** is batting .531 (15-for-30) with 3 doubles, 2 home runs and 6 RBI during his 7-game hitting streak.
- ◆ Josh Reddick is hitting .415 (17-for-41)/1.003 OPS with 6 doubles and 6 RBI in his last 13 games.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona is 20-12 in its last 32 games vs. AL opponents and is 25-17 (.595) since 2019.

♦ The D-backs' .595 interleague winning pct. since 2019 is fourth best in the Majors behind the Rays (.708; 34-14), Padres (.653, 32-17) and Dodgers (.635; 33-19).

WE WERE ON A BREAK: The D-backs have won 2 of their 3 games following an off day on the road this season.

◆ Arizona won on April 15 @ Nationals and April 20 @ Reds before losing on May 4 @ Marlins.

IT'S BAAAACK!: This series marks the first games Arizona will utilize a designated hitter this season.

- ♦ In 2020, D-backs DHs batted .234 with 2 homers (1 by **Kole Calhoun** and **David Peralta**) and 21 RBI.
- ◆ Christian Walker led the club last season with 11 RBI and 59 at-bats as DH.

D-BACKS ON TOP SINCE MAY 25: Pavin Smith leads the Majors with a .432 average since May 25, followed by teammates **Josh Reddick** (.415) and **Ketel Marte** (.408).

Nick Ahmed (.341) is also tied for 10th during that span.

GET OUT AND VOTE: Voting is underway for the MLB All-Star Game on July 23 @ Coors Field...fans can vote exclusively online and via mobile devices until the voting period for Phase 1 concludes at 1:00 p.m. AZ on June 24...Phase 2 will begin on June 28 where fans can vote for Phase 1 finalists to determine who makes the All-Star teams and starts for each League.

TIES TO "THE TOWN": The following members of the D-backs have spent time in the A's organization:

- ◆ Mike Fetters (bullpen coach) appeared in 48 games in 1998 and posted 5 saves.
- ◆ Dave McKay (first base coach) played 3 seasons the (1980-82) before serving on Oakland's coaching staff from 1984-95...is not with the team after suffering a fall in the dugout in Spring Training and recently having his spleen removed.
- ◆ Ryan Buchter was 7-1 with a 2.87 ERA in 118 relief appearances in 2018-19...he led the Majors by stranding 93.3 pct. of inherited runners (28-of-30) in 2018.
- ◆ Josh Reddick batted .257 with 84 homers and 300 RBI in 596 games from 2012-16...in 2012, he won a Rawlings Gold Glove® Award and hit a career-high 32 home runs for the West Division champions.
- ◆ Joakim Soria was 4-6 with 3 saves and a 3.94 ERA in 92 games from 2019-20.
- ◆ **Stephen Vogt** made 2 All-Star appearances in his 5 seasons with Oakland (2013-16) and hit .255 with 49 home runs and 198 RBI in 458 games.
