



# BALTIMORE ORIOLES GAME NOTES

Baltimore Orioles (54-52) at Oakland Athletics (48-60)

LHP Wei-Yin Chen (5-6, 3.24) vs. RHP Kendall Graveman (6-7, 3.84)



**A-PLUS EFFORT:** Today's starter **LHP Wei-Yin Chen** is making his sixth career start against the A's...Chen is 4-0 with a 1.69 ERA (6 ER/32.0 IP) and three Quality Starts over his previous five outings...Chen has surrendered two or fewer runs in five of his last six road starts (since May 3), going 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (12 ER/38.0 IP) and owns a Quality Start in all but one of those six outings...His 1.87 walks per 9.0 IP ranks 12<sup>th</sup> among Qualified American League starters.

**DAY TRIPPER:** The Orioles rank fourth in the American League with a .568 (21-16) winning percentage in day games this season...As a team, Baltimore ranks fifth in the American League with a .261 batting average under the sun...OF Adam Jones ranks seventh in the majors and fifth in the American League with a .363 (45-for-124) batting average in day games.

**VS. OAKLAND:** The Orioles and Athletics play the third game of seven matchups between the two clubs this season...The season series is tied, 1-1...The A's will visit Camden Yards for a four-game series, August 14-17...The A's won the season series, 4-2, in 2014...Baltimore trails Oakland in the all-time series, 253-256, with the Orioles trailing 122-128 at home and leading 131-128 at Oakland.

**CATCH THIS:** **CA Caleb Joseph** tied his career high on Monday at Oakland by notching three RBI...It marked the third time this season and the fifth time in his career that Joseph has collected three RBI...Joseph went 2-for-4 with a home run on the night...The Orioles improved to 35-5 when Joseph logs at least one RBI in his career and 17-2 when he records at least two RBI.

**WHAT A LONG, STRANGE TRIP IT'S BEEN:** On Sunday, the Orioles completed a seven-game homestand with series against Atlanta (3-0) and Detroit (2-2)...Prior to the homestand, the O's finished a 10-day, nine-game road trip which included series wins at Detroit (2-1) and Tampa Bay (2-1)...In between series wins, the O's were swept in a three-game series at Yankee Stadium...On Monday, the Birds began another 10-day, nine-game road trip with stops at Oakland (1-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (three games).

**TRADE WINDS:** On July 31, Major League Baseball's non-waiver trade deadline, the Orioles acquired **OF Gerardo Parra** from the Milwaukee Brewers in exchange for minor league **RHP Zach Davies** and designated **RHP Bud Norris** for assignment...**RHP Mychal Givens** was recalled from Double-A Bowie...**OF Junior Lake** was acquired from the Chicago Cubs in exchange for **RHP Tommy Hunter**...**RHP Mike Wright** was recalled from Triple-A Norfolk...Parra reported to the club and **INF Chris Parmelee** was designated for assignment.

**MAKE NO MISTAKE:** The Orioles have committed the fewest number of errors in the majors (41)...The Los Angeles Dodgers are the next-closest team with 45 and the nearest AL teams is the Detroit Tigers at 52...The Orioles lead the majors with a .989 team fielding percentage.

**HAPPY TO ASSIST:** The Orioles lead the Major Leagues with 31 outfield assists...**Adam Jones** has nine outfield assists, **Travis Snider** has five...According to FanGraphs, Orioles outfielders rank tied for third in the American League with 15 defensive runs saved (DRS).

**OH, WHAT A RELIEF IT IS:** Since April 29, the Orioles bullpen leads the majors with a 2.41 ERA (69 ER/258.0 IP)...In that same time, Baltimore relievers have held opponents to a .224 clip, fifth in the majors...This season, Orioles relievers rank fourth in the majors and third in the AL with a 2.83 ERA (102 ER/324.1 IP)...Their .228 opponents' batting average ranks sixth in the majors...**RHP Darren O'Day** ranks sixth in the majors among relief pitchers with a 1.35 ERA (6 ER/40.0 IP).

**RISP-Y BUSINESS:** The Orioles .280 team batting average with runners in scoring position ranks third in the American League this season...Baltimore trails Toronto (.289) and Kansas City (.281)...**INF/OF Jimmy Paredes** leads the team ranks 10<sup>th</sup> in the American League with a .350 (21-for-60) average with RISP.

