TODAY'S TILT...the Mariners continue a 7 -game homestand with the last of 4 games vs. Oakland (2-1). begin a 3-game series vs. Houston tomorrow night before embarking on a 10-game road trip at Texas (3 G, $7 / 30-8 / 1$ ), Tampa Bay ( $3 \mathrm{G}, 8 / 2-8 / 4$ ) and New York-AL ( $4 \mathrm{G}, 8 / 5-8 / 8$ ) with off days before and after the trip...today's game will be televised on ROOT SPORTS, as well as broadcast on 710 ESPN Seattle and the Mariners Radio Network.
ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners won last night's game 5-4 in walk-off fashion...are 8-4 in their last 12 games, 19-10 over their last 29, 22-11 over their last 33 and 32-20 over their last 52...are 20-13 in day games and 33-33 at night... are 31-21 at T-Mobile Park and 22-25 on the road...are 44-14 when scoring at least 4 runs and 9-32 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 38-3 when out-hitting their opponent.

- The Century Mark - The Mariners play their 100th game of the season today.
- High Water Mark - The Mariners enter today's game with a record of 53-46, matching their sea-son-high water mark of 7 games over .500 (51-44 on July 20)...Seattle was last 8 games over .500 on April 20, 2019 when they were 16-8.
- Series of Fortunate Events - The Mariners have won or split 10 of their last 11 series including the current 4-game set vs. Oakland after last night's victory clinched at least a series tie...are 7-1-2 in series in their last 10 coming into the current series.
- One on One - The Mariners are 22-8 (.733) in 1-run games this season, leading the Majors in 1-run winning percentage by a wide margin...Cincinnati has the 2nd-best winning percentage (.643, 18-10).. Seattle also owns the most 1-run wins (22), leading the New York Mets (19)
- I Wanna Play That Game Tonight - Seattle trailed 3-1 in last night's eventual 5-4 win...earned their 22nd comeback win of the season.
- Pack the Park - T-Mobile Park drew a season-high 30,843 fans last night.
- Weekend Warriors - The Mariners are 40-22 (.645) between Thursday and Sunday this season, compared to 13-24 (.351) between Monday and Wednesday.
- Matinee - The Mariners are 20-13 (.606) in day games, the 3rd-best record in the American League.

MITCH THE MAGNIFICENT...Mitch Haniger went $3-$ for- 4 with 3 runs scored, 1 double, 2 home runs, 3 RBI and was at the plate when Jarred Kelenic scored the game-ending run on a wild pitch in the 9th... Haniger has reached base safely in 22 of his last 23 games since June 25 ...in that span, Mitch is batting $.333(30 \times 90)$ with 24 runs, 3 doubles, 9 home runs, 21 RBI, 8 walks and 4 hit-by-pitches...he's also hit safely in 13 of his last 14 games since July 6.

- Multi-HR Mitch - Recorded his 5th career multi-homer game and 3rd this season...has accounted for half of the Mariners 6 individual multi-homer performances this season... Mitch has homered twice in a game on $9 / 25 / 17$ at OAK, $6 / 12 / 18$ vs. LAA, $5 / 11 / 21$ at LAD, $6 / 10 / 21$ at DET and $7 / 24 / 21$ vs. OAK.
- Extra Note - 2nd Mariners player with 3+ XBH in a game this season (other: Jarred Kelenic, $5 / 14 \mathrm{vs}$. CLE).
- AL Outfield Ranks - Mitch is batting 268 ( $99 \times 370$ ) with 69 runs, 18 doubles, 1 triple, 25 home runs, 62 RBI and 27 walks this season...among AL players with at least $60 \%$ of their games played in the outfield, Haniger ranks 1st in runs (69), 1st in home runs (25), T2nd in RBI (62), 2nd in extra-base hits (44), 2nd in total bases (194), 3rd in hits (99) and 3rd in slugging percentage (.524).

BULLPEN BULLIES...last night, 6 Mariners relievers (JT Chargois, Anthony Misiewicz, Casey Sadler, Drew Steckenrider, Paul Sewald and Kendall Graveman) combined for $6.1 \mathrm{IP}, 1 \mathrm{H}, 1 \mathrm{ER}, 1 \mathrm{BB}$ and 6 SO...Seattle's bullpen is 26-14 with 27 saves and a 4.03 ERA (171 ER, 381.2 IP) with 334 hits allowed, 136 walks and 389 strikeouts this season...FanGraphs pegs Mariners relievers as the 2nd-most valuable by Wins Above Replacement (4.8) this season, trailing only Tampa Bay (5.2)...the bullpen's 3.54 Fielding Independent Pitching also ranks 2nd in the Majors to Tampa Bay (3.41).

