BOSTON RED SOX (52-31) at OAKLAND A'S (48-36)

STATE OF THE SOX: The Red Sox lead MLB in wins and own sole possession of the AL's best record (52-31, .627).

- The Sox are a season-high 21 games above .500.
- The Sox have won their last 8 games, the AL's longest active win streak and the club's 2nd-longest of the season (9 G, 4/5-14)...During the streak, the Sox have out-scored their opponents, 55-23 (+22).

EXTRA! EXTRA!: The Red Sox improved to 5-2 in extra innings last night, including 4-0 on the road...That is MLB's 5th-best extra-inning record this season.

Kiké Hernández hit a go-ahead RBI single in the top of the 10th inning, then threw out Seth Brown at home plate for the 2nd out in the bottom half.

GET OUT: The Sox lead MLB with 25 outfield assists this season, after leading the majors with 18 in 2020.

Sox outfielders rank T-2nd in MLB with 22 defensive runs saved (TB-26, MIA-22)...They rank 2nd in the AL and 4th in MLB with a 9.2 ultimate zone rating.

HALFWAY HOME: This is the 9th time the Sox have won at least 52 of their first 83 games, having most recently done so in 1986 and 2018 (went World Series in both years).

Under the 10-team playoff format from 2012-2019, all 11 teams who won 52+ of their first 83 games made the Postseason, with 8 winning the World Series.

GIVE ME A BREAK: The Red Sox are closing out the first half by playing 19 games in 20 days (6/22-7/11)...<u>They are</u> in a stretch of 16 consecutive days with a game (9-2 so far).

The Sox will open the season's 2nd half by playing a game on 18 consecutive days (7/15-8/1), all against AL East opponents (NYY-8, TOR-7, TB-3).

MONTH BY MONTH: The Red Sox went 17-10 (.630) in April, 15-11 (.577) in May, and 18-10 (.643) in June... The only other teams to win 15+ games in each of those months were the A's, Dodgers, Giants, and Padres.

LONG DIVISION: The Red Sox lead the AL East by 4.5 games, their largest lead of the season.

- The Sox are 9-13 (.409) vs. AL West teams and 43-18 (.705) against all others.
- The Sox are 25-17 (.595) vs. teams that entered today with a winning record, MLB's 3rd-best mark.

HERE AND THERE: The Red Sox are an MLB-best 25-14 (.641) on the road...They have lost their last 3 series at Oakland Coliseum, going 4-8 in games from 2017-21.

The Red Sox are 27-17 at home, including 27-14 (.659) since getting swept by BAL to begin the season...Their

.614 win % at home ranks 3rd in the AL.

DOWN, NOT OUT: The Red Sox lead the majors with 28 come-from-behind wins this season...They are an MLB-leading 25-12 (.676) in games decided by 1 or 2 runs.

- The Sox lead the majors in runs scored with 2 outs (179)...With RISP & 2 outs, the Sox lead MLB in AVG (.284) and OPS (.880).
- The Sox lead MLB in 2-strike RBI (169), 17 more than any other team...Rafael Devers (34) and Xander Bogaerts (27) rank 1st and 2nd in MLB in 2-strike RBI.

SLUMP BUSTERS: The Red Sox' longest losing streak of the season is 3 games (3 times)...<u>They are 1 of only 2 teams without a losing streak of 4+ games (also NYM).</u>

ALL-STAR SOX: Xander Bogaerts and Rafael Devers have been named starters for the 2021 MLB All-Star Game... They would become the first Red Sox teammates ever to start the Midsummer Classic together at SS and 3B.

All-Star Game pitchers and reserves will be announced Sunday at 5:30 p.m. ET.

LEFT SIDE...STRONG SIDE: This is Xander Bogaerts' 3rd All-Star selection (also 2016 & '19), his 2nd fan-elected start (2016)...He would become only the 3rd Red Sox player to start multiple All-Star Games at SS, joining Rico Petrocelli (1967, '69) and Joe Cronin (1935, '37-39, '41).

