OAKLAND NOTES

- Sean Manaea turned in his shortest outing since 8/12/17 vs. Baltimore, lasting only 2.2 innings while allowing three runs on six hits...the three walks surrendered by Manaea were the most in eleven starts, since 6/5/18 at Texas.
- With a double in the sixth inning, **Matt Chapman** extended his career-long on-base streak to 22 games, now the longest active streak in the American League... during the streak, Chapman is 28-for-84 (.333).
- Emilio Pagán logged his ffth straight scoreless outing.
- The A's season-long eight-game home winning streak, as well as their season-long tying six game winning streak, were both snapped.
- Mark Canha is now 0 for his last 11.
- Jed Lowrie is now 0 for his last 12.
- Shawn Kelley made his Athletics debut after being acquired from Washington on August 5, getting out of a bases-loaded jam in the sixth inning.
- Khris Davis homered in his third straight game, the third time this season he has had a stretch of three consecutive games in which he has hit a home run.
- In seven appearances with the A's, **Jeurys Familia** has not allowed an earned run.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- Rich Hill made his first appearance at the Oakland Coliseum since playing for the Athletics in 2016 and starting seven games at the Colisuem.
- The three hits Hill allowed tie his fewest of the season in a start where he threw at least three pitches (was removed due to injury after two pitches on 5/19/18 at Washington)...the four walks tie a season high.
- Khris Davis' sixth-inning home run ended Hill's streak of four starts in which Hill did not allow a homer, his longest such streak since 2016.
- With a single in the seventh inning, **Matt Kemp** snapped an 0 for 10 stretch.
- Los Angeles won at the Coliseum for the first time since 7/14/01...the A's had held an eight-game winning streak over the Dodgers at the Coliseum.
- Yasmani Grandal is now 0 for his last 10.
- **Kenley Jansen** collected his 32nd save, tied with Colorado's Wade Davis for the most in the National League.