- Sadler (H, 1.0 IP, 2 SO) made his first appearance since April 30...he was returned from Major League rehab assignment and reinstated from the 60-day Injured List on July 23.
- Sewald (1.0 IP, 2 SO ) reclaimed the Major League lead in strikeouts-per-9 innings (15.73) among pitchers with at least 30.0 IP...leads Aroldis Chapman-NYY (15.58) and Craig Kimbrel-CHC (15.54).
- Graveman (W, 1.0 IP, 1 SO ) leads the American League with a 0.69 WHIP and a 140 (15x107) opponent batting average among pitchers with at least 30.0 IP.
TYPICAL TY...Ty France went 1 -for- 4 with a run batted in last night...is batting $.406(13 \times 32)$ with 5 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBI and 2 hit-by-pitches in his last 8 games...in 52 games since returning from the Injured List on May 24, the Mariners are 32-20 (.615) and Ty is batting . 308 ( $60 \times 195$ ) with 23 runs, 13 doubles, 6 home runs, 30 RBI, 11 walks and 10 hit-by-pitches in that span...he's batting .346 (28x81) with 8 doubles, 3 home runs and 36 RBI with runners in scoring position this season.
LONG DIVISION...the Mariners play the 4th of 10 consecutive games against the American League West Division, their 3rd-longest intra-divisional streak this season...Seattle is 23-16 (.590) in 39 games against the AL West this season and $30-30$ in 60 games outside the division...Seattle went $9-5$ during a seasonhigh 14-game stretch against divisional opponents from May 24-June 6...the Mariners play their final 13 games of the regular season within the division.
WILD WILD LIFE...the Mariners won 5-4 on a walk-off wild pitch in the bottom of the 9th last night...it was Seattle's 8th walk-off win of the season...Jarred Kelenic scored after reaching base via his second walk of the game...the walk-off wild pitch came one night after Oakland's 5 wild pitches on Friday set a new Mariners franchise record for most wild pitches thrown against them in a game.
LT HIT STREAK...Luis Torrens went 1-for-4 last night with a pivotal base hit to lead off the 9th against Lou Trivino...Luis extended his hitting streak to 6 games (7/18-c), setting a new career-high...is batting . 316 ( $6 \times 19$ ) with 4 runs, 3 home runs and 3 RBI with a 1.170 OPS during the streak...since June 15, is batting .276 ( $24 \times 87$ ) with 16 runs, 1 double, 1 triple, 10 home runs, 18 RBI and 12 walks...he's gotten on-base at a .364 clip, slugging .655 with a 1.019 OPS in that span.
RISP-TAKING...the Mariners have the 3rd-highest slugging percentage (.471) in MLB with runners in scoring position this season, trailing Toronto (.486) and Houston (.472)...Seattle is batting . 262 (186x709) with RISP, 9th-best in MLB...the Mariners are 1 of 2 AL clubs (other: Chicago) with 4 players batting .300 or better with RISP (min. 50 PA each): J.P. Crawford is batting . 356 (21x59) with RISP, Ty France is batting .346 (28x81), Mitch Haniger is batting . 343 (23x67) and Kyle Seager is batting . 300 ( $24 \times 80$ ).
AS YOU KNOW...Mitch Haniger went 3-for-4 with a double, 2 home runs and 3 RBI last night...it was Haniger's 3rd multi-homer game of the season and the 6th individual multi-homer performance by a Mariners player this season...BUT, DID YOU KNOW?...that each of the first 5 multi-homer performances by Mariners this season came on the road?...Haniger became the first Seattle player to hit 2+ homers in a game at T-Mobile Park since Daniel Vogelbach did it 2 years ago to the day on July 24, 2019 in a 5-3 win vs. Texas.

