HIT PARADE: The Royals overcame a six-run deficit to complete a 10-7 comeback win vs. the Athletics last night, matching their largest comeback win of the season...they trailed 6-0 in the third inning, when the offense started chipping away at Oakland's lead with a three spot on a pair of RBI singles and an RBI groundout. trailing 7-4 in the sixth, the Royals recorded four consecutive one-out hits, capped by a go-ahead, three-run homer by Salvador Perez, his 43 rd of the season...Kyle Isbel added a two-run shot in the seventh-his firs career homer-and the Royals' bullpen did not allow a hit after the fifth inning to secure the wild win at The K + The Royals' 14 hits fell one shy of their season high, and they scored 10 runs for the sixth time this season-five of which have come at home-but it was their first 10-run output since June 4 vs . the Twins

+ Whit Merrifield, Nicky Lopez and Isbel each recorded three hits and it was Whit's second straight three-
hit game...last night was the third time this season the Royals had three different players record three hits five batters...last night marked the first time the Royals won a game in which their starter recorded three outs or fewer since a 9-1 win vs. the White Sox on May 13, 2012, when Danny Duffy exited after two outs
- Jake Brentz earned the win on his 27th birthday, becoming the seventh Royals pitcher-and fourth

ROSTER MOVE: The Royals announced that they have placed left hander Mike Minor on the 10-day Injured List with a left shoulder impingement...Minor was originally scheduled to start tonight...in a corresponding

THE RALLY ROYALS: The Royals recorded their 37th comeback win of the season last night, which are their most since 2017 ( 46 comeback wins) and are fourth most in the American League behind Tampa Bay (43) Boston (42) and New York (38)...the Royals overcame a 6-0 deficit to match their largest margin overcome in a win this season, following a 9-8 win on July 24 vs. Detroit, when they erased a 6-0 lead...according to Elias, this marks the first time the Royals have overcome a six-run deficit to win twice in the same season since 2006 when they had three such wins, and they are one of five teams in the Majors this season with multiple wins when trailing by at least six runs...last night marked the Royals' fourth win when trailing by at least five runs and their eighth win when trailing by at least four, both of which are the most in the Majors, according to Elias

SALVY SPLASHES: Salvador Perez hit the go-ahead, three-run home run last night in the sixth inning to complete the Royals' six-run comeback, marking his 15th go-ahead homer this season, which are two behind Nolan Arenado (17) for the Majors lead...last night's homer was his 43rd of the season, third most in the Majors behind Shohei Ohtani (44) and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (45)...it was his 195th career home run, two shy of Mike Sweeney (197) for second in Royals history, and with 18 games remaining, Salvy is five homers shy of matching Jorge Soler (48 HR in 2019) for the club's single-season record, and he's attempting to become the first Royal to lead the Majors in HR....after hitting 21 home runs in 89 games before the All-Star break, Perez leads the Majors since the break with 22 homers in 54 games, three more than Joey Votto (19)

