### THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY **APRIL 2**

2018 - The Astros unveil their 2017 World Series Championship banner in a pregame ceremony before the home opener vs. BAL... one of the heroes of the World Series, RHP Charlie Morton, gets the start, earning the win after tossing 6.0 scoreless frames in the GAME 2: The Astros and A's will match up for Game 2 of the 2021 season tonight in Oakland with the Astros going for their 17th 2-0 start in club history (last accomplished in 2020)...tonight's pitching matchup features a pair of young starters with great nicknames in 24-year old RHP Cristian Javier and 23-year old LHP Jesús Luzardo...it's a matchup of amphibians, with Javier nicknamed El Reptíl (Spanish for reptile) and Luzardo known as the Lizard King, per Baseball-Reference.

JAVIER ON THE BUMP: RHP Cristian Javier enters his second Major League season after a successful rookie season in 2020 in which he finished third in the AL in Rookie of the Year voting...he followed up his regular season with an outstanding postseason run, in which he posted a 2-0 record with three holds and a 2.89 ERA (3ER/9.1IP) in five relief appearances.

ON THE RADIO: Tonight's Astros English radio broadcast will air exclusively on KTRH 740 AM with Robert Ford and Steve Sparks on the call...Ford and Sparks are both entering their ninth season in the booth since joining the club back in 2013.

**ASTROS EN ESPAÑOL:** Tonight's Astros Spanish radio broadcast, featuring Francisco Romero and Alex Treviño, can be heard exclusively on the MLB App...the Astros will announce their on-air Spanish radio partner in the coming weeks

MODERN-DAY RECORD REACHED: With last night's win, the Astros have won nine straight games on Opening Day (2013-21), which ties the modern Major league record, also reached by the Mariners (2007-15), Reds (1983-91), Mets (1975-83) and St. Louis Browns (1937-45)...per Elias, the only MLB team to post a longer winning streak on Opening Day was the 1887-1896 Boston Beaneaters (current Braves franchise), with a 10-game streak.

**OPENING DAY WIN:** The Astros downed the A's by a score of 8-1 on Opening Day last night behind a strong pitching performance by RHP Zack Greinke (0ER/6IP) and big games from LF Michael Brantley (3x4, HR, RBI) and DH Yordan Alvarez (1x3, 3RBI)... below are some highlights from last night:

- · Marked the 18th time in club history for the Astros to open the year on the road...they are 9-9 when they open on the road and 32-28 all-time on Opening Day.
- Greinke earned his first career Opening Day win in what was his fifth career Opening Day start.
- 2B Jose Altuve made his 10th consecutive Opening Day start, becoming just the fourth player in franchise history to start double-digit Opening Day games, joining Jeff Bagwell (15 starts), 2B Craig Biggio (14 starts) and OF Jose Cruz (11 starts).
- Brantley has homered on three straight Opening Days, joining George Springer (2017-19) and Jeff Bagwell (1994-96) as the only players in club history to do so.
- Brantley and 3B Alex Bregman hit back-to-back homers in the 8th inning, making them the fourth pair of Astros teammates to hit back-to-back homers on Opening Day, also Cesar Cedeño-Bob Watson (1976), Carl Everett-Richard Hidalgo (1999) and Carlos Lee-Brian Bogusevic (2012).

AT THE HELM: Astros skipper Dusty Baker is commencing his second season in a Houston uniform after leading the Astros to the ALCS in 2020...Baker, now the only manager in MLB history to take five different teams to the Postseason, currently ranks 15th all time in managerial wins (1,893), just three wins behind HOFer Bill McKechnie (1,896) on that all-time list.

AIR YORDAN: With three RBI last night, DH Yordan Alvarez has totaled 85 RBI in his first 90 career Major League games...only four players in MLB history have tallied more RBI within their first 90 career games: Walt Dropo (95 RBI), Rudy York (94), Joe DiMaggio (88) and Ted Williams (87)...York, DiMaggio and Williams all played in the 1930s, while Dropo played in the '40s.

SALTY VETS: The Astros pitching staff features Major League Baseball's active leader in starts (RHP Zack **Greinke**) and active leader in relief appearances (RHP Joe Smith)...last night, Greinke made his 460th career start, while Smith made his 783rd career appearance.

V'S THE A'S: The Astros and A's have played each other 150 times in their histories, splitting the wins at 75 apiece...Houston of course owns the Postseason record against the A's, as they dispatched Oakland in four games in the 2020 ALDS, their only Postseason matchup...if there was an MVP awarded for the ALDS, it would have been SS Carlos Correa, who hit .500 (7x14) with three homers and 11 RBI in the four games.

