OAKLAND ATHLETICS (23-33) VS. BOSTON RED SOX (24-31)

FRIDAY, JUNE 5, 2015 – FENWAY PARK – 7:10 P.M. EDT LHP SCOTT KAZMIR (2-3, 2.93) VS. LHP WADE MILEY (4-5, 4.97) CSNCA – A'S RADIO NETWORK (95.7 FM THE GAME)

ABOUT THE A'S: The A's have won a season-high four straight, six of seven and nine of the last 12 games after losing 14 of the previous 16 contests...have not won more than four straight since July 3-8, 2014 when they had a six-game winning streak...swept the Tigers in a three-game series Tuesday through Thursday for their first sweep this season and have now won consecutive series for the first time...prior to that, had five losses and a split over the previous six series...are 15-25 (.375) over the last 39 games (beginning April 23) after starting the year 8-8...are 23-33 (.400) overall, which is the worst record in the American League and fourth worst in the majors...are in fifth place in the AL West for the 28th consecutive day (beginning May 8) and trail first place Houston by 11½ games...have spent six days in sole possession of first, three days tied for first, five days in second, three days tied for second, two days in third, five days tied for third, seven days in fourth, one day tied for fourth and 28 days in fifth.

STARTING PITCHING: A's starting pitchers are 8-2 with a 1.36 ERA (12 er in 79.2 ip) over the last 12 games and 9-8 with a 2.23 ERA (34 er in 137.1 ip) over the last 22 contests (beginning May 12)...have a 3.10 ERA (116 er in 337.0 ip) for the season, which is the lowest in the American League and second lowest in the majors (St. Louis, 2.87)...have allowed 22 home runs, which is the fewest in the majors...have tossed 337.0 innings, which is the most in the AL and second most in the majors (New York-NL, 339.0).

PITCHING: The A's have a 2.00 ERA (24 er in 108.0 ip) over their last 12 games and a 2.69 ERA (58 er in 194.0 ip) over the last 22 contests (beginning May 12)...have three shutouts in the last 12 games and eight for the season, which is the most in the American League and second most in the majors (San Francisco, 9)...rank sixth in the AL in strikeouts (421) but have issued the sixth most walks (165)...are tied for the fewest home runs allowed (43) and are tied for third in pickoffs (5).

DEFENSIVE DOINGS: The A's have committed 54 errors, which is five more than any other team (Texas, 49)...the errors have led to 31 unearned runs, which is three more than any other team (Washington, 28).

OFFENSE: The A's have gone 21-for-69 (.304) with runners in scoring position over their last seven games after going 18-for-140 (.129) over the previous 14 contests...are hitting .202 (53-for-263) with RISP over the last 28 games after hitting .310 with RISP over the first 28 contests...have been shut out five times, which is second most in the AL (Tampa Bay, 6)... are tied for the AL lead in triples (16), are second in stolen base percentage (32-for-38, 84.2%) and fourth in batting (.256).

HOME AND AWAY: The A's have won the past five road games, which is their longest road winning streak since May 4-21, 2014 when they won six in a row...are 3-0 on this six-game road trip to Detroit (3-0) and Boston (three games)...have finished with a .500 record or worse on each of their last 10 road trips dating back to last year, which is the A's longest such streak since a 12-trip streak from Aug. 6, 1996-Aug. 31, 1997...last had a winning road trip June 3-11, 2014 (5-4)...went 3-4 on the last road trip to Houston (1-2) and Tampa Bay (2-2) and are 14-16 (.467) on the road for the season...went 4-3 on their last homestand, a seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-2) and New York-AL (3-1)...it was the A's first winning homestand after finishing with a losing record in each of the first three homestands, which marked the first time the A's had three straight losing homestands in one season since 2005...it also snapped a streak of five consecutive losing homestands dating back to last year, which matched the longest such streak in Oakland history (last four of 1978, first of 1979)...won three of four games against New York-AL last weekend, which was the A's first home series win this year...the series win snapped a streak of eight consecutive home series without a win dating back to last year, which matched the longest such streak in Oakland history (May 13-June 29, 1977 and June 1-July 15, 1979)...it was their first home series win since they took two of three from Philadelphia Sept. 19-21, 2014... have now lost 15 of their last 21 home games and are 9-17 (.346) at home for the season, which is the second worst home record in the majors (Milwaukee, 9-20).