**SAVING THE DAY:** **LHP Zach Britton** collected his 27<sup>th</sup> save of the season on Friday vs. Detroit...He ranks tied for seventh among Major League relievers and tied for second in the American League...Britton owns a 1.71 ERA (8 ER/42.0 IP) with 48 strikeouts and has held opposing hitters to a .204 average this season.

**IN GOOD COMPANY:** With a home run on Friday, **OF Adam Jones** hit his 183<sup>rd</sup> home run as an Oriole...With that homer, Jones passed **OF Ken Singleton** for sole possession of seventh place on the Orioles all-time home run list...**OF Brady Anderson** ranks sixth with 209 home runs...**SS J.J. Hardy** is seven home runs shy of 100 long balls with Baltimore...A total of 23 players have notched at least 100 homers for the Orioles.

**PACK 'EM IN:** Saturday night's attendance of 45,968 marked the seventh sellout of the season at Camden Yards...In 2014, the Orioles had eight home sellouts and drew a total of 2,458,970 at Oriole Park, the largest attendance figure since 2005 (2,624,740).

**THIS DATE IN ORIOLES HISTORY:** On this date in 1994, **RHP Ben McDonald** tossed his second career one-hitter by defeating the Brewers 4-0 at Milwaukee County Stadium...The lone hit allowed came in the fourth inning, the same as with his first one-hitter on July 20, 1993...The only hit McDonald allowed in the contest was a single by CA Dave Nilsson.

**A GRAND ENTRANCE:** With his start in left field on Saturday against the Detroit Tigers, **OF Gerardo Parra** became the 1000<sup>th</sup> player to appear in a game for the Orioles since the team moved to Baltimore in 1954...**RHP Jason Garcia**, **2B Rey Navarro**, **RHP Mike Wright**, **RHP Tyler Wilson**, **RHP Oliver Drake** and **RHP Mychal Givens** made their Major League debuts this season...**RHP Chaz Roe**, **CA Ryan Lavarney**, **LHP Cesar Cabral** and **INF/OF Chris Parmelee** also made their Orioles debuts this season.

**DISABLED LIST:** Two Orioles are currently on the 15-day disabled list...**INF/OF Steve Pearce** (retroactive to July 19 with a left oblique strain) and **RHP Mike Wright** (August 1 with a left calf strain) are currently on the 15-day DL...**RHP Jason Garcia** is currently on the 60-day DL (retroactive to May 11 with right shoulder tendinitis).

**THE SKIPPER:** **Buck Showalter** (1313) has tied **Ned Hanlon-HOF** (1313) for 31<sup>st</sup> on the all-time managerial wins list...He trails **Chuck Tanner** (1352) for 30<sup>th</sup> all-time...His 431 wins as O's manager are third-most in club history, trailing **Earl Weaver** (1480) and **Paul Richards** (517) on the club's all-time list...Showalter recently won his third Manager of the Year award (1994, 2004, 2014) and is in his sixth season as O's manager.

**TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: #16 WEI-YIN CHEN**

**How Acquired:** January 10, 2012; signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent to a three-year contract with a club option for 2015



**QUICK HITS:** His 1.87 walks per 9.0IP ranks 12<sup>th</sup> among qualifying American League starters...**Posted a career-high tying six-game Quality Start streak, June 15-July 21**...Name pronounced Way-In...First Taiwanese-born player in Orioles history...Is the second Taiwanese-born pitcher to log 100 career starts in the majors (also, **Chien-Ming Wang**; 126)...Had surgery following the 2013 season to remove bony ossicles from his right knee...Missed 2006-07 seasons in Japan after having “Tommy John” surgery...Married to **Yi-Wen Tsai** (E-ween sigh)...They have a son, **Karsten** (11/12/12).

**CHEN VS. OAKLAND:** Is making his sixth career start against the A's...**Chen is 4-0 with a 1.69 ERA (32.0IP, 6ER) and three Quality Starts over his previous five outings...**Has held the A's to a .183 batting average in those five starts...In two career starts at O.co Coliseum, is 2-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0IP, 3ER).