ABOUT THE ROSTER: The Astros Opening Day roster consists of 13 pitchers, 13 position players and six on the Injured List: RHP Justin Verlander, RHP Pedro Báez, RHP Josh James, RHP Austin Pruitt, RHP Andre Scrubb and LHP Framber Valdez.

THE TAXI SQUAD: The Astros five-man Taxi Squad for this road trip consists of RHP Ralph Garza Jr., RHP Nivaldo Rodriguez, RHP Peter Solomon, C Garrett Stubbs and IF Abraham Toro.

**CREDENTIAL DEADLINE:** The deadline to apply for credentials for the Astros Home Opener on April 8 vs. OAK is Monday at 7 p.m. CT...credentials can be applied for at Credentials.mlb.com...due to spacing limitations, the Astros will be very limited on credentials.

**EXHIBITION SEASON OVER:** The Astros completed their exhibition season with a 6-14-4 record in Grapefruit League play...the Astros got strong Springs from SS Carlos Correa (.308, 12x39), RF Michael Brantley (11 RBI) and CF Myles Straw (.310, 13x42).

**LAST REG. SEASON START - 9/24/20 at TEX:** ended the 2020 regular season campaign with a 5.2-inning, 3-run performance in a 12-4 win against the Rangers...walked 1 with 6 strikeouts over 95 pitches.

**LAST SPRING OUTING - 3/14 vs. WSH:** threw 1.0 scoreless inning against the Nationals.

- **EL REPTÍL:** the 24-year-old right-hander is set to start the Astros 2nd game of the season tonight in what will be his 11th career MLB start.
- had a breakout 2020 rookie season that culminated with a 3rd-place finish in the 2020 AL Rookie of the Year voting...led AL rookies in ERA (3.48) and opponent batting average (.188).
- in 10 starts in 2020, went 5-2 with a 3.68 ERA (21ER/51.1IP), 18 walks and 48 strikeouts.
- **VS. 0AK:** made 2 starts in the regular season against the A's in 2020, giving up 7 runs in 8.0 innings...was dominant in 2 postseason relief outings against the club in the ALDS.
- tossed 3.1 scoreless innings in the 2020 ALDS against the A's, striking out 6 with 1 walk and 3 hits allowed...earned the win in the series-clinching Game 4, tossing 2.1 scoreless innings with 4 strikeouts in Houston's 11-6 win.
- **SECRET WEAPON:** went 2-0 with a 2.89 ERA (3ER/9.1IP), 5 walks and 13 strikeouts across 5 postseason outings in 2020, all of which were in relief.
- joined Charlie Morton (2017) as the only pitchers in Astros history to record two wins in series-clinching games in a single postseason...was the winning pitcher in the Astros ALDS Game 4 victory over the A's, and their Wild Card Series Game 2 win over the Twins.
- **TOUGH TO SQUARE UP:** allowed just 36 hits in 54.1 innings pitched (.188 opponent batting average, 36x192) during the 2020 regular season.
- ranked 4th in the AL in opponent batting average (min. 150 batters faced), behind only Shane Bieber (.167), Kenta Maeda (.168) and Lucas Giolito (.184).
- posted the 7th-best hard-hit ball rate in MLB (29.3%, min. 100 batted balls).
- his .188 opponent batting average was the 3rd-lowest by a rookie in a single season in Astros history (min. 200 batters faced)...only Billy Wagner (.165 in 1996) and Bill Dawley (.185 in 1983) posted lower marks.
- in 2019, led all of minor league baseball in opponent average (.130), 31 points in front of the next best pitcher (**Mackenzie Gore**, .161)
- **BREAKOUT 2019 SEASON:** was one of minor league baseball's top performers during the 2019 season, posting an 8-3 record and a 1.74 ERA (22ER/113.2IP) with 170 strikeouts across 3 levels in the Astros minor league system: Class A Advanced Fayetteville (7g), Double A Corpus Christi (17g), Triple A Round Rock (2g).
- was named the 2019 Astros Minor League Pitcher of the Year...led all
  of minor league baseball in opponent batting average (.130, min. 100IP),
  while ranking 2nd in ERA, 3rd in strikeout rate (37.7%), 6th in strikeouts
  and 8th in WHIP (0.97)...trailed only Padres prospect Mackenzie Gore
  in ERA (1.69) among all minor league pitchers.

- has been an integral part of the Astros success since making his Major League debut in 2015, both in the regular season and postseason.
- in 14 career postseason appearances (7 starts), has posted a 3.28 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 45.2 innings pitched...holds the distinction of being both the closer and starter in the Astros two Game 7 victories in the 2017 postseason, as he tossed the final 4.0 innings to earn the save in the Game 7 ALCS win vs. the Yankees, and was the starting pitcher in the Astros Game 7 World Series win at Dodger Stadium.
