1981 - In a 500 win over the Dodgers in the Dome, RHP Nolan Ryan makes history with his Major League-record fifth no-hitter...Ryan tallies 11 strikeouts in his record-setting performance.

TODAY'S GAME: The first-place Astros enter today's game with a magic number of two to clinch the AL West, needing a win today and a loss by the Mariners to punch their ticket into the postseason... RHP Jake Odorizzi will get the start for Houston today after spending the last 13 days on the IL with right foot soreness...he'll be opposed by RHP Paul Blackburn, who's allowed 13 earned runs in 6.1 innings in a couple appearances in his career opposite Houston.

TODAY'S STARTER: RHP Jake Odorizzi returns to the rotation today after missing a couple turns in the rotation due to injury...prior to being sidelined, Odiorizzi was on a strong run, having posted a 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in his last seven outings.

ON THE BRINK: The Astros are on the brink of their fifth straight postseason appearance (2017-21), which would extend their franchise record...a clinch today would give the Astros their 10th division title in club history and their fourth in the last five seasons.. Houston's division title history: NL West (1980, 1986), NL Central (1997-99, 2001), AL West (2017-19).

BACK IN HOUSTON: Should the Astros clinch the division today, the Astros Team Store at Minute Maid Park will open tomorrow morning at 5 a.m. and will have exclusive clinch product available for purchase.

## WHERE WE STAND: At 91-64, the Astros check

WRAPPING UP THE ROAD: Today is the Astros final regular season road game of the 2021 season... the Astros are 44-36 (.550) on the road and rank fourth in the AL in road win percentage...as of today, their 44 road wins are the second-highest total in the AL.

VS. THE WEST: The Astros are 47-25 vs. the AL West, including winning records against all divisional foes, the Rangers (14-5), Angels (13-6), M's (11-8) and A's (9-6)... with four games remaining with the A's, the Astros need one win to secure a season series win.

ON THE OFFENSIVE: The Astros lead the Majors in runs scored (830), hits (1433), OBP (.340) and batting average (.268), while ranking second in OPS (.783) and fourth in SLG (.443)...additionally, the Astros have struck out the fewest times in the Majors (1173).

AT THE HELM: Astros manager Dusty Baker has reached 90 wins in each of his last five full seasons as a manager (2012-13 with CIN, 2016-17 with WAS, 2021 with HOU)...he is one of two active managers to reach 90 or more wins in their last five full seasons... the other is Dave Roberts, who has also reached that plateau in his last five full seasons (2016-19, 2021)... also, this is Baker's 11th 90 -win season in his career.

TODAY'S ROSTER MOVE: The Astros have reinstated RHP Jake Odorizzi off the 10-day IL today... he takes the roster spot of RHP Seth Martinez, who was optioned to the Taxi Squad.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad for this road trip is RHP Josh James, RHP Seth Martinez and C Garrett Stubbs...additionally, OF Michael Brantley and RHP Zack Greinke are on the trip as IL players.

STREAKER: 2B Jose Altuve is riding a 13-game hitting streak into today's game, in which he's hitting .327 (17×52)...the streak is his second-longest of the season, trailing only a 17-game streak from May 5-23, and is the longest active streak in the AL.

MILESTONE LONGBALL: 2B Jose Altuve reached a couple milestones with Friday night's solo homer...it marked his 163rd career homer, which ties him with OF Cesar Cedeño for seventh on the Astros franchise list in home runs...next on the list for Altuve is sixth-place 1B Glenn Davis (166 HR), who we trails by three homers...additionally, last Friday's homer was Altuve's 30th of the season, giving him his second career 30 -homer season and leaving him just one homer shy of tying his career high (31 HR in 2019).

MVP COMPANY: Since May 2, RF Kyle Tucker leads the AL in batting average (.324) and OPS (.997)... on the season, he ranks fourth in the AL in OPS (.914) and ninth in average (.293).

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Astros and A's played a tight ballgame yesterday, with the A's walking off with a $2-1$ win on an RBI double by CF Starling Marte.. the starters for both teams were dealing with both LHP Framber Valdez (1ER/6.2IP) and LHP Sean Manaea (1ER/7IP) pitching into the 7th...the Astros scored their lone run on a solo homer by RF Kyle Tucker.

ON THE MEND: RHP Pedro Báez, on the IL with right shoulder soreness, made his second injury rehab appearance with Triple A Sugar Land last night, tossing 0.2 of an inning and 28 pitches, allowing 2 runs...RHP Tyler Ivey, on the IL with right elbow soreness, is scheduled to make an injury rehab appearance with Sugar Land tonight at El Paso.

ABOUT ODORIZZI: veteran pitcher has made 213 career starts and 21 with the Astros this season.

- has been on a strong run in his last 7 outings, posting a 2-1 record and a 2.78 ERA (10ER/32.1IP) in that span.
- the Astros have won 7 of his last 10 starts... in those 10 outings, the Astros have scored $5+$ runs in 9 of those 10 .
- on the season, has allowed a 244 opponent batting average with even splits against right-handed hitters (.241) and lefties (.230)...has been particularly effective the first two times through the lineup, allowing just a .205 mark the first time through and a .226 average the second.
- has had his first season with the Astros slowed for various reasons... signed in March and began his season at the Astros ATS before being activated on April 11 ...missed 29 team games while on the IL (right pronator muscle strain) from April 25 -May 28 ...also missed 12 team games while on the AL from (right foot soreness) Sept. 14-26.
- the 2019 All-Star joined the Astros on a two-year free agent contract on March 8, 2021.
- the Astros are his fourth MLB organization to pitch for, also Kansas City (2012), Tampa Bay (2013-17) and Minnesota (2018-20)...is a lifetime $68-63$ in 216 MLB games ( 212 starts).
- is known as a durable starter, having made at least 28 starts in six consecutive seasons (2013-19) prior to running into injury issues in 2020.
VS. OAK: will make his start against the A's this season...in his last start on July 19,2019 , he allowed 3 runs on 6 hits with 2 walks and 3 strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
- in his career against Oakland, he's recorded a 4.03 ERA (20ER/44.2IP) with 33 strikeouts and a 1.12 WHIP.
THE 2020 CAMPAIGN: had an injury marred 2020 season with the Twins, missing time with a right intercostal strain, a chest contusion and a right middle finger blister.
- made a total of 4 starts between IL stints, posting a 6.59 ERA (10ER/13.2IP) with 12 strikeouts in 13.2 innings pitched.
- held leff-handed batters to a .190 batting average ( $4 \times 21$ ) and .451 OPS.
