## Texas Rangers (31-48) at Oakland Athletics (47-34)

WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers have won a season high 4 straight games after opening this 6-game roadtrip with a 5-4 victory at OAK on Tuesday...it is the 4th longest current winning streak in MLB: 7--MIL; 5--BOS/LAD...is team's longest winning streak since 4 consecutive wins, 8/11-15/20...last longer winning streak was 5 victories in a row, $7 / 31-8 / 5 / 19$... last defeat was $6 / 24$ vs. OAK...the Rangers have won 5 of 6 and 6 of the last 8 games, longer span beginning 6/21.

- Over the longer span, Texas has lost 12 of 20, 21 of 30 , and 30 of last 43 G...club's 9-15 (.375) June mark is 3rd lowest in A.L....season-long 9-G losing skid from 5/25-6/3 was T5th-longest drought in TEX history and longest slide since 0-9 span from 5/30-6/8/03.
- At 31-48 (.393), Texas has the 4th-lowest win pct. in MLB (ARI-.272, 22-59; BAL-.325, 26-54); PIT-.372, 29-49). T3rd-fewest wins in TEX history after 79 G (29-50 in 1973; 30-49 in 2003; 31-48 in 1985/2021)...club has improved to 17 games under .500 for 1 st time since $6 / 15$ (25-42)...Texas has been season-high 21 G under $.5003 x$ (last at 27-48 on 6/24)...reached season-high point at $.500(18-18)$ on $5 / 9$.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas has been in 5 th place in the A.L. West for the last 34 days...current 9-21 span has dropped club from 6.0 GB to 16.5 GB behind 1st place HOU , the 2nd-largest deficit in A.L. (23.0 GB--BAL) and 5th largest in MLB...Texas has gained 3.5 games in the standings the last 5 days after reaching season-high 20.0 GB on 6/24, largest since end of '19 (29.0 GB)...current deficit is smallest since $6 / 15$ (16.0 GB)...have been in 4th or 5th place all but one day since $4 / 9$ (T3rd after win $5 / 23$ vs. HOU).

SERIES INFO: The Rangers are 8-15-2 in 25 overall series in 2021, 5-6-2 at home and 3-9-0 on the road...Texas has a split and win in its last 2 series entering this 3-game set with OAK after going 0-7-1 in its previous 8 series since that sweep of HOU, 5/21-23...club has had a win or split in 3 straight series once in 2021, 3-0-0 from 4/29-5/9.

- The Rangers have won the 1st game in 3 straight series after losing 7 of the previous 8 openers...club had lost its previous 9 opening games of a series on the road prior to last night with the only other away opening win in 2021 coming on 4/19 at LAA...club is $8-18$ overall in the 1st game of a series. - The club had lost all 10 games after an off-day in 2021 prior to the vicrtory on Tuesday night...Texas had dropped its last 11 such games over 2 seasons since winning on 9/1/20 at HOU .

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers snapped a 3-game away losing streak on Tuesday with just their 2nd road win in the last 21 games beginning 5/10, the other on 6/12 at LAD...Texas lost 16 consecutive road games from 5/10-6/11, matching the longest road losing streak in franchise history with 16 straight road defeats by the expansion Washington Senators in their 1st season, 8/3-9/8/61.

- Texas has lost its 7 away series entering this 3 -game set in OAK since going 3-1 at MIN, 5/3-6...the club dropped its final 7 road series in 2020 after going 2-1 at COL, 6/14-16.
- The Rangers are 11-27 (.289) overall on the road in 2021, the 3rd lowest winning percentage in MLB to COL at . 162 (6-31) and ARI at . 222 (10-35)...It is the Rangers' 2nd fewest victories after 38 road games in club history behind 1973 (10-28/10-29).

VERSUS OAKLAND:The Rangers are 3-2 against the A's in 2021, alternating wins and losses through the 1st 5 meetings...Texas went 3-7 vs. OAK in all of 2020...club is just 7-16 vs. OAK beginning 7/27/19 and 13-31 starting 7/23/18..

