O'S ON THE INJURED LIST

Anthony Santander 10-day (left ankle sprain) Mac Sceroler 10-day (right shoulder tendinitis) Chris Davis 60-day (lower back strain) Hunter Harvey 60-day (left oblique strain) WRAPPING UP THE ROAD TRIP: The Orioles completed their second road trip of the season on Wednesday, falling to the Marlins by a 3-0 score...The O's ended the road trip with a winning record, going 3-2 in the five games...The O's have posted a winning record in each of their first two road trips, 4-2 and 3-2 respectively.

- The O's were shutout for the third time this season on Wednesday, all coming on the road... Their three times being shutout are tied for the most in the AL (SEA and TEX) and tied for the second-most in the majors (MIA 4).
- O_3 The O's 2.92 team ERA (32 ER/98.2 IP) on the road is the lowest in the AL and the third-lowest in the majors; the O's bullpen has posted a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) on the road.

MAKING OUR WAY BACK HOME: The O's begin a seven-game homestand tonight, with three games over the weekend against Oakland and a four-game set next week against New York-AL...The O's have gone 1-6 at Oriole Park this season and are 14-26 at home since the beginning of the 2020 season.

- Orioles pitchers have surrendered 16 home runs at Oriole Park, in seven games, the second-most home runs allowed at home in the AL (OAK 18 in 14 games).
- The Orioles 6.32 team ERA (40 ER/57.0) at home is the highest in the majors.

TAKING ON THE ATHLETICS: The Orioles and Athletics meet for the first time this season, beginning a three-game series tonight; they'll already wrap up their season series next week, when the O's travel out to Oakland for a three-game set next weekend, April 30 - May 2.

- O₃ The Orioles went 1-6 against Oakland during the 2019 season, including losing each of the last six games.
- Θ_{\gg} INF/OF Trey Mancini has slashed .324/.425/.588 with three home runs in 10 career games at home against the Athletics.
- 🔗 C Chance Sisco has gone hitless (0-for-14) in six career games against Oakland.

KEEPING IT IN THE YARD: Orioles pitchers have not allowed a home run in four-straight games...The four-game stretch is their longest this season and longest since July 21-24, 2016... The last time O's pitchers did not allow a home run in five-straight games was July 8-16, 2016...All seven of the games in which O's pitchers have not allowed a home run this season have come on the road...Their seven road home runs allowed are tied for the fourth-fewest in the AL...38 of the 77 runs allowed by Orioles pitchers this season have come via the home run (49.4%).

THE GOOD AND THE BAD INNINGS: O's hitters are batting .312 (24-for-77) in the third inning and have scored 15 runs...Their third inning batting average is the third-highest in the majors and their 15 runs scored are tied for the fourth-most...The O's have surrendered just one run in the ninth inning this season, one of six teams in the majors to have allowed one-or-fewer runs in this frame...The Orioles have allowed 21 runs, all earned, in the fifth inning this season, the most in the majors; their 10.50 ERA (21 ER/18.0 IP) is the highest in the fifth inning...On the hitting side, the O's have yet to score a run in the second inning, the only team in the majors not to have scored a run in the second.

<u>DE-PEN-DABLE:</u> The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 3.38 ERA (25 ER/66.2 IP) this season, the sixth-lowest ERA in the AL and seventh-lowest in the majors...At home, the bullpen has posted a 5.55 ERA (15 ER/24.1 IP) in seven games compared to a 2.13 ERA (10 ER/42.1 IP) in 11 games on the road.

- 6» RHP César Valdez has recorded four saves in five opportunities; tied for the most saves in the AL...Valdez has allowed a .224 opponent slugging percentage since joining the Orioles on August 29 last season (17 games); this is the third-lowest opponent slugging percentage by an AL pitcher in this stretch (min. 20.0 IP).
- (2 ER/11.0 IP)...His innings out of the bullpen are the seventh-most in the AL.
- C₃ LHP Paul Fry has appeared in a team-high nine games...His nine games are tied for the most by a left-handed pitcher in the AL and tied for the sixth-most in the majors...He has not allowed a run since his 2021 debut on 4/5 at NYY (eight games 7.0 IP); the eight-straight games without allowing a run is tied for the longest active streak in the majors.

WHO'S ON FIRST, WHAT'S ON SECOND: The Orioles have been shutout in two of their last three games, collecting nine total hits and one walk in these games...On the season, the O's as a team have a .2762 on-base percentage, the lowest in the majors...Their team .639 OPS also ranks as the lowest in the majors.

