HERE'S THE STORY: Arizona has won 6 of its last 7 games and is 10-4 in its last 14.

- ◆ The D-backs are 8-3 in their last 11 games in AL parks.
- ◆ **Nick Ahmed** is hitting .500 (18-for-36) with 4 doubles, 2 home runs and 14 RBI in his last 10 games.
- ◆ **David Peralta** is batting .400 (22-for-55) with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 2 homers and 13 RBI in his last 15 games.

VOGT RETURNS TO THE BAY AREA: **Stephen Vogt** returns to the Bay Area after spending parts of 6 seasons with Oakland (2013-17) and San Francisco (2019).

- ◆ Vogt was traded from the Rays to the A's in 2013 for cash considerations, and was named to a pair of AL All-Star Teams (2015-16).
- ◆ He signed with the Giants as a Minor League free agent in Feb. 2019 and appeared in 99 games and hit 10 homers with 40 RBI.

LOCASTRO A GO-GO: **Tim Locastro** has been successful in his first 23 career stolen base attempts, the fifth-longest stolen base streak to start a career (since 1951 - when steals were tracked) [source: Sportradar].

- ◆ Only 6 of the combined 23 runs scored in the home-and-home series vs. A's. have come after the sixth inning.

GOING BATTY: The D-backs are hitting .299 over their last 14 games after batting .194 in their first 11.

- D-backs' second-round pick in the 2015 draft out of TCU (signed by: George Swain).

LAST APPEARANCE: In his first start, on Aug. 15 vs. Padres, worked 4.1 innings with 1 run on 4 hits and 1 walk with 5 strikeouts.

VS. A'S: First time facing the A's.

INTERLEAGUE: Has 2 career Interleague outings (1 start), going 1-0 with a 1.42 ERA (1 ER in 6.1 IP).

- His lone start was a 9-2 win on July 16, 2019 @ Rangers (1 ER in 5.1 IP).
- Had a relief outing on Aug. 6 vs. Astros (0 ER in 1.0 IP).

WHAT EVER YOU NEED: Is 7-5 with a 3.76 ERA (34 ER in 81.1 IP) in 16 starts and 1-0 with a 2.81 ERA (5 ER in 16.0 IP) in 9 relief appearances.

LIMITED FREEBIES AVAILABLE: Has issued only 1 walk in his last 6 appearances (45 BF)...did not issue a walk over 5 outings (27 BF) from July 31-Aug. 11.

AVOIDING THE HARD CONTACT: Is averaging 86.3 mph exit velocity, the second lowest on the team behind Junior Guerra (83.0).

- Averaged 87.7 mph exit velocity in 2019.

2019 REVIEW: Went 7-5 with a 3.56 ERA in 17 games (15 starts) in his first season with Arizona.

- Set a club rookie record with 12 strikeouts on Sept. 7 @ Reds, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings with 2 hits allowed.
- Threw 6.0 hitless innings on July 7 vs. Rockies before being removed by manager Torey Lovullo, tied for the longest no-hit outing to open a game by a D-backs rookie (also: Edgar Gonzalez on Aug. 29, 2004 @ Reds) [source: Sportsradar].

RISP-Y BUSINESS: Despite going 0-for-8 last night with runners in scoring position, Arizona is batting .355 (38-for-107) with RISP in its last 9 games and leads all of baseball with a .313 average (68-for-217) overall.

START ME UP: D-backs starters have posted a 2.18 ERA (8 ER in 33.0 IP) and a .154 opponent average in their last 6 games.

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona has won 14 of its last 19 games vs. AL opponents and is 19-9 (.679) since 2019.

- ◆ The D-backs' .679 interleague winning pct. is the second best in the Majors during that span behind only the Mets (.708; 17-7).
- **BEST INTERLEAGUE WIN PCT SINCE 2019:** .708 - Mets (17-7); .679 - D-backs (19-9); .667 - Rays (16-8); .654 - Cubs (17-9).

ON DECK - SAN FRANCISCO GIANTS: The D-backs went 10-9 vs. Giants in 2019, going 7-2 @ Oracle Park.

- ◆ **Ketel Marte** is hitting .362 (17-for-47)/1.220 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs and 10 RBI in his last 11 games vs. Giants.

NEXT STARTER: LHP ROBBIE RAY (1-2, 8.59)

- ◆ Tossed 5.0 hitless innings in a no decision on Aug. 16 vs. Padres (1 ER)...recorded his 1,000th strikeout (Jorge Mateo), becoming the second-fastest left-hander since 1913 to reach the milestone (154 G and 810.0 IP).

- ◆ Was 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA in 3 starts in 2019 vs. Giants and 5-2 with a 3.33 ERA in 14 career starts.

- ◆ Has gone 4-2 with a 3.03 ERA (13 ER in 38.2 IP) in 7 starts @ Oracle Park.
