OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland A's had their three-game winning streak snapped...are 0-1 on this six-game homestand against Los Angeles-AL (0-1) and Kansas City (three games).
- A's pinch hitters are 0-for-10 with three strikeouts to start the season.
- Sonny Gray tossed 6.1 innings to go over 500 innings pitched in his career (now has 504.1 ip)...is 5-3 with a 3.27 ERA (28 er in 77.0 ip) in 12 career appearances, including 11 starts, against the Angels.
- Ryan Dull had his streak of 13 consecutive batters retired snapped when he hit Daniel Nava with a pitch in the seventh inning...however, has not allowed a hit or walk in five games and 4.2 innings pitched.
- Coco Crisp (2-for-5, 3b, so) hit a triple in the fifth inning, his first since Aug. 9, 2014 vs New York-NL...recorded his second multi-hit game of the season.
- Jed Lowrie (2-for-4, r) recorded his team-leading third multi-hit game of the season.
- Josh Reddick (2-for-3, 2b, bb) is batting 7-for-25 (.280) to begin the season...recorded his second multi-hit game of the season.
- Danny Valencia (1-for-4) has hit safely in each of his last four games (5-for-15, .333) after going 1-for-10 (.100) over his first three contests.

- Nick Tropeano made his season debut...is 3-0 with a 0.51 ERA (1 er in 17.2 ip) in three career starts against Oakland...is 5-2 with a 2.62 ERA (13 er in 44.2 ip) in eight career starts against AL West competition.
- Yunel Escobar (1-for-5, r, 2b) has hit safely in each of his last three games...is batting 7-for-27 (.259) to start the season.
- Daniel Nava (1-for-3, r, rbi, so, hbp) is 3-for-9 (.333) to start the season.
- Carlos Perez (2-for-4, 2b) is a .367 (11-for-30) career hitter against Oakland.
- Mike Trout (1-for-3, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb, 2 so) is a .280 (82-for-293) career hitter against Oakland.
