San Diego claimed Game 1 of the brief 2-game set against the Oakland A's by the score of 7-4...starter **Chris Paddack** got the win (7-6) after working 6.0 IP of 3-run, 9-hit ball with 6 strikeouts and 1 walk...he tossed a career-high 102 pitches.

► **Adam Frazier, Fernando Tatis Jr., Jake Cronenworth, Manny Machado, and Victor Caratini** all had multi-hit efforts, and both Machado and Tatis both homered.

► The Friars went 3-for-6 with RISP last night.

BRING OUT THE BROOMS San Diego is in search of their 7th sweep of the season with a win today over Oakland and their 1st since they swept the Dodgers in 3 games from June 21-23 in San Diego...it would be their 1st-ever sweep of Oakland would be the 2nd time in Padres' history in which they've won 3 straight against the A's.

THE PADRES' BULLPEN The Padre 'pen leads the Majors in ERA (3.01) and innings pitched (427.0 IP).

WE OUT HERE PLAYIN' San Diego's 103 games played (not including their suspended game @ Atlanta) are the most of any National League team this year.

VS. OAK The Padres host the A's for the 1st time since 2018, and their first time overall since they took 2 of 3 games @ OAK from Sept. 4-6, 2020...against the AL West, the Padres are 9-1 this season, and their .900 winning percentage against the Division is the best in MLB this year of any team against an opposing division.

► **Manny Machado** has a .312 career batting average vs. Oakland, ranking 4th highest among all active players (min. 150 PA)...behind just David Fletcher (.348), Miguel Cabrera (.336), and Jose Altuve (.325).

UP NEXT The Padres host the Rockies for a 4-game set following their current 2-game series against the A's...the Friars are 6-6 vs. the Rockies so far in 2021, and they've lost 5 of their last 6 games against Colorado...SD is 4-2 vs. COL @ Petco Park this year.

HOME, HOME ON THE RANGE The Padres have 34 wins at home this year, which are the most of any National League team and rank T-2nd in MLB with the Astros and behind just the White Sox's 35 home wins.

SUSPENDED? BOOM, RESUMED MLB yesterday announced the suspended Padres game @ ATL game from Wednesday, July 21st will resume at Petco Park in San Diego on Friday, September 24th at 5:10 p.m. PT...the originally scheduled 7:10 p.m. PT game will follow the conclusion of the suspended game from July 21st...the Braves will serve as the home Club for the resumption of the suspended game, which will resume in the bottom of the 5th inning and remain 7th-inning regulation game...the Padres will be the home Club for the originally scheduled game, which will be a nine-inning regulation game.

- ▶ Blake Snell is set to make his 3rd start of the 2nd half and the 4th of his career vs. the A's today in the 2nd of 2 in this brief 2-game set...faced the A's once each season from 2016-18, going a combined 1-0 with a 2.76 ERA.
- ▶ Tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run, 3-hit ball his last time out last Thurs @ MIA in SD's 3-2 victory...the 6.0 innings and 8 punchouts were both season highs on the road.
- ▶ He was reinstated from the 10-day IL (gastroenteritis) ahead of his 7/17 start vs WSH, tossing 4.0 innings of 6-hit, 4-run ball in SD's eventual 10-4 win...he walked 4 and struck out 3, marking the 3rd start in his last 4 where he's walked more than he's struck out...he was riding a 9.0 scoreless IP streak heading into the outing across his 6/22 start vs. LAD and his 7/4 start @ PHI.
- ▶ Snell has posted a 1.43 ERA at Petco this season, the 2nd-lowest ERA among all ML pitchers who have made at least 7 starts in their home park, trailing only Jacob deGrom (1.20 ERA)...he has a 8.02 ERA on the road, the highest ERA among all ML pitchers who have made at least 11 starts on the road, with Dylan Cease's 5.91 ERA being 2nd-highest.
- ▶ He has received 2 runs of support-or-fewer in 10 of his 18 starts this season, including 1-or-fewer in 8 outings.

