YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees won their season-high 13th straight game on Friday with an 8-2 win vs. the A's at Oakland Coliseum...RHP Gerrit Cole (6.0IP, 6H, 0R, 2BB, Oakland Coliseum...RHP Gerrit Cole (6.0IP, 6H, 0R, 2BB, 9K) tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to earn his 13th win of the season...RF Giancarlo Stanton (2-for-4, 1R, 1HR, 1RBI) hit a 474-foot solo HR in the fourth inning...DH Luke Voit (1-for-4, 1HR, 1RBI, 1HP) also hit a solo HR in the fourth...CF/RF Aaron Judge (3-for-5, 1R, 1HR, 4RBI) hit a three-run HR in the fifth and an RBI single in the ninth...C Kyle Higashioka (2-for-4, 2R, 1HR, 2RBI) hit a two-run HR in the ninth...2B DJ LeMahieu (2-for-5, 2R) and 1B Anthony Rizzo (2-for-5) each picked up multi-hit games...LHP Joely Rodriguez allowed 2R/1ER in 0.1IP (2H, 1BB)...RHP Chad Green tossed 1.2 scoreless innings of relief (1BB, 3K)...LHP Lucas Luetge (1.0IP, 2K) tossed a perfect ninth inning. MILESTONE MAN: Manager Aaron Boone has 312 managerial wins and needs one win to tie Buck Showalter (313) for ninth place on the Yankees' all-time managerial wins list.

SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Yankees own a 10-series winning streak, their longest since a 10-series winning streak from 6/22-7/22/54... with a win today, would be their longest such streak since 1943 when they won a franchise-record 13 straight series (credit: Elias)...have won 15 of their last 16 completed series.

NASTY NESTOR: LHP Nestor Cortes has posted a 2.56 ERA (56.1IP, 16ER) with 60K in 15 appearances (seven starts) for the Yankees this season...since making his season debut on 5/30, his 2.56 ERA is the second-lowest in the AL (min. 50.0IP), trailing only Toronto's Robbie Ray (2.15)...ranks seventh in the Majors over that span.

STANTON ISLAND: DH/OF Giancarlo Stanton hit a solo HR in the fourth inning on Friday at Oakland...has homered in four straight regular season games for the third time in his career: 6G from 8/10-15/17 and 4G from 8/14-17/11 (also Homored in five straight postseason games from 2020 ALWC Game 1 - 2020 ALDS Game 3)...has 6HR in his last 9G...has 8RBI over his last five games and 11RBI in his last 10.

• According to Statcast, his HR on Friday traveled an estimated 472 feet...in the Statcast era (since 2015),

Stanton has hit 9HR that have an estimated measurement of at least 470 feet...no other player has hit more than four in that span (Mike Trout, George Springer and Miguel Sanó all have four).

Has reached base in a season-high 23 straight games (since 8/2)...is the second-longest on-base streak of his career, trailing only a 27-game streak from 7/24-8/22/17...is batting .329/.421/.671 (27-for-82) with 16R, 4 doubles, 8HR, 21RBI, 11BB and 2HP in that span.

CLOSE CALLS: The Yankees have had 71 games this season determined by 2R-or-fewer, the second-most such games in the Majors, trailing only the Mets (72)...their 71 games decided by 2R-or-fewer are their most in a single season since 2015 (76)...their 48-23 (.676) record in those games is the best in the Majors...marks their second-highest winning percentage in games decided by 2R-or-fewer in a single season in franchise history, trailing only their .688 (44-20) record in 1951 (also had a .676 mark in 2004, going 50-24). WINNING WAYS: The Yankees have won a season-high 13 straight games, their longest winning streak since a 13-game winning streak from

9/1-12/61...marks just the ninth time in franchise history the Yankees have won 13 consecutive games (see chart on right)...their 13-game winning streak matches the longest by any Major League team over the last Major League team over the last four seasons (also Oakland's 13game streak from 4/9-24/21).

FOR STARTERS: Yankees starters own a 2.93 FRA (240.0IP. 78ER) and 259K in their last 46 starts (since 7/4-Game 2)... have allowed 3R-or-fewer in 40 of their last 46 starts and 2ERor-fewer in 34 of those starts.

SUMMER HEAT: The Yankees have posted a 34-11 (.756) record since 7/6, the best record in the Majors in that span.

▶ The Yankees are 25-5 in their last 30 games (since 7/27), their best 30-game span in a single season since going 25-5 from 4/21-5/26/98.

BRONX BOMBERS: Yankees batters hit 4HR on Friday... have hit at least 3HR in a season-high three straight games, their longest such streak since a three-game stretch from 9/15-17/20...their last longer streak was a four-game stretch from 8/5-8/19...have hit 10HR in their last three games.

- Have homered in a season-high-tying seven straight games (also 7G from 5/4-11), hitting 17HR in that span...their last longer stretch was a 10-game span from 8/11-26/20.

ALL RISE: RF Aaron Judge drove in four of the Yankees' 8R on Friday at Oakland, hitting a three-run HR in the fifth and an RBI single in the ninth...has multiple hits in a career-high

- four straight games.

