YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Yankees had their season-high 13-game winning streak snapped on Saturday, falling to Oakland, $3-2$...LHP Nestor Cortes (5.1IP, 4H, 3ER, 3BB, 4K, 1HR, 1BK) started and took the loss despite allowing just $3 E R$...CF Aaron Judge (3-for-4, 1R, 1 double, 1HR, 2RBI) recorded 3 H for his second straight game...hit a two-run HR in the ninth inning, accounting for the Yankees' only runs...1B Anthony Rizzo (1-for-4, 1R) and DH Luke Voit ( 1 -for-3) were the only other Yankees to collect a hit...RHP Albert Abreu (1.2IP, 1H, 1 IBB ) and LHP Lucas Luetge (1.01P, 1 K ) combined to toss 2.2 scoreless innings.

MILESTONE MAN: Manager Aaron Boone has 312 managerial wins and needs one win to tie Buck Showalter (313) for ninth place on the Yankees' all-time managerial wins list.
SERIES-LY SPEAKING: The Yankees own a 10 -series winning streak, their longest since a 10 -series winning streak from 6/22-7/22-G2/54... with a win today, would be their longest such streak since 1943 when they won a franchise-record 13 straight series (credit: Elias)...have won 14 of their last 15 completed series.

STANTON ISLAND: DH/OF Giancarlo Stanton had seasonhigh 23-game on-base streak snapped on Saturday (8/2-
27)...was the second-longest on-base streak of his career, 27)... was the second-longest on-base streak of his career,

## TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER: LHP JORDAN MONTGOMERY (5-5, 3.69 ERA)

LHP Jordan Montgomery will make his 24th start of the season in tonight's series finale at Oakland...the 28-year-old will make the start on extended five days' rest due to Wednesday's off-day....last started on $8 / 23$ at Atlanta and earned his fifth win of the season in the Yankees' $5-1$ victory, allowing 1 ER in 5.0 OPP (2H, $4 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}, 1 \mathrm{HR}$ )... has allowed 1R-or-fewer in four of his last five starts (since $7 / 22$ ), going $2-0$ with a 1.78 ERA ( $25.11 \mathrm{IP}, 5 E R$ ) in that span...missed 13 team games on the COVD-19 injured list from $8 / 3-16 \ldots$ in 2020 , went $2-3$ with a 5.11 ERA (44.0IP, 25 ER) and 47 K in 10 starts for the Yankees... underwent "Tommy John surgery on $6 / 7 / 18$ and returned to make two appearances (on start in September 20....inished sixth in the AL Rookie of the Year voting in 2014 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of South Carolina.

LAST START: Earned his fifth win of the season in the Yankees' 5-1 victory on $8 / 23$ at Atlanta, allowing 1 ER in 5.01 P ( $2 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{BB}, 2 \mathrm{~K}, 1 \mathrm{HR}$ )...allowed a solo HR to Dansby Swanson in the second, accounting for his only run allowed...marked his eighth start of $1 R$-or-fewer allowed this season, his most such starts in a single season since he recorded career-high nine starts of $1 R$-or-fewer allowed in 2017...has allowed $R$-or-fewer in four of his last five starts (since $7 / 22$ ), going $2-0$ with a 1.78 ERA ( $25.11 \mathrm{P}, 5 \mathrm{5R}$ ) in that span.

Is $0-1$ with a $3.50 \mathrm{ERA}(18.01 \mathrm{P}, 7 \mathrm{FR})$ in three starts against AL West clubs this season...is $1-2$ with a $4.60 \operatorname{ERA}$ ( $45.0 \mathrm{IP}, 23 \mathrm{ER}$ ) in nine career starts vs. the AL West.