NIGHT AND DAY: The A's have won five of their last six day games after losing 13 of the first 14...are now 6-14 (.300) during the day compared to 17-19 (.472) at night...are tied for the second worst record in the majors in day games (Cincinnati, 5-14) and are tied for the second most losses (Chicago-AL, 15)...are batting .243 (164-for-674) with 75 runs scored during the day (3.75 per game) compared to .263 (335-for-1274) with 165 runs at night (4.58 per game).

ONE-RUN GAMES AND OTHER CLOSE CALLS: The A's are 3-15 (.167) in one-run games and 6-22 (.214) in games decided by two runs or fewer, both of which are the worst record in the majors...are 0-6 in extra inning games and are one of two teams without an extra inning win (Pittsburgh)... are tied with Pittsburgh for the Major League lead in extra-inning losses and have the second most extra inning games in the American League (Seattle, 9)...have a six-game extra inning losing streak, which matches the longest such streak by an A's team over the last 20 years (May 18-July 5, 2011 and May 21-July 25, 1999)...are 0-9 in games decided in the last at bat and are the only team without a last at bat win...also lost their final last at bat game of 2014 and the 10-game losing streak in games decided in the last at bat matches the longest such streak in Oakland history (May 14-July 17, 1989)...snapped a 12-game losing streak in one-run games at home on May 28, which was the longest such streak in Athletics history (dating back to 1901)...are now 1-10 in one-run games at home, 2-5 on the road.

LEFT AND RIGHT: The A's have won each of the last two games when the opponent has started a left-handed pitcher...are 3-10 when the opponent starts a left-hander compared to 20-23 when they start a right-hander... are batting .223 (109-for-489) against lefties compared to .267 (390-for-1459) with 41 of their 48 home runs off righties...the mark against lefties is second lowest in the American League and the mark against righties is third highest.

THE DISABLED LIST: The A's have eight players on the disabled list (Crisp, Davis, Doolittle, Griffin, Ladendorf, Mujica, Parker, Thompson)... Griffin, Ladendorf, Parker and Thompson are on the 60-day DL...Griffin is on a rehab assignment...have had at least seven players on the DL all year...have used the DL a total of 16 times.

IN MAY: The A's went 11-19 (.367) in May, which was the third worst record in the majors (Boston and Miami, 10-19)...the 19 losses were the A's most in a month since August, 2008 (10-20) and their most in May since 2005 (7-20)...it was the sixth worst May in Oakland history...finished the month 12 games behind first place Houston, which was the A's third largest deficit at the end of May since divisional play began in 1969 (14 in 2001, 13 in 1979)...now have four consecutive months with a losing record after recording 14 straight months with a winning record...had just one off day in May and played 30 games in the month...that matches the most in Oakland history in the month of May (1981, 1997)...the A's pitching staff had 230 strikeouts in May, which was the second most in one month in Oakland history (Aug. 2007)...the record is 246 in Sept. 2013.

A's vs. RED SOX: The A's trail the season series, 2-1...won the season series last year, 4-3...went 3-1 in Oakland and 1-2 in Boston...have won two of the previous three season series against the Red Sox and are 16-9 against Boston over the last four years...are 12-4 in Oakland and 4-5 in Boston over that span...since the start of the 2007 season, the A's are 36-34 against the Red Sox...that breaks down to 25-11 in Oakland, 10-22 in Boston and 1-1 in Tokyo...are 235-283 since moving to Oakland in 1968... that includes 141-118 in Oakland, 93-164 in Boston and 1-1 in Tokyo...all-time, the A's are 877-1064 against the Red Sox.

TODAY'S TIDBITS

Billy Burns has hit safely in each of his past nine games, which is an ongoing career-high (15 for 39, .385)...ranks first among American League rookies in multiple hit games (13), is tied for first in hits (40), is second in stolen bases (10) and fifth in runs (19)...Brett Lawrie has hit safely in six of his past seven games and is batting .385 (10-for-26) with five runs, three doubles, two home runs and six RBI over that span...Josh Phegley is 10-for-28 (.357) with three walks over his last eight games after going 3-for-23 (.130) over his previous eight contests...Stephen Vogt is 13-for-41 (.317) with eight walks over his last 12 games after going 7-for-40 (.175) over his previous 15 contests.