+ Of Salvy's 43 home runs, 29 have come as a catcher, which are six shy of Hall of Famer Iván Rodríguez's American League record of 35 HR as a catcher, set in 1999, according to Elias...Perez's 43 homers are tied with Javy Lopez for the second most Salvy enters today with 109 RBI, two more than José Abreu (107) for the Major Lag as atcher, Salvy enters today with 109 RBI, two more than José Abreu (107) for the Major League lead, and he's attempting to become the second Royal to lead the Majors in RBI, and would join Hal McRae, who recorded a Majors-best 133 RBI in 1982...Salvy also leads the Majors with 56 RBI in 54 games since the All-Star break, and he's on pace for 123 RBI, which would be third-highest single-season total in Royals history behind Sweeney (144 in 2000) and Hal McRae (133 in 1982), and would be the most by any player who played at least 75\% of his games at catcher since Mike Piazza had 124 RBI in 1999 The last to lead the Majors in both HR and RBI was Giancarlo Stanton in 2017, when he won NL MVP - In his last 162 games since Aug. 12, 2020, Perez is batting 285 (179-for-629) with 51 homers and 132 RBI
+ Perez has four home runs and 12 RBI in his last three home games, and has 23 homers and 62 RBI in 70 games at Kauffman Stadium this season...his 23 homers are the most in a single season in the 49 year history of this ballpark, two more than Chili Davis (1997), Dean Palmer (1998) and Soler (2019)
+ In five games vs. the A's this season, Salvy is batting 400 ( 8 -for- 20 ) with three home runs and six RBI,
ROberto CLEMENTE DAY: Today is the 2Oth annual Roberto Clemente Day, which was established by Major League Baseball to honor Clemente's legacy as a humanitarian and to formally acknowledge club nominees of the Roberto Clemente Award...for the first time, today's league-wide celebration will allow the nominees and previous award winners the option to wear Roberto's No. 21 on their uniform....Salvador Perez is the Royals' nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award, baseball's most prestigious individual honor...the award is the annual recognition of a Major League player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions on and off the field
+ The league-wide winner will be selected via a blue ribbon panel, including Commissioner Manfred representatives from MLB-affiliated networks, MLB.com and Roberto's children, Enrique, Luis and Roberto Clemente Jr...fans can vote for the Award through the end of the season via mib.com/clemente21.

SCORING CHANGE: Andrew Benintendi has been going so good that he picked up another hit in his sleep as the league this morning announced a scoring change to the Sept. 8 game in Baltimore...in the fifth inning Benintendi reached on what was originally ruled a fielder's choice RBI, but has been changed to an RBI single,
giving him a four-hit game, which means he hit $536(15-$-for- 28$)$ in VS. ATHLETICS: With a win tonight or tomorrow, the Royals would clinch their first series win over the Athletics since taking two of three from Aug. 14-16, 2017 in Oakland, and it would mark their first series win vs. the Athletics at Kauffman Stadium since they took two of three from April

LOVE FOR LOPEZ: Nicky Lopez was one of three Royals to record three hits last night, extending his hit streak to 10 games, a stretch in which he's batting . 444 (20-for-45) with eight multi-hit efforts...this streak is the second-longest active run in the American League, according to Elias, and is two games shy of his career-best 12-game hit streak from Aug. 16-29, 2019...Lopez also has a career-best 23-game on-base streak, which is the longest streak by a Royal since Jorge Soler reached in 25 straight from Sept. 14, 2019-Aug. 3, 2020...Lopez leads the Majors with 39 hits and a 402 + Lopez Lopez has 69 hits in 52 games since the All-Star break, which are tied for third most in the Majors and are tied with Freddie Freeman for the most among left-handed batters since the break...Lopez ranks sixth in the Majors since the break with a 347 average, second best among lefties,

+ After batting .226 ( 36 -for-159) through his first 59 games of the season, Lopez is batting a Major League-best. 348 ( 94 -for-270) in his last 74 games since June 15 with an American League-leading .395 on-base percentage, which ranks fourth among all big leaguers during that time. Lopez stole his 20th base of the season last night, improving to 20 -for- 20 on the year, which marks the most steals without being caught in the Majors...the only player in Royals history to finish a season with more steals without being caught was Alcides Escobar, who went 22 -for- 22 in 2013 .

BLANKING IN BALTIMORE: Carlos earned his fifth straight winning decision in th Royals' 6-0 win last Thursday in Baltimore, in which he allowed just three hits and three walks in 6.0 scoreless innings, with one strikeout....all three of Baltimore's hits came consecutively in the second inning, but Carlos escaped the jam thanks to a 7-2 outfield assist by Andrew Benintendi...Hernández and two relievers did not allow a

THE GREAT EIGHT: Carlos has won five consecutive decisions over his last eight appearances (7 starts) since July 29, a stretch in which he's 5-0 with a 1.68 ERA ( 9 ER in 48.1 IP ) and .192 opponents' average ( 32 -for-167)...his ERA during this stretch leads the American League, his five wins are tied for the league lead and his opponents' average ranks second, trailing Triston McKenzie (.140)...Hernández has held opponents to one run or fewer in six of his last eight outings, and four of the 10 runs he's allowed since July 29 came in one start on Aug. 16 vs. Houston, a 7-6 Royals win...they are 7-1 in his last eight appearances, including wins in each of his last five. + Carlos made the Opening Day roster but pitched to an 8.22 ERA (7 ER in 7.2 IP) over his first two big league stints...he was recalled on June 9 and has been with the Royals since, going 5-1 with a 2.74 ERA ( 21 ER in 69.0 IP) and .198 opponents' average ( 48 -for-242) in 18 outings ( 9 starts), and his ERA during that stretch ranks second in the American League (min. 60.0 IP), higher only than Robbie Ray (2.29).

