OAKLAND NOTES

- Matt Chapman matched a career-high with three RBI on the contest...Last season, he accomplished the feat three times, last 7/13/18 vs BAL.
- Daniel Gossett tossed four innings, allowing six hits and four earned runs...he has failed to complete five innings of work in four straight starts.
- Yusmeiro Petit inherited two runners in the top of the fifth and allowed both runners to score...It was the first time he has allowed an inherited runner to score since May 8, 2016, snapping a streak of 32 consecutive stranded runners.
- Jonathan Lucroy failed to reach base, snapping an eightgame hitting streak against the Angels...he entered the contest with a .304 (24-for-79) batting clip.
- Marcus Semien reached safely in all four games this series.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- Shohei Ohtani became the first player to start as a pitcher and a non-pitcher in the first ten games of the season since 1920...
- Ohtani tossed six innings, allowing three runs on three hits...all three of his runs came in the second inning.
- After allowing a three-run homer in the second inning, Ohtani retired 14 of his last 15 batters he faced, allowing a walk to Matt Joyce in the fourth inning.
- Mike Trout had four extra base-hits this series...In his career against OAK, 56 of his 132 hits have gone for extra bases (25 doubles, 5 triples, 26 homers).
- Andrelton Simmons hit safely in all four games this series and raised his career mark against OAK to .301 (47-for-156).
- Zack Cozart recorded three multi-hit games in the series, hitting safely in all but one game...he finished the series .368 (7-for-19).