## ABOUT GONZALES.

- 29-year-old left-hander is making his 12 th start of the season, 108th career appearance (100th career start) and his 3rd career start against Oakland.
- Acquired by Seattle from St. Louis in exchange for minor league outfielder Tyler O'Neill on July 21, 2017.
- Native of Fort Collins, CO...attended Gonzaga University for 3 years (2011-13).
- Originally selected by Colorado in the 29th round of the 2010 MLB Draft out of Rocky Mountain High School (Fort Collins, CO) but did not sign...drafted and signed by the Cardinals with the 19th overall pick in the 2013 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga University ...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program.
- Made his MLB debut with Cardinals on June 25, 2014 at Colorado.
- Went 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (3 ER, 6.0 IP ) with 4 strikeouts and 2 walks with St. Louis in the 2014 postseason...earned 2 wins in the NLDS vs. Los Angeles, becoming the 4th rookie in postseason history to win 2 games in the Division Series (also: Dave Righetti-NYY, 1981, Jaret Wright-CLE, 1997 and Francisco Rodríguez-LAA, 2002).
CENTURY MARK...tonight marks his 100th career Major League start.
LAST TIME OUT...earned his 2nd win of the season on July 20 vs. the Rockies at Coors Field...pitched 5.0 innings, allowed 2 runs on 6 hits and 3 walks, allowed only 1 home run and struckout 3 ...the Mariners won the game by a 6-4 score.
LAST TWO...is 1-0 with a 4.22 ERA (5 ER, 10.2 IP ) with 4 walks and 6 strikeouts over his last 2 starts.
VS OAKLAND...Gonzales pitched a ND during his last start against the Athletics on June 1, 2021 at T-Mobile park....he pitched 4.0 innings, allowed only 1 run on 2 hits, 1 walk, only 1 home run and struckout 6 ...overall, is $5-3$ with a 3.82 ERA (29 ER, 68.1 IP) with 17 walks and 60 strikeouts over 12 career games ( 11 starts) vs. the Athletics.
PATERNITY LIST....was placed on the paternity list from June 27...activated off paternity list on June 30.
INJURED LIST...Gonzales was on the 10-day Injured List with a strained left forearm, April 29-June 1 ...is $0-1$ with a 5.63 ERA ( 5 ER, 8.0 IP) in 2 starts after returing from the IL: June 1 vs. OAK ( $4.0,2,1,1,1,6, H R$ ) and June 8 at DET ( $5.0,5,4,4,1,2, H R$ ).
FOR OPENERS...made his 3rd consecutive Opening Night start on April 1 vs. SF, but his 1st in T-Mobile Park...started opener at HOU last July, and was charged with loss ( 4.1 IP, 3 ER)...made 1st career Opening Night start on 3/20/19 vs. OAK in Opening Series in Tokyo...was winning pitcher, allowing 3 ER in 6.0 IP...got the no-decision in the 2021 Opening Night start...overall, is 1-1, 6.06 (16.1 IP, 11 ER) in 3 total Opening Day starts.
OPENER $\times 3 \ldots$ with his Opening Night start, Marco became just the 4 th Mariners pitcher in history to make 3 or more Opening Night starts...he joins Félix Hernández (11), Randy Johnson (6) and Jamie Moyer (4) with 3 or more Opening Night starts...only Hernández (7) and Johnson (2) have more than 1 Opening Night win; a win tonight would give Marco 2.
BULLDOG ROOTS...played 3 seasons (2011-13) with the Gonzaga Bulldogs, compiling a career record of 26-7 with a 2.34 ERA while recording 9 complete games and 4 shutouts...tallied 278 strikeouts over 303.2 innings of work...became the highest draft pick in the history of the Gonzaga baseball program when he was selected 19th overall by St. Louis in 2013...shared West Coast Conference Player of the Year honors with the Cubs' Kris Bryant (University of San Diego) as a freshman in 2011 and as a junior in 2013...in 2013, earned John Olerud Two-Way Player of the Year honors as well as WCC Co-Player of the Year for the 2nd time in his career.
$\underline{2020}$ LEADERBOARD...struck out 9.14 batters per walk ( $64 \mathrm{SO}, 7 \mathrm{BB}$ ) last season, the best ratio in MLB....also among the AL leaders in wins (T2 $\mathrm{w} / 7$ ), fewest BB per 9.0 IP (2nd, 0.90 ), win \% (3rd, . 778 ), WHIP (3rd, 0.95 ), ERA ( 8 th, 3.10 ), IP ( 7 th, 69.2 ) and opponents batting average against (10th, .222).
COMPLETELY DOMINANT...tossed his second career complete game on Aug. 31, 2020 at Los Angeles-AL, leading the Mariners to a 2-1 victory over the Angles ( $9.0,4,1,1,1,8, \mathrm{HR}$ )... is the 51 st pitcher in franchise history to record multiple complete games as a Mariner, the 40th pitcher in club history to record multiple complete games while allowing 1 run or less in each outing.
CAREER ...in 7 Major League seasons with St. Louis (2014-15, 2017) and Seattle (2017-c), is $42-32$ with a 4.27 ERA ( 272 ER, 573.1 IP) with 149 walks and 469 strikeouts in 107 games (99 starts).


## TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP DARREN McCAUGHAN (0-0, 1.80)

25-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 1st start of the season, 2nd appearance...made his Major League debut in his last outing on July 20 at Colorado, tossing 5.0 innings of relief and allowing only 1 run on no hits, 3 walks and no strikeouts...CAREER: was originally selected by the Mariners in the 12th round of the 2017 First Year Player Draft out of Long Beach State...vs. HOU: Is scheduled to make his first career appearance against the Astros.