THE HERNÁNDEZ HEAT: Carlos has hit 100.0 mph on 30 of his pitches this season, 11 of which have come as a starting pitcher, which matches Shohei Ohtani for the fifthmost pitches at triple digits among all starters, trailing Jacob deGrom (185), Sandy Alcántara (53), Gerrit Cole (31) and Shane McClanahan (15)...in the Pitch Tracking Era (since 2008), only one Royal has recorded more triple-digit velocity pitches in starting role in a single season, and that was Yordano Ventura, who did it in 2014 (135) 2015 (50) and in 2016 (29)...the only other Royals to his 100.0 mph as a starter in the last 14 years were Danny Duffy (2012), Felipe Paulino (2011) and Zack Greinke (2010). + Carlos threw a pitch at 100.9 mph in the sixth inning on July 6, which was fouled off by Cincinnati's Mike Freeman...it was the fastest pitch of his big league career, and marked the second-highest velocity on a pitch by a Royal this year, trailing Josh Staumont's 101.8 mph pitch on April 23 at Detroit vs. Robbie Grossman...Hernández threw five pitches in that game that registered at 100.0 mph or more-and did it again on July 18 vs . Baltimore-to mark the most such pitches in a game by a Royal since Staumont threw nine pitches at 100.0 mph or greater in Game 2 of a double dip on Aug. 19, 2020 vs. Cincinnati (Game 2).

GROUNDED: Carlos has not allowed a homer in his last four appearances, marking a career-best 24.2-inning homerless streak...he's allowed just six home runs in 76.2 innings in the Majors this season, good for a $0.70 \mathrm{HR} / 9$, which is second lowest in the American League (min. 75.0 IP ), higher only than Alex Cobb ( $0.35 \mathrm{HR} / 9$ in 77.2 IP ).

REVERSE SPLITS: Carlos has held left-handed batters to a .174 average ( 21 -for-121) this year, and just five of those 21 hits have gone for extra bases, resulting in a . 256 slugging percentage...that leads the American League among right-handed pitchers (min. 125 lefties faced)...he's allowed just one extra-base hit to the 85 lefties he's faced h his last eight appearances, a double to switch hitter Ian Happ on Aug. 22 in Chicago.

+ On the other hand, right-handed batters are batting .242 (37-for-152) vs. Carlos this season and they have accounted for 12 of the 17 extra-base hits he's allowed + Over his last four outings, he has held opponents on both sides to a .155 average

VS. OAKLAND: Hernández made his only previous appearance vs. the Athletics on June 12 in Oakland, which was his first outing after his June 9 recall...he was charged with one run-a solo home run to Matt Chapman-on two hits in 1.1 innings, with two strikeouts, in the Royals' 11-2 loss,

+ In his second outing vs. an opponent he's already faced this season, Carlos is 2-0 with a 2.13 ERA ( 6 ER in 25.1 IP) in seven appearances ( 4 starts).. five of the six runs he's allowed in those outings came on July 24 vs. Detroit, but he's posted a O.4O ERA (1 ER in 22.2 IP) in the other six outings.