- ▶ With the 5.0 shutout innings in SD's 3-2 victory on June 22 vs. vs. LAD, Snell is now 1-0 with a 2.35 ERA vs. LAD...10 of his 18 starts this year have come against the NL West, and he is now 2-0 with a 3.94 ERA vs. the division.
 - ▶ Blake's 5.71 BB/9 and his .140 BB/BFP are both the highest ratios in the majors (min. 80.0 IP).
 - ▶ Has a 43.6% whiff rate on his slider and a 46.8% whiff rate on his curveball.

BULLPEN

54 AUSTIN ADAMS - RHP

last outing 7/25 @ MIA (0.1 IP, 2 H, 4 R, 4 ER, 2 BB) current scoreless streak 0.0 IP (0 g)
Pitches: Slider (89.0%) Four Seamer (11.0%)

- ▶ Allowed a season-high 4 ER on Sunday @ MIA, twice as many runs (2) as he allowed from 4/18-7/24 (0.57 ERA, .100 AVG).
- ▶ He's 1 of just 11 relievers to have made 40 app. since 4/18, and he leads that group in ERA (1.69) and opp. AVG (.118)...he's allowed 12 hits since 4/18, 11 fewer than the next closest hurler in that group (Liam Hendriks' 23).
- ▶ His 15 HBP are most in majors, 2 more than the next closest (Morton's 13 in 116.0 IP)...no pitcher has ever finished a season with 15+ HBP in fewer than 100 IP...the fewest IP was 114.0 (with 15 HBP) by BOS' Alfredo Aceves in 2011.
- ▶ Has struck out 54 of the 158 batters he's faced...the 13.89 SO/9 IP ratio ranks 6th in the majors and 2th in the NL (min. 150 batters faced).
- ▶ Has now thrown 630 pitches on the season, with 561 of them being sliders...his 89.3% slider usage is 2nd-highest among all ML pitchers (min. 500 total pitches).

74 NABIL CRISMATT - RHP

last outing 7/25 @ MIA (2.2 IP, 5 H, R, ER, 4 SO) current scoreless streak 2.0 IP (1 g)
Pitches: Changeup (48.6%) Curveball (26.8%) 4-Seam Fastball (13.3%) Sinker (11.3%)

- ▶ Recalled from ELP on 7/11 for the 5th time this season...is the only NL pitcher to have 2 outings of 5.0+ IP and one of only 4 pitchers in the majors this season to do so (KC's Kris Bubic and TB's John Fleming and Ryan Yarbrough).
- ▶ Has now worked 2.0 IP-or-more in 16 of his 25 outings this season...has a 4.7 barrel % (89th percentile).

25 TIM HILL - LHP

last outing 7/27 vs. OAK (0.1 IP) current scoreless streak 0.1 IP (1 g)
Pitches: Sinker (47.4%) 4-Seam Fastball (34.3%) Slider (18.0%) Changeup (0.3%)

- ▶ Tagged with his 5th loss and 3rd blown save Sat. night @ MIA.
- ▶ His 49 app. lead the NL and T-3rd in the majors.
- ▶ In his last 14 outings he's recorded 4 holds, 2 wins, 2 losses and 1 save.

36 PIERCE JOHNSON - RHP

last outing 7/23 @ MIA (1.0 IP, BB, SO) current scoreless streak 4.0 IP (4 g)
Pitches: Curveball (72.7%) Sinker (27.3%)

- ▶ 26 of the 61 outs he's collected since 5/18 have come via the strikeout (11.51 SO/9)... he has struck out at least 1 batter in all but 5 of his 23 outings since 5/18.
- ▶ Has a 2919 rpm spin rate on his curve (92nd percentile), with opponents hitting just .204 against the pitch...his 31.1 K% is just shy of his career-high 33.8 K% from 2020.

33 MARK MELANCON - RHP - *muh-LAN-son*

last outing 7/27 vs. OAK (1.0 IP, SO) current scoreless streak 4.0 IP (4 g)
Pitches: Cutter (60.5%) Curveball (37.0%) 4-Seam Fastball (2.5%)

- ▶ Converted his ML-leading 31st save Tues. night vs. OAK, 6 ahead of Liam Hendriks' 25.
- ▶ Earned his 4th career All-Star nod and appeared in the game in the 8th.
- ▶ His 27 saves were 2nd-most in franchise history before the All-Star Break, trailing only Kirby Yates' 30 in 2019.

