WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers beat the A's yesterday, 8-6, and club has a 5-3 record entering the finale of this 9-G, 10-day road trip to LAA (2-2), ARI (2-0), and OAK (1-1)... Texas has won 5 of last 6 G, 1st time for club to have 5+ wins in a 6-G span since 6/25-7/1 (also 5-1)...current span included a 4-G win streak from last Sun.-Wed. (9/5-8) that matched longest by the Rangers this season (also 4-0, 6/25-29)...have gone 8-4 in last 12 G, and team's 8 wins since 8/29 rank T2nd-most in A.L. and T3rd-most in MLB behind only TOR (12-2) and MIL (10-3)...have lost 8 of 16, 13 of 23, 16 of 28, and 22 of last 35 G...TEX has a 17-34 (.333) record since the All-Star break, 2nd-fewest wins and 2nd-lowest win pct. in MLB (WAS is 16-37, .302)...club was 18-18 after win on 5/9, but has gone 34-71 (.324) since reaching that point... currently 37 G under .500, this after matching season high at 41-under following loss 9/4 at LAA (also 41-under after loss 8/28 vs. HOU)...team had a 12-G losing streak from 7/10-25, T2nd-longest in club history and longest in 39 years (15, 9/13-30/72; 12, 4/22-5/6/82; 12, 7/10-25/21).

• At 52-89 (.369), TEX has the 2nd-lowest win pct. in the A.L. and 4th-lowest in MLB (ARI/BAL-.324, 46-96; PIT-.366, 52-90)...team is assured of 5th consecutive losing season, most consecutive sub-.500 campaigns in club history...club's 52 wins are T2nd-fewest in TEX club history thru 141 G (50-91 in 1973, 52-89 in 1972/1985/2021).

WITH A WIN TODAY, Texas would:

- Finish the road trip with a 6-3 record, which would be most wins on a single road trip since going 8-2 from 6/10-19/16 at SEA/OAK/STL.
- Go 6-1 in a 7-G span for 1st time since 8/8-15/20.
- Win 2 of 3 road series at OAK this season, this after going 0-7-2 in series at the Coliseum from 2017-20.
- Improve to 3-0-1 in last 4 series, this after losing 7 of previous 8 series.

IN THE STANDINGS: Texas has been in 5th place in the A.L. West for the last 108 days (beg. 5/27)...has lost 10.5 games in division since the All-Star break, but has been between 30.0 and 33.0 GB since 8/20...since 5/25, club has gone from 6.0 GB to 30.0 GB behind 1st place HOU, the 2nd-largest deficit in A.L. and 4th-largest in MLB (46.0 GB--ARI; 43.0 GB--BAL; 35.5 GB--PIT).

ON THE ROAD: TEX is 5-3 entering the finale of this road trip, having already secured a winning multi-city road trip for 1st time since 9/2-8/19 at NYY/BAL (5-2), also last time with at least 5 wins on a single trip...won 4 straight Sun.-Wed. to match longest road win streak in 2020-21 (also 4-0, 4/13-19/21)...Texas is 21-52 (.288) on the road this season, 4th-lowest win pct. in MLB...lost 16 straight (5/10-6/11) and 14 straight (7/4-8/8) this season, the 2 longest road losing skids in TEX history.

VS. OAKLAND: This weekend marks last of 4 trips and 11 G in the Bay Area in 2021 (0-2 from 5/10-11 at SF, 2-1 from 6/29-7/1 at OAK, 0-3 from 8/6-8 at OAK, 1-1 to open this weekend at OAK)...Rangers are 8-10 vs. A's in '21 entering final meeting of the year today...have already lost the season series for a 5th straight year...have lost 7 of last 10 G after a 5-3 start to the year...the series win 6/29-7/1 at OAK was Rangers' 1st at the Coliseum since 2016 (2-1, 9/23-25/16), as TEX is 10-30 in the East Bay since the start of 2017.

HOMEWARD BOUND: The Rangers are scheduled to fly back to the DFW Metroplex following today's game and begin a 7-day, 7-game homestand against the Houston Astros on Monday night...Texas will play 13 of its final 20 games this season in Arlington, starting this this week's homestand against HOU (4 G) and CWS (3 G), teams with 2 of the top 3 records in the A.L...TEX won 3 of last 4 G in Arlington to finish last homestand.

A LATE WIN: The Rangers won yesterday despite trailing 6-2 after 7 innings...according to Elias Sports Bureau, the last Texas win (overall and on road) after the club trailed by 4+ runs in the 7th-or-later came on 5/8/19 at PIT, a 9-6 win over the Pirates in 9 innings...in that game, Hunter Pence hit a game-tying pinch grand slam in the 8th, and the club scored 3 times in the 9th - including a 2-R HR by Rougned Odor... other notes on yesterday's win:

- Matched the largest deficit in any Texas win (any point in game) this season, as club also overcame a 4-R deficit to win on 5/8 vs. SEA.
- \bullet Club's 6th win of the season when trailing after 7 innings, 3rd on the road.
- Team's 6th road win in a game decided in 7th-or-later this season, 17th such win overall.