AT HOME: Carlos is $3-1$ with a 3.86 ERA ( 18 ER in 42.0 IP) in 12 appearances ( 6 starts) at Kauffman Stadium this season, including 2-O with a 2.55 ERA ( 7 ER in 24.2 IP) in his last four home starts...the Royals are $4-2$ in his six home starts, and his only loss came on July 18 vs. Baltimore...after recording just 4.0 innings and 2.2 innings in his first two home starts, Hernández has completed at least 6.0 innings in each of his last four starts in Kansas City.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER: LHP DANIEL LYNCH (4-4, 5.37)

+ Daniel will make the 13th start of his rookie season in tomorrow afternoon's series finale vs. the Athletics at Kauffman Stadium.
+ In his last start on Friday at Minnesota, Lynch did not factor into the decision of a 6-4 Royals victory...he threw 6.0 innings, allowing four runs on a career-high-tying seven hits, with no walks and four strikeouts...the outing was his longest since throwing 7.0 innings vs. the Astros on Aug. 17 at Kauffman Stadium...Lynch began the game by allowing a leadoff home run to Byron Buxton, which was followed by a Jorge Polanco double and Rob Refsnyder single...with a full count, Josh Donaldson brought both runners in with a three-run home run to left field....after that, Lynch retired 18 of the next 21 batters, stranding one base runner in the second and two in the fourth, and recorded 1-2-3 third, fifth and sixth innings.
+ Since his recall from Triple-A Omaha on July 25, Lynch has gone 4-2 with a 3.67 ERA ( 20 ER in 49.0 IP) and the Royals are $7-2$ in those games.
+ Daniel will be making his first career start vs. Oakland tomorrow...he has faced AL West teams three times this season, going 2-0 with a 1.62 ERA (3 ER in 16.2 IP) with 14 strikeouts in those starts...three out of Lynch's previous four starts have come on the road.
+ In six home starts this season, he's gone 2-2 with a 6.83 ERA ( 21 ER in 27.2 IP)...he threw 8.0 scoreless innings on July 25 vs. the Tigers at The K.


## MANAGER MIKE MATHENY

+ With a win on Opening Day vs. Texas, Mike Matheny-in his ninth season as a Major League manager-became the ninth active manager to record a win vs. all 30 teams, according to Elias, joining Dusty Baker (24th season), Bud Black (14th season), Terry Francona (21st season), Joe Girardi (13th season), AJ Hinch (8th season), Joe Maddon (18th season), Don Mattingly (11th season) and Bob Melvin (18th season). The game on July 30 marked Matheny's 162nd game as Royals manager, in which he went 71-91, matching the number of wins the Royals had in Ned Yost's first full season as manager in 2011, and marked a 12-game improvement on the Royals' 2019 season under Yost, in which they went 59-103. + Matheny was named the Royals' 17th full-time manager on Oct. 31, 2019 and has a 683-586 record over nine seasons as a manager-including seven years in St. Louis-and his 683 wins are the ninth most among active managers....his .538 win percentage ranks sixth among active skippers. + This is Matheny's second big league managerial stint, after leading the St. Louis Cardinals from 2012-2018, then serving as a Special Advisor to Player Development for the Royals during the 2019 campaign....he posted a winning record in each of his seven seasons with St. Louis, including a Major League-best 100 victories in 2015...Matheny led the Cardinals to the postseason in each of his first four seasons from 2012-15, becoming the first manager to do that in Major League history...under his leadership, the Cardinals were a Wild Card qualifier in 2012, before winning three-straight National League Central titles (2013-15) and winning the National League pennant in 2013