14 EMILIO PAGÁN - RHP - *eh-MEE-lee-oh pa-GAHN*

last outing 7/27 vs. OAK (0.2 IP, H) current scoreless streak 1.2 IP (2 g)
Pitches: 4-Seam Fastball (60%) Cutter (38.7%) Changeup (1.2%)

- ▶ Leads the SD pen with 14 holds...his 8 holds since June 1 are T-7th in MLB and T-4th in the NL.
- ▶ SD is now 31-13 in games in which he's appeared, including wins in 13 of his last 16, with the 3 losses coming in his last 5 app.

15 DREW POMERANZ - LHP

last outing 7/27 vs. OAK (1.0 IP, BB, SO) current scoreless streak 0.0 IP (0 g)
Pitches: 4-Seam Fastball (77.2%) Curveball (22.8%)

- ▶ Scored upon Tues. night vs. OAK for just the 6x in his 52 outings since start of 2020.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 10-day IL on 7/17...secured his 10th hold Fri night @ MIA.
- ▶ Has struck out 26 of his 85 BF, good for a 11.14 SO/9.0 IP ratio.
- ▶ LHH are 2-for-27 (.077) vs. him this season while RHH are 13-for-47 (.277).

34 CRAIG STAMMEN - RHP - *STAM-en*

last outing 7/24 @ MIA (2.0 IP, H, R, 4 SO) current scoreless streak 1.0 IP (1 g)
Pitches: Sinker (46.8%) Curve (30.6%) Slider (21.9%) Changeup (0.5%) 4-Seam (0.2%)

- ▶ Tossed 2.0 IP Sat. night @ MIA in relief of Weathers, his 12th outing of 2.0+ IP...the 4 punchouts tied a season high (also: 5/25 @ MIL).
- ▶ Has a 56-to-8 SO/BB ratio...the 3.5 BB% is a career low and ranks in top 2% of MLB.
- ▶ Made his 500th career appearance 7/8 vs. WSH, 1 of 24 active ML pitchers with 500-or-more career outings.
- ▶ Limiting first batters faced to a .171 average this season (7-for-41).
- ▶ His wife, Audrey, gave birth to their son, Ty, at 10:30pm PT last Tuesday night.

last game: 2-4, r, so **DOB/age** 8/17/93 in Ponce, Puerto Rico (27)

last HR 6/23/21 vs. LAD **current hitting streak** 1 g (7/27-)

- ▶ Has a .758 OPS at Petco this year and .576 OPS on the road.
- ▶ Since the All-Star break has a .385 OBP.
- ▶ Has hit safely in 10 of his last 13 games (.316, 12-for-38) and in 11 of his last 15 G.
- ▶ Switch hitter is batting .288 vs. LHP this year and .211 vs. RHP.
- ▶ Has caught 564.1 innings and appeared in 74 G behind the plate with 62 starts...the Padres are 45-29 in games in which he appears behind the plate.

9 JAKE CRONENWORTH - INF - L/R - *CROW-nen-worth*

last game 2-4, r, 2 rbi **DOB/age** 1/21/94 in St. Clair, MI (27)

last HR 7/16/21 @ WSH **current hitting streak** 1 G (7/27-)

- ▶ His 104 hits this season now rank 2nd on the team to Adam Frazier (127) and rank 7th in the National League.
- ▶ Has made appearances at 2B (86 games, 81 starts), 1B (15 games, 12 starts), SS (6 games, 3 starts), and pitcher (1 game in relief).
- ▶ Hit safely in 8 of his last 12 G, batting .304 (14-for-46) with 2 2B, 3 3B, and 1 HR.
- ▶ July 16th, hit for the cycle (doubled in the 2nd inning, tripled in the 3rd, homered in the 5th and singled in the 6th)...was his 1st-career cycle and the 3rd Padre to do so.
- ▶ Played in his 1st-career All-Star game, replacing Freddie Freeman at 1B in the T-6th and drawing a walk in the B-6th.