 Owns a season-high 19-game on-base streak (since 8/7)... is his longest on-base streak since a 21-game streak from 4/1-26/18...is the fourth-longest on-base streak of his career, trailing a 32-game streak (5/28-6/30/17), 26-game streak (9/3/17-3/29/18) and a 21-game streak (4/1-26/18)...is hitting .362/.464/.696 (25-for-69) with 14R, 5 doubles, 6HR, 19RBI, 14BB/1IBB, 4SB and 1SF in that span.
- Has reached base multiple times in 11 of his last 15 games, 12 of his last 17 games and 13 of his last 19. Is hitting .330/.434/.538 (30-for-91) with 4 doubles, 5HR, 40RBI, 18BB/2IBB, 1HP and 3SF with RISP this season.

COLE TRAIN: RHP Gerrit Cole tossed 6.0 scoreless on Friday to extend his scoreless streak to 16.2 innings, the longest by a Yankee this season...marked his seventh scoreless start of at least 6.0IP this season, tied with Philadelphia's Zack Wheeler (seven) and Milwaukee's Corbin Burnes (seven) for the most in the Majors this season...his seven such starts are the most by a Yankee in a single season since Hiroki Kuroda in 2013 (eight).

Reached 200K on Friday, becoming the 16th Yankee (19th time) to record at least 200K in a season and first since Luis Severino (2017-18)...reached the milestone in 24 starts, the fastest Yankee in franchise history to accomplish the feat (previous: David Cone - 25 starts in 1998).

HOMETOWN HERO: INF Andrew Velazquez is hitting .313/.333/.563 (10-for-32) with 7R, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1HR, 6RBI, 1BB and 3SB in his last 10 games (since 8/17-G1).

LUUUUUUKE: INF Luke Voit is hitting .452/.528/.935 (14-for-31) with 8R, 3 doubles, 4HR, 14RBI, 3BB and 2HP in his last 11 games (since 8/15)...has 12RBI in his last six starts, 14RBI in his last eight starts and 18RBI in his last 13 starts.

ROLL CALL: The Yankees have used 57 players this season (P: 28, C: 3, INF: 13, OF: 13), their second-highest total in franchise history (58 players in 2014).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP NESTOR CORTES (2-1, 2.56)

LHP Nestor Cortes will make his eighth start and 16th appearance of the season today at Oakland...will make the start on extended seven days' rest...last pitched on 8/20 vs. Minnesota, tossing a career-high 7.0 innings (4H, 2ER, 2BB, 7K, 1HR, 1HP) and earning his second win of the season...was signed to a Major League contract and selected to the Yankees' 26-man roster from Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre prior to the game on 5/30 at Detroit...was signed by the Yankees as a minor league free agent on 1/4/21...in 2020, went 0-1 with a 15.26 ERA (7.2IP, 13ER) in five games (one start) with the Seattle Mariners before missing the remainder of the season with a left elbow impingement...was originally selected by the Yankees in the 36th round of the 2013 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft...was selected by the Baltimore Orioles from the Yankees in the 2017 Rule 5 Draft and returned to the Yankees on 4/13/18...was acquired by the Seattle Mariners from the Yankees in exchange for international bonus pool money on 7/25/19... over parts of four Major League season, has played with Baltimore (2018), the Yankees (2019, '21) and Seattle (2020).

LAST TIME OUT: Made his seventh start and 15 appearance of the season on 8/20 vs. Minnesota, tossing a career-high 7.0 innings (4H, 2ER, 2BB, 7K, 1HR, 1HP) and earning his second win of the season...surrendered a two-run HR to Josh Donaldson in the sixth inning...also threw a career-high 104 pitches (previous: 98) and tied his career high in strikeouts (also 7K on 8/15/21 at Chicago-AL and 6/15/19 at Chicago-AL).

NASTY NESTOR: Since making his season debut on 5/30, his 2.56 ERA (56.1IP, 16ER) is the second-lowest in the AL and 10th-lowest in the Majors over that span (min. 40.0IP).

VS. OAKLAND: Will make his fourth career appearance (first start) against the Athletics today...has a 3.86 ERA (7.0IP, 3ER) and 10K without recording a decision in three relief appearances

- Has made one apppearance vs. Oakland this season, allowing 1H over 3.0 scoreless innings of relief (1BB, 3K) on 6/19/21 in the Bronx.
- Has made five appearances (two starts) vs. the AL West this season, posting a 1.17 ERA (15.1IP, 2ER) and 11K withour recording a decision...is 1-1 with a 7.08 ERA (34.1IP, 27ER) in 17 career appearances (three starts) against the AL West.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is 1-1 with a 3.23 ERA (30.2IP, 11ER) in seven road appearances (four starts) this season...in 30 career appearances (six starts) on the road, is 4-3 with a 5.13 ERA (73.2IP, 42ER) and 72K.

Has allowed 1ER-or-fewer in five of his seven appearance on the road this season.

THE RIGHT STUFF: Right-handed batters are hitting just .203/.274/.304 (30-for-148) with 3 doubles, 4HR and 14BB against Cortes this season...among left-handed pitchers vs. right-handed batters this season (min. 100 batters faced), he ranks eighth in the Majors (second in the AL) in slugging percentage, fifth in the AL in opponents'

AS A STARTER: Is 2-1 with a 2.70 ERA (36.2IP, 11ER) with 32K and a .222 opponents' BA (30-for-135) in his seven starts this season...has allowed 2ER-or-fewer in six of his seven starts this season...has tossed at least 5.0IP in each of his last five starts... is 2-2 with a 4.58 ERA (39.1IP, 20ER) in nine career starts (seven in 2021, one in 2020 and one in 2019).