## REPLAY SPECIALIST BILL DUPLISSEA

+ Royals' replay specialist Bill Duplissea was unsuccessful in his most recent challenge on Aug. 27 in Seattle where replay upheld a juggling catch by second baseman Abraham Toro to retire Andrew Benintendi. + He's challenged 115 calls since 2018, and just six of them have been confirmed, including four this season, the first of which came on May 13 and snapped a streak of 35 challenges without one being confirmed.... he also had a streak of 48 straight without a confirmed from Sept. 27, 2017-April 9, 2019. Duplissea is 16 -for- 31 on challenges this season, and owns a Majors-best $69.5 \%$ success rate ( 132 -for-190) since 2016, well ahead of the Yankees, who rank second with a $64.5 \%$ overturn rate, and well above the Majors average, which is $49.7 \%$ this season as of the last update from Major League Baseball on Sept. 9...the Royals have finished in the top three in replay success rate in each of the last five seasons from 2016-20, including a 78.6 success rate in 2018, which is the best rate by any team since 2016 .
+ Scott picked up his 13th save of the season with a scoreless ninth last night, working around two walks...since Aug. 8, he is $2-0$ with seven saves and a 1.04 ERA ( 2 ER in 17.1 IP) with 16 strikeouts to just five walks, and his 1.04 ERA since then ranks fourth in the AL (min. 15 games). + Barlow has been one of Kansas City's most reliable relievers, leading the club (min. 25.0 IP) in innings (69.1), ERA (2.34), wins (5) and saves (13). + With a 2.34 ERA ( 18 ER in 69.1 IP) in 66 outings, he's the first Royals reliever to appear in at least 65 games and maintain an ERA lower than or equal to 2.50 since Ryan Madson (2.13) in 2015...his ERA ranks eighth in Major League Baseball among pitchers who have appeared in 60+ games.

+ Jake earned his fifth win of his rookie season last night on his 27th birthday, recording a 1-2-3 sixth to become the first Royal to win on his birthday since Foster Griffin on July 27,2020 in Detroit...it was his second win in as many appearances, following a win on Sunday in Minnesota. + His 66 appearances are tied for sixth most in the Majors and trail Andrew Sisco (67 outings in 2005) for fifth most by a Royals rookie... + Has nine saves and a 0.95 ERA vs. Oakland over 19.0 career innings, and hasn't allowed a run to them since June 14, 2011 , giving him 16.1 consecutive scoreless innings vs. the A's...his 16-game scoreless streak vs. Oakland is tied for the third longest since 1920, trailing only a $17-$ game streak by Jeff Russell from Sept. 25, 1989-April 28, 1994 and an 18-game stretch by Félix Hernández from June 4, 1999 -June 27 , 2004.

+ Joel allowed one run on two hits over 2.0 innings last night vs. the A's, and stranded Starling Marte at first after inheriting him from Ervin Santana. + He was reinstated from the Injured List Monday after missing the final two games of the series in Minneapolis vs. the Twins.
+ Since joining the Royals on Aug. 16, he has a 4.63 ERA ( 6 ER in 11.2 IP ) and 10 strikeouts, but three of those seven runs came on Sept. 8 in Baltimore. + He earned his first Major League win on Aug. 28 in Seattle, after allowing just one hit over 2.2 scoreless innings of relief to maintain a two-run lead.
+ Covered 2.0 innings after relieving Jackson Kowar in the second inning last night vs. the A's and allowed one run on three hits with two strikeouts.
+ Santana earned his second win of the year Friday night in Minnesota with a scoreless 10th inning...he owns a 2.49 ERA ( 6 ER in 21.2 IP) in 15 outings since Aug. 1, and his appearance on Friday marked his 34th of the 2021 campaign, a new single-season career high.
+ Ervin picked up his first win of the season, and 150th of his career, with 2.0 scoreless innings of relief on Aug. 26 th in Seattle.
+ Is 17-7 lifetime vs. the A's with a 1.96 ERA ( 46 ER in 211.0 IP) in 34 games ( 30 starts)...his 1.96 ERA vs. Oakland is the lowest in the Live Ball Era (1920-), ahead of Urban Shocker (2.15 ERA in 268.1 IP from 1920-27) and Luis Tiant (2.23 ERA in 294.0 IP from 1964-80), (min. 200.0 IP vs. the A's).
+ Recorded a 1-2-3 eighth inning last night vs. the Athletics, retiring Tony Kemp, Elvis Andrus and Josh Harrison on just 11 pitches.
+ Staumont has recorded at least one strikeout in 30 of his last 36 games since June 6, including two Friday night to Rob Refsnyder and Miguel Sanó. + Josh recorded the fastest pitch by a Royal this season, a 101.8-mph ball to Robbie Grossman on April 23 at Comerica Park in Detroit.
+ Domingo retired all three A's batters he saw last night on 11 pitches...despite not being given an inherited runner last night, he has stranded 14 of 17 runners that he's inherited, which does not include automatic runners in extra innings.