WHOOMP THERE IT IS: After having gone 4 full games, and a total of 48 innings without hitting a home run, the Rangers hit 3 HR in the final 2 innings of yesterday's game to win it...2 of those were key 2-R HR by DJ Peters and Jonah Heim (goahead 2-R HR) in the 8th inning...Peters' HR in the 8th was the 1st by any Ranger since his previous HR in the 3rd inning on Sun. at LAA (2nd of the game).

SAINT PETERS: DJ Peters registered a game-high 112.2 mph exit velocity on his 2-R HR in the 8th yesterday, the highest figure on any batted ball in his brief ML career...he now has 10 HR in his last 26 G, T4th-most in MLB since 8/13... he is just the 5th Ranger with 10+ HR in 2021: 29-Garcia, 25-Gallo, 14-Lowe, 11-Solak, 10-Peters.

HEIM TIME: Jonah Heim hit a go-ahead 2-R HR off Andrew Chafin in the 8th inning yesterday, giving Texas a 7-6 lead...the Rangers have hit 8 total go-ahead HR in the 8th inning-or-later in 2021, and two batters have accounted for all 8 HR: Adolis García (5) and Jonah Heim (3)...just 4 other ML batters have 3+ GA HR in the 8th-or-later this season.

LATE SCRATCH: LHP Kolby Allard was scratched from his scheduled start yesterday around 1 1/2 hours prior to first pitch...research indicates that the Rangers have not had a starting pitcher scratched on the day of his outing since 2017...that year, Andrew Cashner was scratched from his scheduled start on 8/8/17 at NYM due to neck stiffness after he woke up with the issue...A.J. Griffin made the start in Cashner's place, as he had been slated to start the next day...on 5/2/17 at HOU, Cole Hamels was scratched after experiencing tightness in his right oblique while warming up for this start...Alex Claudio made his 1st MLB start in his' place.

SHORTS: Taylor Hearn has won 3 straight outings, quality starts in 2 straight...over his last 15 G/6 GS, Hearn has a 2.61 ERA (14 ER/48.1 IP) and .199/.265/.339/.604 opp. slash... yesterday was the 3rd time this season for TEX to post a 5+run inning in the 8th-or-later, also a 5-R 9th on 8/19 vs. SEA and 5-R 8th on 5/26 at LAA...yesterday was Rangers' 4th win of season when allowing 6-or-more runs (last 8/13 vs. OAK), 1st such road win since 9/6/19 at BAL (7-6 win)...TEX offense in last 8 day games (5-3): .290/.346/.492/.837, 12 HR, 60 R (7.5 R/G)...batters have posted 10+ hits in each of last 6 day games, hitting .364 (24-66) w/ RISP in those contests.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

#52 Taylor Hearn, LHP (5-4, 3.95)

TODAY: The 27-year-old left-hander is scheduled to make his 39th appearance/8th start of the season in today's road trip finale here in Oakland...has made 4 straight and 6 of his last 8 appearances as a starter...last 15 G/6 GS: 2.61 ERA (14 ER/48.1 IP) and .199/.265/.339/.604 (34-171) opp. slash to lower season ERA from 5.75 to 3.95...last 6 GS: 3-1, 3.56 ERA (12 ER/30.1 IP) and .234/.263/.441/.704 (26-111) opp. slash...has wins in each of his last 3 outings, posting quality starts in both of the last 2...will work on extra 6 days' rest as he has not pitched since a quality start in Texas' 7-3 win last Sun. at LAA (W, 7.0 IP, 3 R-ER)...is 3-2, 4.65 (16 ER/31.0 IP) in 7 starts and 2-2, 3.54 (21 ER/53.1 IP) in 31 relief outings in 2021...left-handed batters are slashing .194/.276/.340/.616 (20-103) w/ 6 XBH (4 HR, 3B, 2B) against Hearn this season...recorded at least one strikeout in 18 straight from 4/20-6/30, and has K's in 36 of 38 outings overall...the Dallas-area product has seen Major League action with Texas in each of the last 3 seasons, working primarily as a reliever after coming up through the minor leagues as a starter...converted to a bullpen role in 2020 after missing most of 2019 with arm issues...is in his 3rd full season in the Texas organization after being acquired in a 3-player trade with the Pittsburgh Pirates on 7/31/18...Texas is 4-3 in his 7 starts this season, winning 3 straight.