THIS DATE IN A'S HISTORY

In 1983 Rickey Henderson homers off Cleveland's Bud Anderson in the second game of a double header for the 2000th home run in Oakland A's history...in 2004 Tim Hudson tosses a complete game eight-hit shutout in the A's 4-0 win against Toronto, snapping the A's major league record tying streak of seven consecutive no decisions by a starter.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Scott Kazmir (2-3, 2.93 ERA)

MONTH BY MONTH: Went 0-3 with a 4.65 ERA and .269 opponents batting average in six starts in May after going 2-0 with a 0.99 ERA and .158 opponents average in four starts in April...posted the fourth lowest April ERA in the American League...is now 2-5 with a 3.67 ERA in 11 starts in May in his two seasons with the A's compared to 6-0 with a 1.64 ERA in 10 starts in April...went 3-1 with a 3.12 ERA last June.

WITH RUNNERS ON BASE: Has allowed a .258 (32-for-124) batting average with the bases empty compared to .167 (15-for-90) with runners on base...the mark with runners on base is second lowest among American League pitchers with enough innings to qualify for the ERA title...Sonny Gray ranks first at .163...opponents are 8-for-45 (.178) with runners in scoring position, including 1-for-19 (.053) with RISP and two outs...last year, he held the opposition to a .081 batting average with runners in scoring position and two outs, which was the lowest mark by a Major Leaguer with 162 or more innings pitched since Bobby Bolin had a .079 average with San Francisco in 1965...opponents are now 6-for-81 (.074) off him with RISP and two outs over the last two years...four of the six home runs he has allowed this year have come with the bases empty.

OPPONENTS BATTING: Has issued 23 of his 25 walks to right-handed hitters...the 25 walks are sixth most in the American League...has allowed a .314 (27-for-86) batting average and all six of his home runs with no outs...opponents are hitting .209 (14-for-67) with one out and .098 (6-for-61) with two outs...has yielded a .139 (16-for-115) batting average with two strikes...has held the opponents number three hitter to a .154 (4-for-26) batting average...has yielded a .357 (20-for-56) average and four of his six home runs to batters leading off an inning...has a .661 opponents slugging percentage against batters leading off an inning...the slugging percentage leading off an inning is second highest in the AL among qualifiers for the ERA title and the batting average is third highest.

HOME AND AWAY: Is 1-1 with a 1.65 ERA (5 er in 27.1 ip) and .173 (17-for-98) opponents batting average in five starts in Oakland compared to 1-2 with a 4.06 ERA (14 er in 31.0 ip) and .259 (30-for-116) opponents average in five starts on the road...has allowed all six of his home runs on the road...tossed 7.0 shutout innings in each of his first two starts at home to become the second A's pitcher since 1914 on an Opening Day roster to start the season by tossing seven or more innings and not allowing a run in his first two home starts (Tommy Milone, 2012).

THIS AND THAT: The A's are 3-7 (.300) in his starting assignments...has received just eight runs of support over his last eight starts (45.1 ip, 1.59 RSA) after getting 18 runs of support in his first two starts...started the season by tossing six or more innings and allowing two runs or fewer in each of his first four starts...that matched the longest season-opening streak by an A's pitcher on the Opening Day roster since at least 1914 (fifth time, last: Jesse Chavez, 2014)...struck out 10 batters in his first start and eight in his second start to become the only A's pitcher on an Opening Day roster since at least 1914 to strike out eight or more batters in each of his first two starts of the season.

