OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 9-3 in their last 12 home games after losing six straight at the O.co Coliseum...are now 3-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (2-2) and Los Angeles-AL (1-0)...are 3-1 against the Angels this season and 16-11 against the AL West.
- **Drew Pomeranz** tossed 5.1 innings...was his first start throwing more than five innings since July 27, 2012, a span of 20 starts...was the longest such stretch by a Major Leaguer since at least 1914...allowed more than two runs in a game for the first time this season (five starts, nine relief appearances).
- Josh Donaldson (3 for 4, 3 r, 2 hr, 4 rbi, bb) reached base for the 45th straight game as a third baseman, the longest such streak by an A's third baseman since at least 1914...recorded his second multi-homer game of his career (also April 24, 2014 at Houston)...is 10 for 23 (.435) with seven runs, five home runs, 10 RBI and four walks over his last five games.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 2, r, hr, 4 rbi) hit his first career grand slam in the first inning...became just the fourth Oakland Athletics cleanup hitter to hit a grand slam in the first inning (Kingman, McGwire, Stairs)...set a new Oakland record for extra-base hits in May (19)...has set new career highs for home runs in a month (9) and RBI in a month (25)...left the game in the third inning with right calf tightness.
- · Coco Crisp (2 for 4, 2 r, rbi, bb) recorded his second straight multi-hit game and now has a season-high five-game hitting streak.
- Sean Doolittle has not allowed a run over his last 12 outings (13.1 ip, 5 h, 1 bb, 22 so).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are currently 2-3 on their seven-game road trip to Seattle (2-2), Oakland (0-1) and Houston (three games).
- Garrett Richards matched the shortest start of his Major League career (also Aug. 15, 2011 vs. Texas)...was the shortest outling by an Angels starter since Jared Weaver did not record an out in his start on May 28, 2012 vs. the Yankees...gave up the first grand slam of his career and his second home run of the season...came into the game having allowed just one home run in 66.0 innings pitched.
- Grant Green (1 for 4, 2b) has gone 21 for 57 (.368) since being recalled from Triple-A on May 2.
- Mike Trout (2 for 5, r, hr, rbi, 3 so) extended his season-long hitting streak to 11 games...has driven in 16 runs over his last 18 games.
