STATE OF THE SOX: The Red Sox are tied for the MLB lead in wins (also SF, LAD) and own sole possession of the AL's best record (52-32, .619).

The Sox snapped an 8-game winning streak yesterday, their 2nd-longest of 2021 (9 G, 4/5-14)...During the streak, the Sox out-scored their opponents, 55-23 (+22).

EXTRA! EXTRA !: The Red Sox and A's have played extra innings in each of the first 2 games this series...The Sox won in 10 innings on Friday, 3-2, and the A's won in 12 innings yesterday, 7-6.

The Sox are 5-3 in extra-innings (4-1 on the road).

BACK NINE: This is the 14th time the Sox have won at least 52 of their first 84 games, having most recently done so in 2007 and 2018 (won the World Series in both years).

Under the 10-team playoff format from 2012-2019, 15 of the 17 teams who won 52+ of their first 84 games made the Postseason, with 8 of those teams winning the World Series.

GIVE ME A BREAK: The Red Sox are closing out the first

A BREAK. The Red 30 days (6/22-7/11)...<u>They are in a stretch of 16 consecutive days with a game (9-3 so far)</u>.
 The Sox will open the season's 2nd half by playing a game on 18 consecutive days (7/15-8/1), all against AL East opponents (NYY-8, TOR-7, TB-3).

MONTH BY MONTH: The Red Sox went 17-10 (.630) in April, 15-11 (.577) in May, and 18-10 (.643) in June... The only other teams to win 15+ games in each of those months were the A's, Dodgers, Giants, and Padres.

LONG DIVISION: The Red Sox lead the AL East by 4.5 games, their largest lead of the season.

- The Sox are 9-14 (.391) vs. AL West teams and 43-18 (.705) against all others.
- The Sox are 27-19 (.587) vs. teams that entered today with a winning record, MLB's 4th-best mark.

HERE AND THERE: The Red Sox are tied with MIL for the best road record in the majors (both 25-15, .625)...They have lost their last 3 series at Oakland Coliseum, going 4-9 in games from 2017-21.

The Red Sox are 27-17 at home, including 27-14 (.659) since getting swept by BAL to begin the season...Their .614 win % at home ranks 3rd in the AL.

DOWN, NOT OUT: The Red Sox lead the majors with 28 come-from-behind wins this season...They are an MLB-leading 25-13 (.658) in games decided by 1 or 2 runs.

- The Sox lead the majors in runs scored with 2 outs (182)...With RISP & 2 outs, the Sox lead MLB in AVG (.287) and OPS (.881).
- The Sox lead MLB in 2-strike RBI (171), 17 more than any other team...Rafael Devers (34) and Xander Bogaerts (27) rank 1st and 2nd in MLB in 2-strike RBI.

GET OUT: The Sox lead MLB with 26 outfield assists this season, after leading the majors with 18 in 2020...No other team has as many as 20 outfield assists this season.

Sox outfielders rank 3rd in MLB with 20 defensive runs saved (TB-23, MIA-21)...They rank 2nd in the AL and 4th in MLB with a 9.2 ultimate zone rating.

SLUMP BUSTERS: The Red Sox' longest losing streak of the season is 3 games (3 times)...<u>They are 1 of only 2 teams</u> without a losing streak of 4+ games (also NYM).

ALL-STAR SOX: Xander Bogaerts and Rafael Devers have been named starters for the 2021 MLB All-Star Game ... They would become the first Red Sox teammates ever to start the Midsummer Classic together at SS and 3B

All-Star Game pitchers and reserves will be announced today at 5:30 p.m. ET.

LEFT SIDE...STRONG SIDE: This is Xander Bogaerts' 3rd All-Star selection (also 2016 & '19), his 2nd fan-elected start (2016)...He would become only the 3rd Red Sox player to start multiple All-Star Games at SS, joining Rico Petrocelli (1967, '69) and Joe Cronin (1935, '37-39, '41).

 Devers will be making his All-Star Game debut, becoming the first Red Sox 3B to win the fan election since 2002 (Shea Hillenbrand)...He ranks 2nd in the majors in RBI (68) and XBH (45).

MONSTER MASH: During their last 9 games, the Red Sox are batting .299 with an .864 OPS, 15 HR, and 15 doubles... They have scored 61 runs and struck out 61 times

- The Red Sox have hit 4+ HR an MLB-best 8 times
- The Sox lead MLB with 19 three-run homers.
- ¢. The Sox are an MLB-best 46-5 (.902) when scoring 4+ runs...They are 40-4 when scoring 5+ runs, 34-2 when scoring 6+ runs, and 25-0 when scoring 7+ runs.

PITCHING IN: Since giving up 18 runs to TOR on 6/13, the Sox have posted a 3.24 ERA in 18 games (59 ER/164.0 IP)... In their last 10 games, they have a 2.42 ERA (25 ER/93.0 IP).

- Sox pitchers have issued only 12 BB in their last 6 games. A
 - The Sox lead the AL with 1.03 HR allowed per 9.0 IP. A. Sox starters have thrown 5.0+ innings 65 times, 3rd-Ą. most in the majors (43-22 in those games).

WHAT A RELIEF: Red Sox relievers rank 3rd in the AL and 8th in the majors in ERA (3.48)...Their 9 *active* relievers have a combined 2.94 ERA for the Sox (83 ER/254.1 IP).

In their last 17 games (beginning 6/14), Sox relievers have posted a 2.43 ERA (19 ER/70.1 IP)...They have stranded their last 17 of their last 18 inherited runners.

'PEN PALS: The Red Sox have an MLB-high 6 pitchers with 20+ relief appearances and a <u>*sub-3.00 ERA*</u>...No other AL team even has 6 pitchers with 20+ games and a sub-4.00 ERA.

Among AL closers, Matt Barnes ranks 1st in strikeout % (45.5), opponent AVG (.168), and FanGraphs' WAR (tied, 1.7)...He also ranks 2nd in opponent OPS (.504), FIP (1.96), and saves (18), and 3rd in WHIP (0.83).

- Taylor's streak is the longest by a LHP in Red Sox history, and the longest by a Red Sox reliever since Joe Kelly in 2017 (22.0 IP, 5/1-7/9).
- Xander Bogaerts (28 G) and J.D. Martinez (21 G) have the 2 longest active on-base streaks in MLB.

Bogaerts' streak matches a career-best (also from 5/6-6/4/16)...During his current streak, Bogaerts has a .346 AVG and .944 OPS.