- Here at the Oakland Coliseum, the Rangers snapped a 3-game losing streak on Tuesday with their 1st victory since 9/22/19 but have lost 7 of 9 beginning 7/27/19...club is $8-25$ since the start if $2017,0-8-2$ in 10 series in that span...alltime, the A's have advantages of 387-279 overall and 203177 in Oakland.

GALLO GOES OFF: Joey Gallo homered twice on Tuesday night for the 2nd time in 3 games ( $6 / 26 \mathrm{vs}$. KC) and the 3rd this season ( $5 / 8$ vs. SEA), matching Adolis Garcia for the team lead in multi-homer games...Galo's career high for multi-HR games in a season is 4 in 2017.

- Gallo has homered in 3 consecutive games (5 total HR), the longest such streak for a Ranger since Rougned Odor, 3 games in a row from 9/11-13/20 (3 total HR)...he is 8th batter in franchise history to hit 5-or-more home runs over a 3-game span, the 1st since Adrián Beltré, 8/22-24/12 (also 5 HR). the only WSH/TEX batter to ever homer 6 times over a span of 3 games is Álex Rodríguez, 8/16-18/02 vs. TOR...Gallo also has 7 HR in his last $9 \mathrm{G}, 1$ st Ranger to hit $7+\mathrm{HR}$ in such a span since Nomar Mazara, 5/1-9/18 (also 7 HR).
- Gallo now has 9 HR in June, T5th most in the A.L.: 13--Shohei Ohtani, LAA; 10--Jose Altuve, HOU; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., TOR; Jonathan Schoop, DET; 9--Ryan Mountcastle, BAL...it's the 4th time Gallo has hit 9+ HR in a month: 11-8/17; 9--5/17 and 4/19...the 9 HR are the most by a Ranger in June since Mitch Moreland (9) in 2015...club record for June is 11, 3 times, last by Juan Gonzalez in 1996.
- Gallo is 5 -for-9 (all 5 HR ) with 9 RBI , and 4 BB in his last 3 games to raise his average from .218 to .230 , highest since 5/4 (.232)...for June, he is also tied with Altuive for the A.L. lead in walks (23) and is 7th in on-base percentage (.442).

ALL-STAR RACE: Entering the final full day of the MLB AllStar Finalist voting to select the game's starters, Adolis Garcia ranks 7th among A.L. outfielders with $9 \%$ of the vote... Phase 2 fan voting, which is available exclusively online at texasrangers.com and MLB.com and via mobile devices continues through Thursday at 1:00 pm CT with the All-Star starters announced at 8:00 p.m. CT that evening...Garcia is T3rd in A.L. at 20 HR and is 4 th at 55 RBI , best of any outfielder.

QUALITY STARTING: The rotation has allowed 3 R-ER in 21.0 IP in the last 3 G as the trio of Kyle Gibson, Jordan Lyles, and Mike Foltynewicz have combined to allow 3 R-ER in 21.0 IP in that span, each pitching 7.0 IP while allowing 2 or fewer runs...it marks the 1st time Texas starters have worked at least 7.0 IP in 3 straight games since $7 / 5-7 / 19$, all at CLE and 2 or fewer R in each (Mike Minor, Ariel Jurado, Lance Lynn)...prior to the last 3 games, the Texas rotation had gone 22 G without a 7.0 -inning performance...the starters have a 2.61 ERA (11 ER/38.0 IP) in the last 6 G to lower their season ERA from 4.76 to 4.55 , lowest since 6/9 (4.53).

SAVING GRACE: Ian Kennedy earned his 14th save in 15 opportunities in 2021 last night despite allowing 2 homers in his 1.0 inning of work...he is the 1 st Ranger to earn a save when allowing 2+ HR in no more than 1.0 IP since Neftali Feliz on $8 / 20 / 14$ vs. MIA (1.0 IP/2 HR)...Tuesday was the 3rd time in 106 career relief appearances that Kennedy has allowed 2 HR , the 1st when he has recorded a save.