12 ADAM FRAZIER - INF/OF - L/R

last game 2-5, 2 r **DOB/age** 12/14/91 in Athens, GA (29)

last HR 6/24/21 @ STL **current hitting streak** 1 G (7/27-)

- ▶ Yesterday logged his 1st hits as a Padre in his 1st game since being acquired by SD from PIT on Monday...acquired with cash by SD from PIT for Tucupita Marcano, RHP Michell Miliano and OF Jack Suwinski.
- ▶ His 127 hits lead the Majors...ranks 2nd in AVG in the NL with a .325 clip, trailing Nick Castellanos' .329 AVG.
- ▶ Takes No. 12...Bench/3B Coach Bobby Dickerson changed his number to 22.
- ▶ Started in LF yesterday for his 1st OF start of 2021 and his 1st since Sept. 19, 2020 (has now made 8 OF appearances in 2021, all in LF).
- ▶ Played his 1st-career All-Star Game this year, starting at 2B alongside Fernando Tatis Jr.

2 TRENT GRISHAM - OF - L/R - *GRISH-um*

last game 0-4, so **DOB/age** 11/1/96 in Burseson, TX (24)

last HR 7/7/21 vs. WSH **current hitting streak** -2 g (0-8)

- ▶ Hitting .308 with RISP (20-for-65).
- ▶ Slugging just .272 in July so far.
- ▶ Batting .290 at Petco Park this year and .231 on the road.
- ▶ Trent is very particular about the weather...he does not like mercurial weather, and it's one of the reasons he likes playing in San Diego so much.

30 ERIC HOSMER - 1B - L/L

last game 1-3, bb **DOB/age** 10/24/89 in South Miami, FL (31)

last HR 7/18/21 @ WSH **current hitting streak** 2 g (7/25-27)

- ▶ In his last 8 games, has 7 RBI, 6 BB, and 7 hits.
- ▶ Since the All-Star break, he's slashing .280/.419/.440.
- ▶ Batting .339 in the month of July (21-for-62) with 6 XBH.
- ▶ Batting .343 with RISP this year (35-for-102)...his 35 hits with RISP leads the NL.

7 HA-SEONG KIM - INF - R/R - *HA-sung*

last game did not play **DOB/age** 10/17/95 in Bucheon, South Korea (25)

last HR 6/22/21 vs. LAD **current hitting streak** -2 G (0-6)

- ▶ Has hit in 11 of his last 16 starts.
- ▶ In the field, has made appearances at 2B (15 games), 3B (17 games), and SS (27 G).
- ▶ Clayton Kershaw was his mom's favorite player growing up...said Kim, "My mother always said, 'I want you to play on the same stage as Kershaw.'" ...after he hit a pinch-hit, game deciding HR against Kershaw on June 22 in SD, his family was watching the game live back in Korea, and Ha-Seong said, "My mother cried a little."

13 MANNY MACHADO - 3B - R/R

last game 2-4, hr, 3 rbi, r, so **DOB/age** 7/6/92 in Miami, FL (29)

last HR 7/27/21 vs. OAK **current hitting streak** 2 G (7/25-27)

- ▶ His .312 career AVG vs. OAK is the 4th highest among all active players (min. 150 PA).
- ▶ Homered last night for the 18th time this season, rankin 2nd on the team to Tatis' 31...was the 2nd time this year in which he's homered in back-to-back games.
- ▶ Has hit in 9 of his last 10 games, batting .359 (14-for-39) with 5 2B, 3 HR, and 11 RBI.
- ▶ Reached via hit, walk, or hbp in 23 of his last 26 starts since June 23.
- ▶ His 71 RBI this year leads the team and rans 2nd in the NL to Jesus Aguilar's 72.
- ▶ On July 10, Machado was named to the NL All-Star team in place of Ronald Acuña Jr...was his 5th career All-Star selection, his 1st in the NL, and his 1st since last 2018.
- ▶ Commissioned the Padres "Swagg Chain."
- ▶ Had a mural painted of him on Third Avenue in Chula Vista...see it [here](#).

3 JORGE MATEO - UTL - R/R

last game did not play **DOB/age** 6/23/95 in Santo Domingo, DR (26)
