HERE'S THE STORY: The D-backs are 7-3 in their last 10 home games dating back to 2020.

- ♦ Arizona is 8-3 in its last 11 games vs. A's @ Chase Field.
- The D-backs won both games @ home in 2020, winning 4-3 and 10-1.
- ◆ The D-backs faced Jesús Luzardo twice this spring...the A's lefty allowed 6 runs (5 earned) on 8 hits over 6.2 innings (6.75 ERA).

ROSTER MOVES: Prior to today's game, the D-backs reinstated **Zac Gallen** from the 10-day injured list (right forearm hair-line stress fracture of radial head).

◆ To make room for Gallen, the D-backs optioned Matt Peacock to the Alternate Training Site following last night's game.

CRON JOINS STAFF: Chris Cron, the D-backs' field coordinator, has joined the Major League staff in place of Dave McKay, who is continuing to recuperate from an injury suffered in Spring Training.

◆ Cron will handle outfield responsibilities and various hitting duties.

BEST OF LUCK: The D-backs would like to congratulate long-time A's equipment manager, **Steve "Vuc" Vucinich**, on his retirement following the season, his 54th with Oakland.

 Vucinich, who has a home in Phoenix, is the only remaining team employee from the move to the Bay Area in 1968.

WALK THIS WAY: The D-backs rank second in walks (44) in the NL, trailing only the Dodgers (50).

LOCASTRO SETS MLB RECORD: On Saturday, **Tim Locastro** set a Major League record with his 28th consecutive stolen base attempt to start his career (since 1951), breaking a tie with Hall of Famer and Arizona resident Tim Raines (1979-81).

- ◆ Raines was Locastro's first base running coach in the Blue Jays' organization in 2013.
- ♦ Locastro's 28 straight stolen-base streak is tied for the 23rd longest all-time...next up is 30-steal streaks by Alcides Escobar/KC (2012-14), Mike Trout/LAA (2012), Jimmy Rollins/PHI (2009-10) and Eric Byrnes/ARI (2007).
 - Vince Coleman/STL holds the Major League record with 50 straight steals (1988-89) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

INTERLEAGUE INSIGHT: Arizona is 20-11 in its last 31 games vs. AL opponents and is 25-16 (.610) since 2019.

◆ The D-backs' .610 interleague winning pct. since 2019 is fourth best in the Majors behind the Rays (.674; 29-14), Dodgers (.650; 28-15) and Padres (.628, 27-16).

PERALTA CLIMBING THE CHARTS: David Peralta, who hit a 3-run homer on Sunday, needs 1 roundtripper to break a tie with Jay Bell (91) and gain sole possession of ninth place in franchise history.

♦ Peralta is 3 hits shy of tying Stephen Drew (776) for fifth place on the club's all-time list.

ON DECK - WASHINGTON NATIONALS: The 2 teams are meeting for the first time since Aug. 2019.

- ♦ Arizona won the last series vs. Washington, taking 2 of 3 games from Aug. 2-4, 2019 @ Chase Field.
- ♦ The 2 teams split the last series @ Nationals Park from June 13-16, 2019.
- ◆ Asdrúbal Cabrera spent 3 seasons with the Nationals (2014, '19-20).

NEXT STARTER: RHP MERRILL KELLY (0-2, 8.10)

- ♦ Lost his last start on April 8 @ Rockies (6 ER in 6.0 IP).
- ♦ Opponents are hitting just .125 (1-for-8) off his curve ball this season.
- ♦ Will be making his first career start vs. Nationals.

RHP ZAC GALLEN ♦ #23 ♦ R/R ♦ 6-2/198 ♦ 25 (AUG. 3, 1995)

AT A GLANCE: Third season with the D-backs.

- Acquired on July 31, 2019 from the Marlins...split his debut season with the Marlins and D-backs in 2019.
- Cardinals' third-round pick in the 2016 draft out of the University of North Carolina.

2020: Tied for ninth in NL Cy Young voting and named the D-backs' Most Valuable Pitcher by the Arizona BBWAA.

- In 12 starts, went 3-2 with a 2.75 ERA (22 ER in 72.0 IP), 82 strikeouts, .210 opponent average and 1.11 WHIP.
- 8 of his 22 earned runs came in 2 consecutive innings (4 runs in the sixth inning on Sept. 7 @ Giants [no outs recorded] and 4 runs in the first inning on Sept. 12 vs. Mariners).

23 SET MLB RECORD AT 23: Set the Major League record by allowing 3 or fewer earned runs in each of his first 23 career games (all starts, no relief appearances)...previous best was 21 games by Aaron Sele/Red Sox (June 23, 1993-April 19, 1994) [source: Elias Sports Bureau].

23: Switched to uniform No. 23 prior to 2020...grew up a big fan of Michael Jordan and wore No. 23 for his sophomore and junior seasons for the Tarheels.

VS. A'S: In his lone career start, Aug. 17 last season, tossed 7.0 innings with 1 run on 3 hits and 1 walks with 8 strikeouts.

SINCE BECOMING A D-BACK: In 20 starts since his D-backs debut on Aug. 7, 2019 (team is 9-5), is 5-5 with a 2.80 ERA (36 ER in 115.2 IP), .217 opp. average and 135 strikeouts (10.50 K/9.0 IP)

 In 11 home starts as a D-back (team is 7-1), is 4-2 with a 2.74 ERA (20 ER in 65.2 IP) while averaging 10.55 K/9.0 IP (77 K/65.2 IP).
