O'S ON THE INJURED LIST

Anthony Santander 10-day (left ankle sprain) Mac Sceroler 10-day (right shoulder tendinitis) 60-day (lower back strain) Chris Davis Hunter Harvey 60-day (left oblique strain) LIFE ON THE ROAD: The O's defeated the A's 3-2 in last night's series opener, and have now gone 4-1 in series opener's on the road this season... Overall, the O's have gone 8-4 on the road for a .667 winning percentage, tied for the second-highest in the AL and tied for fourth-best in the majors.

- The O's have posted a team ERA of 2.84 (34 ER/107.2 IP) in their 12 road games, the second-lowest in the AL and majors (BOS - 2.58).
- The O's have averaged 3.8 runs per game on the road and 3.5 at home; they have a +9 run differential on the road and a -22 run differential at home.
- θ_{*} The O's won their second game of the season last night when scoring three-or-fewer runs (2-12 overall), both have come on the road and during a John Means start (4/2 at BOS).
- OF Cedric Mullins leads the O's with 16 road hits and batting .340 (16-for-47); his hits are tied for the seventh-most in the AL

YOU HAVE MY VOTE: LHP John Means should be your AL Pitcher of the Month for April, and here are the reasons why...Means improved to 3-0 after last night's victory...His 1.70 ERA (7 ER/37.0 IP), 0.84 WHIP, 38 strikeouts, 37.0 IP, and .163 (21-for-129) opponent batting average all rank fourth in the Al

- ⊕ His 1.8 WAR for pitchers leads all of baseball, according to Baseball-Reference.
- One of two pitchers in the majors (**Glasnow**, TB) to have two scoreless appearances of at least 7.0 innings.
- Means' 60 in-zone swing and misses lead the AL and are the second-most in the majors (deGrom, NYM - 65), according to Statcast.
- $\theta_{\!\scriptscriptstyle N}$ His 1.70 ERA is the lowest for an O's starter in their first six starts of a season since RHP Jim Palmer in 1977 (1.13); it is the 10th time in club history in which an O's starter has posted a 1.70 ERA-or-lower in his first six starts of a season.
- (74 total pitches)... His changeup is inducing a 78.9 MPH opponent exit velocity and a 37.4% whiff rate

DE-PEN-DABLE: The Orioles bullpen has pitched to a 2.81 ERA (32 ER/102.2 IP) this season, the fifth-lowest ERA in the AL and the majors...At home, the bullpen has posted a 3.39 ERA (22 ER/58.1 IP) compared to a 2.03 ERA (10 ER/44.1 IP) on the road.

- (9 ER/54.1 In the last 13 games (since 4/16) the O's bullpen has worked to a 1.49 ERA IP), the second-lowest ERA in the majors during this stretch (SEA - 1.14).
- The O's bullpen has posted a combined 2.3 wins above average, according to Baseball-Reference, the highest in the majors.
- Ox LHP Paul Fry has appeared in a team-high 12 games...The 12 games are tied for the most by a left-handed pitcher in the AL...Fry has not allowed a run since his 2021 debut on 4/5 at NYY (11 games - 9.2 IP, 3 H, 4 BB, 15 K); the 11-straight games without allowing a run is tied for the second-longest active streak in the AL.
- RHP César Valdez is tied for the AL lead in saves with six (6-for-8).
- RHP Adam Plutko has worked 15.0 innings in relief, posting a 1.20 ERA (2 ER/15.0 IP)...His innings out of the bullpen are tied for the sixth-most in the AL.

TAKING ON THE ATHLETICS: The O's snapped their seven-game losing streak at Oakland Coliseum last night...The two teams have split their first four match ups this season...The season series will wrap up on Sunday.

- The O's have out-hit the A's in all four games this season, holding A's batters to a combined .183 batting average.
- OF Cedric Mullins is batting .389 (7-for-18) in the four games against the A's.
- OF Austin Hays has hit three home runs and is batting .313 (5-for-16) against the A's.

- Ox INF/OF Trey Mancini leads the O's with 11 barrels, tied for the seventh-most in the AL and tied for the 10th-most in the majors; Mancini has 23.4% of the O's barrels (11-of-47).
- INF Maikel Franco and Mancini lead the O's with six batted balls at 110+ MPH each.
- O's pitchers have allowed the sixth-highest opponents exit velocity average in the majors (89.7 MPH), while O's batters have the seventh-lowest average exit velocity in the majors (88.4 MPH).
- Orioles pitchers have allowed 59 barrels to opponents, the fourth-most in the AL, while Orioles batters have recorded 47 barrels, tied for the third-fewest in the AL

STRONG DEFENSIVELY: The Orioles outfield has combined for five defensive runs saved (LF - 0, CF - 1, RF - 4), according to Baseball Info Solutions, tied for the fifth-most in the majors. Individually, Austin Hays has accounted for 3 DRS in LF, tied for the most in the majors, and Anthony Santander has accounted for 4 DRS in RF, tied for the second-most in the majors.