**LAST START:** Started July 31 vs. Detroit at Oriole Park (ND, 3.1IP, 10H, 6ER, 6K)...Surrendered a season-high six runs and a career-high tying three home runs (fifth inning)...His 3.1 innings pitched matched the shortest start of his career in terms of innings pitched (also, June 28, 2014 vs. Tampa Bay)...**The Orioles erased a six-run deficit and rallied to beat the Tigers, 8-7 (largest come-from-behind victory of the season).**

**ON THE ROAD:** Has surrendered two or fewer runs in five of his last six road starts (since May 3), going 2-1 with a 2.84 ERA (38.0IP, 12ER) and posting a Quality Start in all but one of those six outings...Overall, is 2-2 with a 2.89 ERA (46.2IP, 15ER) and five Quality Starts in eight road outings this season...His 2.89 road ERA ranks 10<sup>th</sup> among AL starters (min. 8 GS)...Is 19-16 with a 3.71 ERA (303.1IP, 125ER) and 27 Quality Starts in 52 career starts away from home...The Birds are 28-24 in those 52 games.

**QUALITY STRETCH:** Chen's streak of six consecutive Quality Starts from June 15-July 21 was **the longest by an Orioles pitcher this season** and matched his career-high (also, July 10-August 10, 2013; 3-2, 3.07 ERA)...During those six outings, he went 2-2 with a 2.28 ERA (43.1IP, 11ER) and held opponents to a .231 batting average in that span.

**THE AL EAST IS A BEAST:** Chen is 26-13 with a 3.53 ERA (367.0IP, 144ER) in 59 starts all-time against teams *outside* of the AL East...Against AL East clubs, he is 14-17 with a 4.02 ERA (273.1IP, 122ER) in 47 starts...Chen is 3-3 with a 3.03 ERA (59.1IP, 20ER) in 10 starts against the East this season and 2-3 with a 3.43 ERA (65.2IP, 25ER) *outside* of the division this season.

**MR. EFFICIENT:** Chen averages 15.2 pitches per inning over 20 starts this season (the fewest among Orioles starting pitchers with at least five starts)...In 2014, Chen's 16.0 pitches per inning led the club's starters and ranked 21<sup>st</sup> in the AL.

**UNDER CONTROL:** Since April 25, Chen ranks 13<sup>th</sup> among qualifying AL starting pitchers with a .290 opponent's on-base percentage...He did not hit a batter in 15 consecutive starts (April 25-July 21), the second-longest stretch of his career behind a 17-game stretch, September 1, 2013 to June 1, 2014...In his 17 starts (since April 25), Chen has allowed 18 walks in 110.1 innings of work and ranks fourth among AL starters in walks per 9.0IP ratio (1.47) in that span.

**START ME UP:** Since the 2014 All-Star break, Chen is 12-9 and owns a 3.05 ERA (206.2IP, 70ER)...He has held opponents to a .249 batting average over that span...His 3.05 ERA in that time ranks ninth among qualifying AL starters.

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONGBALL:** Has surrendered 22 home runs this season (19 to right-handed batters; **18 of the 22 have been solo shots**)...Of those 22 homers he has allowed, 13 have come within the first three innings of his starts, **while the other nine have come in the fourth inning of his starts.**

**UNLUCKY SEVENS:** With his win on June 15 (8.0IP), Chen snapped a three-game losing streak when tossing at least 7.0 innings...Entered this season with a 17-1 record when surpassing the 7.0 innings pitched threshold in his career (see GET HIM 16 OUTS below)...Prior to this season, the only loss Chen suffered when pitching at least 7.0 innings was August 4, 2013 vs. Seattle.

**GET HIM 16 OUTS:** When Chen pitches 5.0 or fewer innings, the Birds are 12-14, but when he pitches 5.1 or more innings, they are 50-30, including a 24-8 mark when he works 7.0 or more innings (Chen is 20-5 in those 32 outings, with four of those losses coming this season).

**MAKING TAIWAN PROUD:** Has 40 career wins, the second-most by a Taiwanese-born pitcher in major league history behind Chien-Ming Wang (62)...Chen passed Hong-Chih Kuo (13 wins) for second place with his April 26, 2013 win at Oakland...Is one of eight pitchers in MLB history to be born in Taiwan (also **Chia-Jen Lo**, **Chin-hui Tsao**, **Fu-Te Ni**, **C.C. Lee**, **Wei-Chung Wang** and those above).
