THE GIANTS: Enter today's games having lost five of their last seven games... SF has scored one run or fewer in all five of those losses and have been shut out in each of their last two games...the Giants have gone 20-consecutive innings without scoring a run.

ON THE MOUND: LHP Tyler Anderson will make his 10th start of the season today looking for his third win of the year...Anderson is 1-2 with an 8.10 ERA (15er, 16.2ip) in his last four starts...he's never faced the A's in his career.

ABOVE AND BELOW .500: The Giants are 5-16 (.238) against teams above .500, the lowest win pct. in MLB...however, SF has the fourth-highest win pct. against teams under .500, going 20-10 (.667)...following today's game, the Giants play four against the Rockies who enter play today at 22-29 (Stats, LLC).

ROUGH ON THE ROAD: The Giants play their final regular-season road game today...SF has gone 9-17 (.346) on the road for the third-lowest road winning percentage among NL teams ahead of the Pirates (5-20, .200) and Diamondbacks (9-20, .310)...SF has lost their last six games away from Oracle Park.

FINAL COUNTDOWN: Just nine games remain on the regular-season schedule for the Giants -one at Oakland, four vs. Colorado and four vs. San Diego.

JUST SCORE FOUR: San Francisco has posted a 24-11 (.686) record when they score four-or-more runs in a game, compared to a 1-15 (.063) record when they score three-or-fewer runs.

WITH THE GLOVES: The Giants committed 21 errors in 155.0 innings in their first 18 games this season from July 23-August 10, the most miscues in MLB during that span...however, beginning August 11, SF has made a total of just 15 errors over their last 33 games and 284.1 innings, the fewest errors in the National League.

IN THE PEN: Beginning August 19, the Giants' bullpen ERA of 2.38 is the second-best in MLB behind Oakland (1.82).

HITTING LEFTIES: The Giants have the fifth-best OPS among MLB teams against left-handed pitching at .816...only the White Sox (.915), Tigers (.875), Nationals (.843) and Phillies (.839) have a better OPS against lefties than the Giants.

RUNS ON ROAD/HOME: The Giants are averaging 4.04 runs per game (105 runs/26 games) on the road (11th in NL) compared to 5.84 per game (146 runs/25 games) at home (2nd in NL).

RACE FOR THE BATTING TITLE: IF Donovan Solano went 2-for-4 yesterday to increase his batting average to .337 (56-for-166), the third-highest figure in the NL behind Atlanta's Freddie Freeman (.349) and Washington's Juan Soto (.338)...Solano is seeking his first career batting title.

New York Giants slugger **Willie Mays** hit two home runs against the Pittsburgh Pirates, giving him 50 for the year and making him the seventh player in major league history to accomplish that feat.

MANAGER GABE KAPLER

- ▶ Is in his first season as the skipper of the Giants after being named the 39th manager in club history on November 12, 2019.
- ▶ Spent the 2018 and 2019 seasons as the skipper of the Philadelphia Phillies, going 161-163 (.497) in his two seasons.
- ▶ The 2020 campaign marks his fourth season managing and his third at the Major League level...he managed Class A Greenville in the Boston Red Sox organization in 2007.
- ▶ Prior to joining the Phillies, Kapler was the Director of Player Development for the Dodgers from November 2014 until being hired by Philadelphia in October 2017.
- ▶ From 2015-2017, the three seasons Kapler was at the helm of the Dodgers Player Development, the Dodgers minor league affiliates went a combined 1,299-1,128 (.535)...the .535 winning pct. was fourth-best among MLB teams in that time
- ▶ Had a 12-year career as a player from 1998-2010, suiting up for Detroit (1998-99), Texas (2000-02), Colorado (2002), Boston (2003-06), Milwaukee (2008) and Tampa Bay (2009-10)...a former 57th-round pick in 1995, Kapler hit .268 over his 1,104 career games.
