TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Athletics will continue their rivalry today for the finale of three games over the weekend between the two top teams in the AL West...

ABOUT JAVIER: Today's Astros starter RHP Cristian Javier, the club's 2019 Minor League Pitcher of the Year, has translated last season's success into the Majors in 2020...

FREE COVID TESTING AT MMP: Texas Governor Greg Abbott, the Texas Division of Emergency Management (TDEM) and the Astros have teamed up to open a free COVID-19 testing site at Minute Maid Park in Houston...

IN THE DUGOUT: Astros Manager Dusty Baker, who managed career game number 3,500 on Opening Day, was named the 19th manager in franchise history on Jan. 29...

YESTERDAY'S PITCHER'S DUEL: The Astros and A's played a close ballgame yesterday with the A's eking out a 3-1 victory...it was an old fashioned pitcher's duel between Astros starter LHP Framber Valdez (1ER) and A's starter RHP Frankie Montas (0ER)...

ON BASE BREGS: 3B Alex Bregman has reached base safely in 46 consecutive road games and is 10 games from tying his own franchise record for this, a 56-game streak set in the 2018 season.

TODAY'S VIDEO CONFERENCES: The Astros will make Dusty Baker and select Astros players available via video conference before (approx. 12:15-1:30 p.m. CT) and immediately after today's game...the video conferences will be hosted on Zoom...

I FIND THAT OFFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in runs per game (5.29), and third in OBP (.325), hits (120), doubles (28) and in extra-base hits (47)...SS Carlos Correa leads the AL in OBP (.458) and ranks second in batting average (.373).

UP THE CHARTS: OF George Springer hit his 163rd career homer on Wednesday, which ties him with OF Cesar Cedeño for sixth on the Astros all-time list: HOME RUNS IN ASTROS HISTORY

SPRINGER UPDATE: OF George Springer exited Thursday's game with a right wrist strain, injured on a diving catch in center field...Springer has not played the last two games and is considered day-to-day.

PLUG AND PLAY: Despite injuries and limited MLB experience on the Astros pitching staff, the club has combined for a 3.98 ERA (59ER/133.1IP), with the bullpen posting a 3.48 ERA (25ER/64.2IP)...

TAYLOR TERRIFIC: LHP Blake Taylor has began his career with six scoreless appearances, tossing 8.2 innings and allowing just five hits with 10 strikeouts...acquired in the OF Jake Marisnick trade with the Mets this offseason, Taylor made the club out of camp despite spending most of his time in 2019 at Class A...

TOMORROW'S CREDENTIALS: The deadline to apply for credentials for tomorrow's game at Minute Maid Park between the Astros and Giants is 1 p.m. CT today...apply at credentials.mlb.com.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros Taxi Squad is currently made up of RHP Bryan Abreu, RHP Chase De Jong, IF Jack Mayfield, OF Chas McCormick and C Michael Papierski...all five players are permitted to work out with the team, but are not on the active roster.

WHATABURGER FIELD WORKOUTS: A few of the club's Major Leaguers are rehabbing at the Astros alternate training site at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi, including OF Yordan Alvarez, IF Aledmys Díaz, RHP Brad Peacock, LHP Cionel Pérez and RHP Jose Urquidy.

LAST START - 8/4 at ARI: pitched Houston to an 8-2 victory at Chase Field, capturing his first-career Major League win...tossed 6.0 innings of 1-run ball, giving up 4 hits and 1 walk with 2 strikeouts.

JAVIER ON THE BUMP: the 23-year-old right-hander and **2019 Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Year** will make his 3rd-career start and 4th-career appearance today.

- in his 2 starts, has gone 1-0 with a 1.54 ERA (2ER/11.2IP), 2 walks, 10 strikeouts and a .150 opponent average (6x40).
- became the 5th pitcher in franchise history to hold the opposition to 1 run-or-fewer while tossing 5.2 innings-or-more in each of his first 2 career MLB starts, joining **Brett Oberholtzer** (2013), **Carlos Hernandez** (2001), **Manny Hernandez** (1986) and **Mike Madden** (1983)...Madden was the only pitcher of that group to stretch his streak to his first 3 career starts.

THE FIRST START: made his first-career Major League start on July 29 vs. LAD, and allowed 1 run on 2 hits and 1 walk with 8 strikeouts in 5.2 innings pitched.