- O_b The O's have walked 46 times this season, the fewest in the AL and third fewest in the majors; INF Maikel Franco and OF Cedric Mullins lead the club with seven walks each.
- As a team, the O's have taken 49.3% of pitches seen (1230/2495), the lowest percentage in baseball.

FLIPPING THE SWITCH: INF Freddy Galvis has hit safely in five of his last six games, and in eight of his last 11...Six of his seven extra-base hits this season have come in his last six games.

O_x In his last 11 games (since 4/10), Galvis is batting .394 (13-for-33) and has raised his season batting average from .115 to .271 during this stretch; his batting average during this 11-game stretch ranks as the third-highest in the AL and tied for the fifth-highest in the majors.

OFFICIAL SCORER UPDATE: The official scorer from the game on April 20 at Miami has made a change to a play in the eighth inning...INF Rio Ruiz advanced to third base on what was originally scored a caught stealing and throwing error by the catcher...This has since been changed to a straight stolen base for Ruiz, with no error credited to Miami, and Ruiz's run now being an earned run...Ruiz now has two stolen bases on the season.

LAST START: Earned his first win of the season on 4/16 against TEX; marked his first win since 9/14/20 vs. ATL, snapping a streak of four-straight losses dating back to 9/19/20 vs. TB...Threw a season-high 5.0 innings, in which he allowed two runs on two hits, both home runs, with one walk while striking out a season-high eight batters...His eight strikeouts are tied for the second-most in his career, only behind a 10 strikeout performance on 4/16/19 at CWS, and his most since 5/29/19 at CWS (8).

QUICK HITS: Claimed off waivers from Kansas City on 8/9/20 and made his Orioles debut on 8/16/20 vs. Washington...Made just one appearance with the Royals on 7/26/20 at Cleveland...Started as a reliever with Baltimore before moving to the rotation on 8/30/20...Originally selected in the second round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft by the Milwaukee Brewers.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Will be making second career start vs. Oakland (third appearance) and first since 9/17/19 with KC; is 0-1 in his career against the A's with an 8.22 ERA (7 ER/7.1 IP)...In his only career start vs. OAK, López suffered the loss, in which he threw 6.0 innings, and allowed two runs on four hits and one walk, while striking out four.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Will be making his second-straight start vs. an American League-West foe after not having faced an AL West opponent since 9/17/19 (at OAK with KC)...Is 1-3 in eight career appearances (six starts), and has pitched to a 7.63 ERA (26 ER/30.2 IP) with 12 walks, and 32 strikeouts.

LONG BALL BLUES: Has given up at least one home run in a career-high seven-straight starts dating back to 9/9/20 at New York-NL...In the seven-game span, he's allowed 11 home runs, eight of which have been solo shots...Home runs have accounted for 35 percent (15-of-43) of the runs he's allowed during that time; including seven of 13 runs allowed in 2021...His five home runs allowed this season are tied for third-most among all Major League pitchers.

RESTED UP: Tonight will be his first start in six days (4/16 at TEX), thanks to two scheduled off days; is 3-4 in eight-career starts when pitching on six days rest or greater, and has pitched to a $5.86\ ERA\ (28\ ER/43.0\ IP)$ with 12 walks and 40 strikeouts.

NO PLACE LIKE HOME: Is looking for his first win at Oriole Park since 9/14/20 vs. ATL, in which he threw 7.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits and two walks, while striking out three...Is 0-1 at OPACY this season, pitching to a 15.75 ERA (7 ER/4.0 IP) in one start, compared to a career 4.89 ERA (19 ER/35.0 IP) in five starts (seven appearances) at Oriole Park.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Went 2-2 with a 6.34 ERA (27 ER/38.1 IP), 12 walks, and 28 strikeouts in nine games (six starts) for the Orioles...Pitched to a 6.14 ERA (20 ER/29.1 IP) with nine walks and 20 strikeouts in the starts alone... Did not earn a decision in any of his relief appearances...Earned his first win as an Oriole on 9/4 vs. NYY (G2), and his first victory since 9/12/19 vs. Chicago-AL...In his start on 9/14 vs. ATL, López became the first Orioles pitcher to toss at least 7.0 innings in a game last season...Led Baltimore hurlers with 30 runs allowed (27 earned), and ranked third in innings pitched (38.1) and hits allowed (43).