2015 START-BY-START: He combined with Otero and Alvarez on a threehit shutout in the A's 10-0 win over Texas April 8...tossed seven innings and allowed just one hit while striking out 10...it was his 23rd career 10-strikeout game, his second with the A's...became just the fifth pitcher in Oakland history to strikeout 10 while allowing one hit or fewer, the first since Barry Zito on Aug. 4, 2001 vs. Detroit (10 so, 1 h)...was the winning pitcher in the A's 8-1 win at Houston April 13...retired each of the first nine batters to extend his season-opening scoreless streak to 10.0 innings... had a no decision in the A's 4-2 loss at Kansas City April 19...had a 2-1 lead entering the bottom of the eighth and walked Orlando to start the inning...retired the next batter and was relieved by O'Flaherty who allowed Orlando to score plus two runs of his own for the blown save and loss. had his second consecutive no decision in the A's 5-4, 11 inning loss to Houston April 24 in Oakland...tossed 7.0 shutout innings and allowed just five hits while walking three...did not allow a runner past second base... Keuchel shutout the A's on two hits in nine innings of work and the game was scoreless going into extra innings...both teams scored twice in the 10th inning before the Astros outscored the A's 3-2 in the 11th...had his third straight no decision in the A's 7-5 win at Texas *May 1*...allowed leadoff home runs to Blanks in the second inning and Fielder in the fourth inning... Smolinski added a sacrifice fly in the fourth and Kazmir left after six innings trailing 3-0...the Rangers built a 5-0 lead before the A's scored seven times in the eighth for the win...was the losing pitcher in the A's 13-0 loss at Minnesota May 6...allowed four runs in the third inning on a leadoff home run by Rosario, RBI singles by Hunter and Plouffe and a sacrifice fly by Escobar...yielded two more runs in the sixth inning on a two-run home run by Escobar...Gibson. Pressly and Graham combined to shutout the A's on six hits...had a no decision in the A's 5-4, 11-inning loss to Boston May 11.... the A's scored a run in the third, but he allowed a run in the fourth on a Ortiz RBI single...the A's scored a run in the bottom of the fourth, but he allowed a RBI single to Betts in the fifth...left after six innings with a 3-2 lead, but Scribner allowed two runs in the seventh for the blown save...was the losing pitcher in the A's 7-3 loss to Chicago (AL) *May* 17 in Oakland...tossed 4.1 innings...allowed an unearned run in the first inning and then blanked the White Sox on two hits and a walk over the next three innings...had a 2-1 lead when he allowed four runs, three earned, in the fifth inning... Abreu opened the scoring with a RBI single, Beckham walked with the bases loaded and Ramirez drove in two with a single...extended his losing streak to three games in the A's 5-2 loss at Tampa Bay *May* 22...it was the 250th appearance of his career...the A's scored a run in the fourth and he blanked the Rays on five hits and three walks over the first four innings... then allowed a three-run home run to Longoria in the fifth inning.

LAST START: He had a no decision in the A's 3-2 loss to Detroit last Wednesday in Oakland...it was the 250th start of his career...did not allow a run or hit but tossed a season-low 3.0 innings...walked three batters... left the game with tightness in his left shoulder.

KAZMIR vs. BOSTON: Is 9-8 with a 3.94 ERA (157.2 ip, 144 h, 75 r, 69 er, 84 bb, 160 so, 17 hr) in 28 career starts...the starts and losses are his most against any team...is 6-5 with a 3.89 ERA (38 er in 88.0 ip) in 16 starts at Fenway Park and 3-3 with a 4.00 ERA (31 er in 69.2 ip) in 12 starts in his home ballparks...had a no decision in his only start this year, a 5-4 A's loss in 11 innings on May 11....the A's scored a run in the third, but he allowed a run in the fourth on an Ortiz RBI single...the A's scored a run in the bottom of the fourth, but he allowed a RBI single to Betts in the fifth...left after six innings with a 3-2 lead, but Scribner allowed two runs in the seventh for the blown save.

- The A's bullpen has posted a 3.80 ERA (31 er in 73.1 ip) over its last 26 games...is 2-5 with six saves and three blown saves over that span... compiled a 7.98 ERA in its previous 15 contests.
- Has a 4.64 ERA for the season, which is the highest in the American League and third highest in the majors...has 13 losses, which is third most in the majors.
- Has the second fewest saves (10) in the AL, second lowest save percentage (55.6%) and is tied for the second most most blown saves (8).
- Has allowed 33-of-92 (35.9%) inherited runners to score, which is the second highest percentage in the AL
- First batters faced are hitting .259 (38-for-147), which is fifth highest in the AL...have the most first batter RBI in the majors (28) and are tied for third in home runs (7).
- The A's are 3-24 when the bullpen allows two runs or more, 19-9 when it allows one run or fewer (one complete game).