- The O's as a team have recorded five outfield assists, tied for the fifth-most in baseball.
- The O's have committed 12 errors, tied for the third-fewest in the AL and have posted a .987 fielding percentage, the fourth-best in the American League.
- Ox C Chance Sisco has thrown out 4-of-5 attempted base stealers, the most catcher caught stealing in the AL and the second-most in the majors (Narváez, MIL).

HIT TO KNOW CEDRIC: OF Cedric Mullins is tied for the Major League lead with 34 hits...He's hit safely in 20 of his 25 starts...He's batted lead off in all of his starts, batting .400 (10-for-25) in the first inning of these games; his 10 hits are the second-most in the majors (Buxton, MIN - 11).

- 🚱 His 16 hits (16-for-37 .432) against left-handed pitching are the most in the majors; entering this season, Mullins had 14 career hits against left-handed pitching (14-for-95), all coming while batting right-handed.
- he's batting .449 (22-for-49) in the Orioles 12 wins, hitting safely in 11 of the 12, and .231 (12-for-52) in the Orioles 14 losses.

QUICK HITS: Making his 150th career start...Snapped an 11-game winless-streak (7/18/19-4/15/21 G1) on 4/20 at MIA; the streak was just three games shy of his career-long stretch without a win (14 games, 9/13/17-5/16/18)...His contract was selected by the Orioles on 3/25/21.

LAST START: Earned his second win of the season in as many games on 4/26 vs. New York-AL...Tossed 6.0 innings of one-run ball, giving up just three hits and three walks with five strikeouts in the quality start...He last allowed one run or fewer (min. 5.0 IP) on 7/13/19 vs. Seattle (5.2 IP)...He last allowed more than one free pass on 8/25/20 at St. Louis (2 BB).

THE DARK KNIGHT RISES: Won back-to-back contests for the first time since winning four games over five starts from 6/21/18-7/13/18... His win during his last outing was his first quality start since 4/28/19 at Kansas City (7.0 IP, R)...Across his last two starts Harvey has pitched to a 3.27 ERÀ (4 ER/11.0 IP) with three walks and nine strikeouts, and has not given up a home run.

<u>CAREER VS. OAKLAND:</u> Facing the Athletics for the first time since 3/29/19, his only career start against the A's came while with Los Angeles-AL...Did not factor in the decision, allowing two runs on four hits (one home run) and three walks with just one strikeout...Held batters to a .190 opponents' average.

AGAINST THE AL WEST: Is 1-5 with a 8.44 ERA (35 ER/37.1), 16 walks, and 20 strikeouts in eight career starts against the American League West...Aside from one start on 9/2/17 at Houston, six of his appearances against the AL West came in 2019...Made just one start against Seattle this season, allowing two runs on three hits (one home run), one walk, and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of the no decision.

800 KLUB: Harvey has 793-career strikeouts, seven shy of the 800 mark...He last recorded seven-or-more punchouts in a game on 9/8/18 vs. San Diego, while with Cincinnati, and has averaged about four strikeouts per game in 2021...Tonight's contest is the 158th game of Harvey's career...If he accomplishes the feat over the course of his next two contests, he will become the 96th pitcher in MLB history to record 800 strikeouts in 159 games or fewer, or the 92nd pitcher in 158 games or fewer

I WALK A LONELY ROAD: Walked just three batters through his first four starts before allowing three free passes in his fifth outing on 4/26 vs. New York-AL...His 2.13 BB/9 is the 10-lowest among all American League starters (min. 5 starts)...According to Baseball Savant, Harvey's 5.5 walk percentage ranks in the 79th percentile among all Major League pitchers.

2020 HIGHLIGHTS: Made seven appearances (four starts) with Kansas City after signing a minor league deal with the Royals...Posted a 0-3 record with an 11.57 ERA (15 ER/11.2 IP), five walks, and 10 strikeouts...Harvey made three relief appearances, including his first since 5/8/18 vs. Atlanta (with NYM), after making just five relief appearances from 2012-19...As a starter, he allowed 13 runs on 20 hits — five of which were home runs — in 9.1 IP; nine of the 15 runs he allowed came via home runs.