- struck out the first 3 batters he faced to open up the 1st inning (**Muncy-Betts-Bellinger**)...per Elias, became the 2nd pitcher in Astros history to strike out the first 3 batters he faced in his first Major League start, joining **Frank DiPino** (Sept. 7, 1982 vs. SD).
- became the first Astros pitcher to strike out 8+ batters in his first-career MLB start since **Corbin Martin** on May 12, 2019 vs. TEX.

MLB DEBUT: made his Major League debut on July 25 vs. SEA, tossing 1.0 scoreless inning of relief...worked around 1 hit and struck out 1 batter in the outing.

- made his first-career Opening Day roster this season...was added to Houston's 40-man roster this offseason on Nov. 20, and was invited to his first-career big league Spring Training camp.

THE ARSENAL: during his first 3 MLB outings, has thrown 177 pitches: 110 four-seam fastballs (62.1%, 92.6 mph), 33 curveballs (18.6%, 78.7 mph), 17 changeups (9.6%, 86.8 mph) and 17 sliders (9.6%, 78.6 mph).

BREAKOUT 2019 SEASON: was one of minor league baseball's top performers during the 2019 season, posting an 8-3 record and a 1.74 ERA (22ER/113.2IP) with 170 strikeouts across 3 levels in the Astros minor league system: Class A Advanced Fayetteville (7g), Double A Corpus Christi (17g), Triple A Round Rock (2g).

- was named the **2019 Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Year**...led all of minor league baseball in opponent batting average (.130, min. 100IP), while ranking 2nd in ERA, 3rd in strikeout rate (37.7%), 6th in strikeouts and 8th in WHIP (0.97)...trailed only Padres prospect **Mackenzie Gore** in ERA (1.69) among all minor league pitchers.

- was tabbed as a 2nd team selection for MLB Pipeline's Prospect Team of the Year.

ROAD TO THE SHOW: was signed by the Astros 8 days before his 18th birthday on March 18, 2015...was signed out of the Dominican Republic by Astros scouts Oz Ocampo, Roman Ocumarez and Leocadio Guevara.

- per *The Athletic's* Jake Kaplan, Javier began pitching at age 16...had played outfield up until that point.
- is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 6 overall prospect in the Astros organization.

- recorded his 300th career double on July 27 vs. SEA, becoming the 6th Astros player to record 300 doubles, joining **Craig Biggio**, **Jeff Bagwell**, **Lance Berkman**, **Cesar Cedeño** and **Jose Cruz**.

- went 0x4 yesterday at OAK...went 3x4 with a double, walk and a run scored on 8/2 at LAA...was his 5th multi-hit game of the season, and his 3 hits were a season-high.
- reached his 10-years of service in the Majors on Thursday.
- is T-4th in the AL in multi-hit games (5).
- has started 11 of Houston's 14 games: 4 in LF and 7 at DH...prior to Thurs. night, hit safely in all 8 of his starts...the last Astros to hit safely in each of their first 8 starts of a season were **J.D. Martinez** (8g), **Brian Bixler** (9g) and **Scott Moore** (9g) in 2012.
- opened the season with a 4-game RBI-streak, the longest season-opening RBI streak of his career.

- went 1x4 with an RBI to extend his hitting streak to a season-high 8 games, is also the longest hitting streak by an Astros player this season...is also tied for the longest active hitting streak in the AL...has reached base safely in all 14 games this season.
- enters today's game on an active 46-game road on-base streak that dates back to June 22, 2019...has hit .353 (59x167) with 19 doubles, 13 homers, 39 RBI and a 1.188 OPS (.484 OBP/.705 SLG) during the streak...is the 2nd-longest streak of his career, behind a 56-game road on-base streak set in 2018.
- notched 51 career RBI against Oakland, which is his most against a single opponent.
- ranks T-6th in the AL in RBI.
- hit the 100th homer of his career on July 27 vs. SEA...became the 18th player in club history to reach 100 career homers...only 3 players in Astros history reached the century mark in homers in fewer games than Bregman's 521 games (per Elias): **Lance Berkman** (452g), **George Springer** (483g), **Glenn Davis** (514g).
- has had just 11 plate appearances against LHP's this year (3x9, 2 BB)...last season, hit .350 (57x163) with a 1.186 OPS (.443 OBP/.742 SLG) against LHP's, the 3rd-best OPS vs. LHP's in all of MLB.

- set a club record for RBI by a catcher over the first 3 games of a single season (6RBI)...topped the previous record of 4 RBI, which was posted by **Hal Smith** in 1962, the franchise's inaugural season, and **Brad Ausmus** in 2002.