MEDICAL UPDATE: C Jose Trevino is day-to-day after sustaining a bruised right forearm while slipping in his hotel room on Tuesday...David Dahl played 9.0 IP in LF at Frisco (AA) on Tuesday and is scheduled to play LF again tonight...has combined for a ,387 (12-31) average with 1 HR and 8 RBI in 8 G at Round Rock (AAA) and Frisco...Sam Huff is 0 -for-7 in 2 games on rehab assignment for the ACL Rangers (Rookie)

SHORTS: The Rangers are one of 5 MLB teams to use just 2 catchers in 2021 (CIN, COL, NYY, PIT)...club selected C John Hicks from Round Rock on Tuesday...Texas snapped a 12-game losing streak in A.L. West parks on Tuesday with 1st win since $4 / 21$ at LAA...Texas has gone 7 straight games with committing an error, its longest such streak since 7 contests in a row, 8/5-12/19...Nick Solak has gone 64 games without an error since a miscue on $4 / 13$. longest streak ever by a Texas 2B in one season and longest overall since 66 G by Jeff Huson, 5/9/90-9/28/93.

[^0]TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER \#39 Kolby Allard, LHP (2-3, 3.33)

TONIGHT: The 23 -year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 16 th appearance/6th start of the season in tonight's middle game of this 3-G set at the Coliseum... will be making a 6th consecutive start since being slotted into the rotation... has gone 1-3, 3.46 ( $10 \mathrm{ER} / 26.0 \mathrm{IP}$ ) over his 1 st 5 starts, holding opponents to a .224/.255/.367/.622 slash line with $4 \mathrm{BB} / 21$ SO, 1.000 WHIP, and 4 HR allowed... one-or-zero BB in all 5 starts....has posted $5.0+\mathrm{IP}$ in each of his last 4 starts covering the month of June...last $9 \mathrm{G} / 5 \mathrm{GS}$ beg. 5/8: 3.21 ERA (12 ER/33.2 IP) to drop season ERA from 3.65 to 3.33 ... has held opposing left-handed hitters to .188/.250/.292/.542 (9-48) slash...opened the season with 10 relief outings before move to the rotation, going 1-0, 3.15 (7 ER/20.0 IP) in 10 app. out of the bullpen... will be facing A's for 2nd straight start, as he took the loss in Rangers' 5-1 series finale defeat on Thurs. at Globe Life Field...is averaging a career-best 8.61 SO/9 and career-low 1.96 BB/9...became 8th different starter used by Rangers in '21...opened the season in the bullpen after making the Opening Day roster for a 2nd straight campaign...is in his 4th MLB season with Atlanta (2018) and Texas (2019-21)...was originally acquired by TEX from ATL in a trade deadline deal for RHP Chris Martin on 7/30/19...has posted a career 29-23 record and 3.19 ERA in 86 games/starts over 5 minor league campaigns...the Southern California native was selected by ATL in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2015 June draft out of San Clemente High School...Texas is $1-4$ in Allard's 5 starts.

LAST START: Took loss in Rangers' 5 -1 defeat in series finale on Thurs. vs. OAK (L, $6.0 \mathrm{IP}, 8 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{R}$-ER, $0 \mathrm{BB}, 1 \mathrm{SO}, 1 \mathrm{HR}, 97$ pitches/ 66 strikes)...threw over $68 \%$ strikes in the start, 5 th-best figure of his career and 2nd-best for a start in '21 ( $71.9 \%$ on $5 / 27$ at SEA)...set season highs for hits (8), runs (4, all ER), pitches (97), and innings (tied-6.0)...surrendered 3 runs on 4 hits in the 1st inning, permitting 3 straight one-out hits to Chapman/Olson/Laureano, but held A's batters 4-for-19 over last 5 frames...lost duel w/ Chris Bassitt (7.0 IP, 1 R-ER), as TEX offense did not have an XBH and were 0 -for- $6 \mathrm{w} /$ RISP.

Vs. OAKLAND: Will be facing A's for 2nd straight start (see above), and will be pitching at the Coliseum for 1st time in his career...has gone 0-3, 8.76 (12 ER/12.1 IP) in $3 \mathrm{G} / \mathrm{GS}$ in his career vs. OAK, all at Globe Life Field: 8/26/20 vs. OAK (L, $5.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{H}, 2 \mathrm{R}-\mathrm{ER}$ ), 9/12/20 vs. OAK-G2 (1.0 IP, $5 \mathrm{H}, 6 \mathrm{R}-\mathrm{ER}$ ), and Thurs. at GLF (see above)...was bested by Mike Fiers in the August 2020 start....in start last Sept., retired 3 of 4 BF in scoreless 1 st inning and then did not record an out in the 2nd inning, allowing all 6 BF in the 2nd to reach safely (and eventually score).

