LAST START - 8/1 at LAA: tossed 5.2 innings of 2-run ball, giving up 3 hits and no walks with 4 strikeouts...did not factor into the decision in Houston's 5-4, 10th-inning defeat.

- was perfect through the first 5.0 innings of the game, before giving up 3 hits and 2 runs in the 6th inning.

GREINKE DAY: the 6-time All-Star and 36-year-old right-hander is set to make the 450th start of his Major League career...ranks 2nd among active MLB pitchers in starts behind **Justin Verlander** (454).

- is coming off a 2019 season that saw him win his 2nd **Silver Slugger** award, and 6th **Rawlings Gold Glove Award**.
- is set for his first full-season with the Astros...was acquired by the Astros along with cash considerations on July 31, minutes before the trade deadline...in exchange for Greinke, the Astros sent 4 prospects to Arizona: **IF Seth Beer**, **RHP J.B. Bukauskas**, **RHP Corbin Martin** and **IF Joshua Rojas**.

vs. OAK: went 2-0 in his 2 starts against the A's in 2019 after joining the Astros...gave up 1 run in 13.0 innings pitched for a 0.69 ERA.

- last pitched at Oakland Coliseum on Aug. 18, 2019, when he recorded his 200th career victory (1ER/7IP)...became the 115th pitcher in MLB history to reach 200 career wins.

WITH THE 'STROS: has made 12 regular season starts for Houston since joining the club in July of 2019, going 8-1 with a 3.27 (26ER/71.2IP) and 58 strikeouts...the Astros have gone 8-4 in his 12 starts.

- made 5 postseason starts for the Astros during their 2019 pennant run, going 0-2 with a 4.68 ERA (13ER/25IP) and 25 strikeouts.
- started Game 3 of the ALDS at TB (6ER/3.2IP), Game 1 of the ALCS vs. NYY (3ER/6IP), Game 4 of the ALCS at NYY (1ER/4.1IP), Game 3 of the World Series at WSH (1ER/4.2IP) and Game 7 of the World Series vs. WSH (2ER/6.1IP).

MR. 200: recorded the 200th victory of his career on Aug. 18, 2019 at OAK, his 3rd start as a member of the Astros.

- ranks 2nd among active MLB pitchers in career wins, behind only his teammate **Justin Verlander** (226 wins).

TOP-25 WITHIN SIGHT: ranks 26th all-time in MLB history in strikeouts (2,628)...trails **David Cone** for 25th all-time (2,668).

COOPERSTOWN BOUND?: is 1 of 3 pitchers in MLB history with at least 6 All-Star appearances and 6 Rawlings Gold Glove Awards, along with **Greg Maddux** and **Bob Gibson**.

- is 1 of 3 pitchers in MLB history who have won a Cy Young, Gold Glove and Silver Slugger...also **Fernando Valenzuela** and **Orel Hershiser**.
- is 1 of 12 pitchers in MLB history to record at least 1,000 strikeouts in both the American League and National League...also **Nolan Ran**, **Randy Johnson**, **Gaylord Perry**, **Fergie Jenkins**, **Pedro Martinez**, **Jim Bunning**, **Cy Young**, **David Cone**, **A.J. Burnett**, **Dennis Martinez** and **Max Scherzer**.

- was the longest relief appearance by an Astros pitcher since **Shane Reynolds** tossed 7.0 innings of relief on July 17, 1994 at PIT...was the longest relief outing by an Astros left-hander since **Jim Crawford** tossed 8.1 innings of relief on Aug. 8, 1975 vs. PIT.

LAST START - 7/28 vs. LAD: gave up 3 runs on 4 hits in 4.1 innings pitched in Houston's 5-2 defeat to the Dodgers...walked 1 with 2 strikeouts on 59 pitches.

- has started 9 of Houston's 12 games: 4 in LF and 5 at DH...prior to last night, hit safely in all 8 of his starts...the last Astros to hit safely in each of their first 8 starts of a season were **J.D. Martinez** (8g), **Brian Bixler** (9g) and **Scott Moore** (9g) in 2012.
- opened up the season with a 4-game RBI-streak, the longest season-opening RBI streak of his career.

- notched 49 career RBI against Oakland, which is his most against a single opponent.
- hit the 100th homer of his career on July 27 vs. SEA...became the 18th player in club history to reach 100 career homers...only 3 players in Astros history reached the century mark in homers in fewer games than Bregman's 521 games (per Elias): **Lance Berkman** (452g), **George Springer** (483g), **Glenn Davis** (514g).
- has had just 11 plate appearances against LHP's this year (3x9, 2 BB)...last season, hit .350 (57x163) with a 1.186 OPS (.443 OBP/.742 SLG) against LHP's, the 3rd-best OPS vs. LHP's in all of MLB.