WINNING WAYS: Has earned wins in each of his last 3 starts (beg. 8/24), posting a 3.86 ERA (8 ER/18.2 IP) over that span...is seeking to become the 1st Texas pitcher to record wins in 4-or-more consecutive outings since Lance Lynn won 5 straight starts from 6/17-7/11/19...Hearn has not issued a walk in either of his last 2 GS (13.2 IP), joining Kolby Allard as the only Rangers with back-to-back starts of 6.0+ IP and zero BB this season...Allard matched the club record (done 9x) by posting 3 straight such outings from 8/4-15.

• Has a 2.61 ERA (14 ER/48.1 IP) and .199/.265/.339/.604 (34-171) opp. slash over his last 15 G/6 GS (beg. 6/30), A.L.'s 5th-lowest ERA and 6th-lowest opp. BA over that span (min. 40 IP).

LAST START: Logged career-high 7.0 IP in the Rangers' 7-3 win last Sun. at LAA (W, 7 H, 3 R-ER, 0 BB, 4 SO, 2 HR, 77 pitches/54 strikes)...it was just the 4th walkless start of 7.0+ IP by a Ranger in '21, 2nd since the All-Star break (also Foltynewicz, 8/12 at SEA)...77 pitches thrown were the fewest by any Texas pitcher in an outing of 7.0+ IP since Alexi Ogando on 9/22/13 at KC (7.0 IP/77 pitches)... all 3 runs allowed came via pair of home runs by Jo Adell in the 4th (solo) and 6th (2-R) innings.

VS. OAKLAND / A.L. WEST: Has gone 0-1 with a 5.68 ERA (4 ER/6.1 IP) in 5 G/1 GS in his career against the A's, including a 10.80 ERA (4 ER/3.1 IP) in 3 G/1 GS this season...took loss in his 2nd career start, 1st start of 2021, on 6/22 vs. OAK (L, 0.2 IP, 2 H, 4 R-ER, 3 BB, 2 SO, 1 HR)...recorded just two outs (both strikeouts), the 2nd-shortest outing by a Texas starting pitcher in 2021 to only Kyle Gibson's Opening Day start on 4/1 at KC (0.1 IP, 5 R-ER)

• Following a rough outing in his 1st start of the year on 6/22 vs. OAK (0.2 IP, 4 R-ER), Hearn has excelled in his last 5 GS vs. A.L. West clubs: 2-1, 3.20 ERA (9 ER/25.1 IP)...has struck out 18 batters while walking just 2 in those 5 starts, holding opposing batters to a .228 BA/.660 OPS.

ON THE ROAD: This season, has fared better in his 3 road starts (2-0, 3.60 ERA) than in his 4 starts at Globe Life Field (1-2, 5.63 ERA)...opponents have batted .215/.303/.429/.732 (35-163) with 11 HR in his road outings against .253/.321/.387/.708 (38-150) with 4 HR at Globe Life Field.

<u>DAY MAN:</u> Hearn will be making a 3rd straight day start...owns a lifetime 3-0 record and 1.75 ERA (9 ER/46.1 IP) over 21 appearances/3 starts in daytime outings...his 1.83 ERA (8 ER/39.1 IP) in day games this season ranks 2nd in A.L. (min. 35.0 IP) to only CWS' Lance Lynn (1.40)...opponents have batted .191 with a .570 OPS in daytime in '21 against .267 BA/.840 OPS at night.

AS STARTER / RELIEVER: Has gone 2-2, 3.57 (28 ER/70.2 IP) in 45 career relief outings and 3-3, 5.74 (20 ER/31.1 IP) in 8 career starts...pitched primarily as a starter in the minor leagues - posting a 3.51 ERA in 77 games/64 starts - before converting to a bullpen role last season.

- <u>As starter:</u> Is 3-2, 4.65 (16 ER/31.0 IP) in 7 starts this season, including 3-1, 3.56 (12 ER/30.1 IP) in last 6 GS...has set career highs for innings in each of his last 4 starts...walks per 9 innings figure as a starter this season (2.03) is far better than his mark as a reliever (4.56)...has issued one-or-zero BB in 5 of 7 GS this season, including zero BB in straight and 3 of last 4 GS.
- <u>As reliever</u>: Has gone 2-2, 3.54 (21 ER/53.1 IP) in 31 bullpen appearances this season...55 relief strikeouts are still 2nd-most among Rangers (59-Sborz)... career-high 7 K's on 4/12 at TB, matching most in club history by a relief pitcher in 3.0-or-fewer innings (3rd time)...had 10.2-inning scoreless streak from 4/25-5/19...recorded at least one strikeout in 18 straight relief outings from 4/20-6/30.