ON ROAD: Has gone 1-1, 3.63 ( $7 \mathrm{ER} / 17.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in $7 \mathrm{G} / 2 \mathrm{GS}$ on the road in ' 21 , incl. 1-1, 2.00 (2 ER/9.0 IP) in the 2 away starts...enters tonight's game with 6.0 consecutive scoreless innings on the road, and earned win in last road effort $6 / 12$ at LAD (5.0 SHO IP) to snap Rangers' club-record 16-G road losing skid... outdueled reigning N.L. Cy Young Award winner Trevor Bauer (6.1 IP, 6 R-4 ER), notching his 1st win in a start since 9/5/19 at BAL.

AS STARTER / RELIEVER: Allard has gone 6-11, 5.77 ( 68 ER/106.0 IP) in 23 career starts and 1-1, 4.67 (14 ER/27.0 IP) in 15 career relief outings...this season, he is 1-3, 3.46 ( $10 \mathrm{ER} / 26.0 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in 5 starts and 1-0, 3.15 ( $7 \mathrm{ER} / 20.0 \mathrm{IP}$ ) in 10 relief outings...opened 2021 in the bullpen before joining the rotation on $5 / 27$ at SEA.

- As starter: Career-best 12.0 -inning scoreless streak spanning starts $6 / 5 \mathrm{vs}$. TB, $6 / 12$ at LAD, and $6 / 19$ vs. MIN....win on $6 / 12$ at LAD for SoCal native was his 1 st in 13 starts ( $0-10,7.82$ ERA) and snapped TEX club-record $16-\mathrm{G}$ road losing streak...outdueled Trevor Bauer in that victory, which was 1st win by a TEX LH starter since Mike Minor on 9/26/19 vs. BOS...last victory had been 9/5/19 at BAL (6.1 IP, 1 R-ER), this after going 5-0, 4.23 ( $18 \mathrm{ER} / 38.1 \mathrm{IP}$ ) over his first 7 starting assignments in the Majors....has just 4 quality starts, one in '21 (6/19 vs. MIN)... his teams (ATL/TEX) are 10-13 in his starts, with the Rangers losing 10 of last 11 since a $2-0$ team victory on $8 / 8 / 20$ vs. LAA.
- As reliever: First win of '21 came in Rangers' come-from-behind 8-4 win on $5 / 22$ vs. $\mathrm{HOU}(1.1 \mathrm{IP}, 0$ R)... his 23 relief strikeouts were T3rd-most on club at the time of his move to the rotation...highest pitch count as a reliever was 50 ( 2 x , last $5 / 3$ at MIN) and he averaged 36.6 pitches per outing in relief...had 2.35 ERA ( 2 ER/7.2 IP) over his last 4 outings...worked 3.0 perfect IP on $4 / 16$ vs. BAL, longest relief outing of career....pitched perfect 9th inning ( 3 K's) to finish Rangers' $8-3$ win on $4 / 13$ at TB, earning club's celebratory Cowboy Hat for his effort.

SPRING TRAINING: Posted no record and a 3.86 ERA (6 R-5 ER/11.2 IP) across 5 relief appearances in Cactus League 'A' games this spring...overall, struck out 15 batters while issuing just 4 walks and held opponents to a 244 BA (11-45).

2020: Logged 11 games/8 starts in his 2nd year with Texas, ranking 4th on the club in starts...made the Opening Day roster for the 1st time in his career. opened season as a member of the bullpen before slotting into the rotation after Corey Kluber was injured in his Texas debut on $7 / 26$ vs. COL...pitched to an 0-6 record through 8 starts and was moved to the bullpen again in late September... went 0-6, 8.80 ( 29 ER/29.2 IP) in 8 starts and posted 4.0 SHO IP in 3 relief out-