Devers will be making his All-Star Game debut, becoming the first Red Sox 3B to win the fan election since 2002 (Shea Hillenbrand)...He ranks 2nd in the majors in RBI (68) and XBH (45).

MONSTER MASH: During their 8-game win streak, the Red Sox are batting .314 with a .917 OPS, 14 HR, and 15 doubles...They have scored 55 runs and struck out 50 times.

- The Red Sox have hit 4+ HR an MLB-best 8 times this season, including in 3 of their last 6 games.
- The Sox lead MLB with 19 three-run homers.
- The Sox are an MLB-best 46-4 (.920) when scoring 4+ runs...They are 40-3 when scoring 5+ runs, 34-1 when scoring 6+ runs, and 25-0 when scoring 7+ runs.

PITCHING IN: Since giving up 18 runs to TOR on 6/13, the Sox have posted a 3.12 ERA in 17 games (53 ER/152.2 IP)... In their last 9 games, they have a 2.09 ERA (19 ER/81.2 IP).

- Sox pitchers have issued only 5 BB in their last 5 games.
- ♣ The Sox lead the AL with 1.04 HR allowed per 9.0 IP.
- Sox starters have thrown 5.0+ innings 64 times, 3rdmost in the majors (43-21 in those games).

WHAT A RELIEF: Red Sox relievers rank 4th in the AL and 7th in the majors in ERA (3.44)...Their 9 active relievers have a combined 2.87 ERA for the Sox (79 ER/248.0 IP).

- Sox relievers have allowed 2 ER in their last 20.2 IP. their last 9 games, they own a 0.92 ERA (3 ER/29.1 IP) with only 4 XBH allowed (2 doubles, 2 HR).
- In their last 16 games (beginning 6/14), Sox relievers have posted a 2.11 ERA (15 ER/64.0 IP)...They have stranded their last 16 inherited runners.

'PEN PALS: The Red Sox have an MLB-high 6 pitchers with 20+ relief appearances and a <u>sub-3.00 ERA</u>...No other AL team even has 6 pitchers with 20+ games and a sub-4.00 ERA.

Among AL closers, Matt Barnes ranks 1st in strikeout % (45.5) and FanGraphs' WAR (1.7)...He also ranks 2nd in WHIP (0.83), opponent OPS (.504), FIP (1.97), opponent AVG (.168), and saves (18).

Xander Bogaerts (27 G) and J.D. Martinez (20 G) have the 2 longest active on-base streaks in MLB...Bogaerts has a .343 AVG and .951 OPS during his streak

- Ranks among AL leaders in wins (T-2nd, 9), HR/9.0 IP (1st, 0.40), & FIP (2nd, 2.55).
- Tossed 7.0 innings in yesterday's 15-1 win vs. KC (5 H, 6 SO)...It's the second straight start of going 7.0+ innings (7.2 IP on 6/26 vs. NYY)...Was his 3rd scoreless start (5/29 vs. MIA, 6/14 vs. TOR).
- ♦ Has reached 5.0+ IP in 15 of his 17 starts this season, with 6.0+ IP in 8.
- Is 5-2 with a 2.27 ERA in his last 8 starts, beginning 5/22 at PHI (47.2 IP, 12 ER, 8 BB, 43 SO).
- Had a homerless streak of 55.0 IP to start 2021, the longest in MLB this year.

- Has allowed 8 HR in his last 4 starts (21.0 IP) after allowing 5 HR through his first 12 starts this season (64.1 IP).
- List winless in his last 6 starts...Allowed 3 ER or fewer in 4 of those 6.
- Leads Sox starters in opponent AVG (.230) and strikeouts, and ranks 2nd in SO/9.0 IP (10.44) and WHIP (1.26).
- ♣ Has thrown 6.0+ innings in 7 of his 16 starts this season, and 5.0+ IP in 13.


