OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics had their five-game winning streak snapped...took their fifth extra innings loss of the season...finish the 10-game homestand with a record of 7-3 against New York-AL (2-1), Texas (2-1) and Boston (3-1).
- Tommy Milone is 0-1 with an 11.00 ERA (11 er in 9.0 ip) in two starts against Boston this season.
- Kyle Blanks (1 for 1) came out of the game in the top of the third inning with a left calf strain.
- Sean Doolittle (0 for 1) had his first major league at bat in the 10th inning...was the first A's pitcher to pinch-hit since Bob Welch, May 13, 1994 vs. Kansas City.
- John Jaso (1 for 1, r, hr, rbi) hit his third career pinch-hit home run with two outs in the bottom of the ninth inning to tie the game...it was his second pinch-hit home run this season (last: April 14 at Los Angeles-AL).
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi) is 13 for 33 (.394) with nine RBI over his last 11 games after going 5 for 19 (.263) over his first six contests.

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox scored at least five runs for the first time in their last eight games...extended their streak of games decided by two runs or fewer to nine consecutive games...are now 1-3 on their season-long tying 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (1-3), Seattle (three games), and New York-AL (three games).
- Jon Lester is now 2-0 with a 1.15 ERA (2 er in 15.2 ip) in two starts against the A's this season with five hits allowed, four walks, and 19 strikeouts.
- Burke Badenhop had his career-high 18.0 inning scoreless streak snapped in the eighth inning.
- David Ortiz (1 for 5, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his second extra-innings home run in his last eight games (last: 10th inning, June 18 vs. Minnesota)...it was his 10th career extra-innings home run.
- David Ross (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his third home run of the season in the second inning...two of his three home runs this season have been off of Tommy Milone (previous: May 3 at Boston)...stole home on a double-steal in the third inning...is the first Red Sox player to steal home and hit a home run in the same game since Rico Petrocelli accomplished the feat on September 9, 1967 vs. New York.
