TODAY'S GAME: The Giants and A's play game one of a three-game weekend series...the Giants enter tonight having won two-straight and seven of their last 10 games...the A's have won six of their last 10 contests and can clinch a Postseason berth tonight with a win over the Giants AND a Mariners loss to the Padres.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves today: **RHP Rico Garcia** and **LHP Wandy Peralta** optioned to the Alternate Training Site... **RHP Shaun Anderson** (#64) and **LHP Andrew Suarez** (#59) recalled from the Alternate Training Site.

WILD FINISH: SF enters today with a 1.0 game lead over the Phillies for the 7th seed in NL Wild Card race... the Cardinals are 0.5 game behind the Phillies for the 8th spot, followed by the Brewers (1.0 game back), Mets (1.5 games back) and Rockies (2.0 games back).

WINNING WAYS: After going 3-7 over their first 10 interleague games this year, the Giants have won seven straight - tied for the longest interleague win streak in team history...it's also tied for the longest interleague win streak in MLB this year, with the Dodgers and Padres (seven each, neither is active) (Stats, LLC).

HITTING THE LONGBALL: The Giants are playing their 50th game of the season tonight and will have posted one of the highest home run totals at that juncture in franchise history...the team has hit 65 homers thus far through 49 games this year for the fourth-highest total in franchise history behind the 2001 team (74 homers in first 50 games), 2000 team (71 homers) and 1958 club (70 homers).

INTERLEAGUE: San Francisco has scored six or more runs in each of its last eight interleague contests, tied for the longest such streak by any MLB team all-time... the Twins did it in eight straight games spanning the 2006 and 2007 seasons (Stats, LLC).

COMEBACK KIDS: Yesterday was the Giants' 12th come-from-behind win this season, tied with the Mets for the fifth-most such wins in the NL...the Padres lead the Majors with 20 comeback wins (Stats, LLC).

JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco has posted a 24-11 (.686) record when they score four-or-more runs in a game, compared to a 1-13 record when they score three-or-fewer runs.

FINAL COUNTDOWN: Just 11 games remain on the regular-season schedule for the Giants - three at Oakland, four vs. Colorado and four vs. San Diego.

GIANT OFFENSE: San Francisco enters tonight's game ranking second in the NL in team batting average (.269), fifth in OPS (.791) and fifth in extra-base hits (168)...last year, the Giants ranked 22nd in extra-base hits (493), 27th in team batting average (.239), 28th in OPS (.694).

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants committed 21 errors in 155.0 innings in their first 18 games this season from July 23-August 10, the most miscues in MLB during that span...however, beginning August 11, SF has made a total of just 15 errors over their last 31 games and 268.1 innings, the fewest errors in the National League.

IN THE PEN: Giants relievers combined for 7.0-scoreless innings in yesterday's 6-4 victory against the Mariners...SF's bullpen has held opponents scoreless in 12.1 innings in their last two games and have posted a 1.81 ERA (9er, 44.2ip) in their past 11 contests...in fact, beginning August 19, the Giants' bullpen ERA of 2.05 is the second-best in MLB behind Oakland (1.95).

ON THIS DATE: SEPTEMBER 18, 1997

At San Francisco, **Brian Johnson** homered in the 12th inning to give the Giants a 6 - 5 win over the Dodgers and a tie for the lead in the National League West. Rod Beck gave up three singles in the 10th, but struck out Todd Zeile and got Eddie Murray on a double play.

MANAGER GABE KAPLER

- ▶ Is in his first season as the skipper of the Giants after being named the 39th manager in club history on November 12, 2019.
- ▶ Spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as the skipper of the Philadelphia Phillies, going 161-163 (.497) in his two seasons.
- ▶ The 2020 campaign marks his fourth season managing and his third at the Major League level...he managed Class A Greenville in the Boston Red Sox organization in 2007.
- ▶ Prior to joining the Phillies, Kapler was the Director of Player Development for the Dodgers from November 2014 until being hired by Philadelphia in October 2017.
- ▶ From 2015-2017, the three seasons Kapler was at the helm of the Dodgers Player Development, the Dodgers minor league affiliates went a combined 1,299-1,128 (.535)...the .535 winning pct. was fourth-best among MLB teams in that time
- ▶ Had a 12-year career as a player from 1998-2010, suiting up for Detroit (1998-99), Texas (2000-02), Colorado (2002), Boston (2003-06), Milwaukee (2008) and Tampa Bay (2009-10)...a former 57th-round pick in 1995, Kapler hit .268 over his 1,104 career games.

TODAY'S OUTING: Will make his 11th start of the 2020 campaign and his second start this year today vs. Oakland

LAST TIME OUT: Had a bounce-back outing in San Diego on Sunday in the second game of a twinbill...worked 4.0 innings and allowed only one run (a solo HR by Wil Myers) while striking out five...was removed after 4.0 innings with the game tied at one.

REVERSE, REVERSE: Through 10 starts in 2020 Webb is showing some reverse splits, getting out lefties with more success than righties...left-handed batters have gone 9-for-47 (.191) with two extra-base hits (both doubles) in his last five starts...on the flip side, right-handed hitters have gone 17-for-47 (.362) with seven extra-base hits (four doubles, one triple and two homers) in that same period...*Webb's full left/right splits are listed in the right column.*

LOOKING FOR EFFICIENCY: Through nine starts in 2020, Webb is throwing an average of 4.09 pitches per batter faced...his 4.09 pitches per batter faced are sixth-highest among NL starters with at least 45.0ip in 2020...on the whole, Webb is throwing an average of 18.0 pitches per inning through 10 starts, the sixth-highest amount of any MLB pitcher with at least 40.0ip this season.

RISPY BUSINESS: With RISP and two outs, opposing batters have gone 0-for-16 with a .158 OPS...according to *Stats, LLC*, Webb is the only MLB pitcher this year to have 15+ opponent at-bats against him with RISP and two outs and not allow a hit.
