LEADING OFF: Today, the Angels play the seventh (2-4) of 10 games on a homestand against the Cleveland Indians (1-3), Minnesota Twins (1-1 doubleheader split), Oakland Athletics (0-1; May 21-23) and Texas Rangers (May 25-26)...Angels went 2-4 on last road trip to Houston (1-2) and Boston (1-2), earning their victories in the first and last games of the trip... LAA was 2-5 on last homestand against the Tampa Bay Rays (0-4) and Los Angeles Dodgers (1-1).

WELCOME BACK FANS! Yesterday, the Angels announced Angel Stadium will return to full capacity beginning June 17 vs. Detroit...Single game tickets for all remaining regular season home games will go on sale to the general public on Friday, May 28th at 9:00 a.m. PT...Registered users on Angels.com will have access to a special presale beginning Thursday, May 27th at 9:00 a.m...Beginning on June 17th, in accordance with the updated California and MLB health guidelines, guests will be required to wear a mask unless they are prepared to provide proof of full vaccination or a recent negative Covid test...A complete listing of protocols and stadium policy information is available at angels.com/protocols.

RO SHOW: Last night, **Jose Rojas** registered his first two career outfield assists...He was the first Angels outfielder with multiple assists in a game since Justin Upton on April 18, 2018 vs. Boston...Rojas also has hit 11 doubles, which is tied for the most in Angels history after 32 career games (also, **Howie Kendrick** and **John Doherty**).

ROSTER MOVES: Today the Angels reinstated RHP **Junior Guerra** from the injured list...Following last night's game, LHP **Dillon Peters** was optioned to Triple-A Salt Lake...Thursday, the Angels reinstated RHP **Alex Cobb** from the injured list.

WINS AND LOSSES: Angels have fallen to a season-low seven games under .500 (19-26)...LAA stayed at or above .500 through their first 18 games of a season for the first time since 2005, but have been under .500 since May 3.

FOUR SCORE: Angels are 18-8 when scoring 4+ runs this season and are 1-18 when scoring three-or-fewer...Since the start of May, Angels have reached the four run threshold in nine of 20 games (6-3 in those contests).

LEAGUE LEADERS:

Shohei Ohtani is tied for the Major League home run lead (14) with Ronald Acuña Jr...Leads Majors in extra-base hits (26) and ranks tied for third in total bases (99)...He's also tied for seventh in runs scored (32) and is eighth in the Majors in slugging (.604) and RBI (33).

Jared Walsh ranks seventh in the American League in OPS (.967) and hits (50), is eighth in batting average (.327), ninth in slugging (.575) and is 10th in RBI (32).

THAT'S RIGHT: Angels have recorded 15 of their 19 wins this season in games against a right-handed starting pitcher...Halos are 4-10 this season when the opposing primary pitcher is left-handed (4-7 vs. left-handed starters; plus **three** games where left-handed primary pitcher followed a right-handed starter).

GLOVE HURTS: Angels have made a Major League leading 37 errors this season, but have gone errorless in nine of last 12 games...Halos are 4-15 when committing an error in 2021...LAA has had five games this season with 3+ errors (most in Majors)...Halos committed 36 errors during 60-game 2020 season.

TROUT TO THE IL: Tuesday, the Angels placed OF **Mike Trout** on the injured list with a right calf strain...An estimated return to play is 6-8 weeks...At the time of his IL placement, he led the Majors in OBP (.466) and OPS (1.090) and ranked fourth (led A.L.) in slugging percentage (.624).

VS. OAKLAND: Today's game marks the second (0-1) of 19 meetings this season between the Angels and A's (10 at Angel Stadium & nine at the Coliseum)...Last season, Oakland won the season series 6-4, marking second straight year Angels lost season series vs. A's.

AGAINST THE A's: In 34 career games against the A's, **David Fletcher** is batting .311 (38/122) with seven doubles, one home run and 10 RBI...**Shohei Ohtani** has hit eight career home runs against the A's, which is tied for his most against any opponent (also has 8 HR vs. Texas)...**Anthony Rendon** is a .314 (16/51) hitter vs. Oakland with one double, four home runs and eight RBI.

HEY BABE: **Shohei Ohtani** is the first player to make multiple pitching starts in a season while also leading MLB in home runs since Boston's **Babe Ruth** in 1919...Three of Ohtani's pitching starts this year have come while he held at least a share of the Major League home run lead.

MORE SHOHEI STUFF: Last Tuesday, **Shohei Ohtani** tallied 10 strikeouts at Houston in 7 IP before finishing the game in right field...He became the third player since 1900 to record 10+ strikeouts and also play the field in the same game, joining St. Louis' **Harvey Haddix** (Sept. 28, 1952 vs. Cubs; 11 SO & played RF) and Cleveland's **Sam McDowell** (July 6, 1970 vs. Senators; 15 SO & played 2B)...Ohtani was only player to finish game at the new position. (ELIAS)

MAKE IT MAJOR: **Mike Trout** is one of six Major League players featured in large photos outside of Major League Baseball's new headquarters in New York City...The building is located directly across the street from Radio City Music Hall.

RANGERS ON DECK: Following the current series with the A's and an off day on Monday, the Angels will conclude the homestand with a pair of games against the Texas Rangers...The 2021 season series is tied 3-3...Rangers won two of three games at Angel Stadium from April 19-21 and Angels won two of three games at Globe Life Field from April 26-28.

THIS DATE IN ANGELS HISTORY

May 22

(2013) Mike Trout becomes the youngest player in American League history to hit for the cycle (21 years, 288 days)...He becomes the sixth Angel to pull off the cycle, 7th total cycle in team history (Jim Fregosi did it twice); (1992) The Angels team bus traveling from New York to Baltimore crashed on the New Jersey Turnpike. 12 members of the team were injured. Manager Buck Rodgers suffered the most severe of the injuries as he was hospitalized and missed the next two months of the season.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER - LHP PATRICK SANDOVAL

0-0, 5.56 ERA

Pitching to a 2.89 ERA (9.1 IP - 3 ER) in three games (one start) at Angel Stadium this season

- TODAY'S GAME:** Making fifth appearance (second start) of the season for Angels and fourth home appearance of 2021...Recalled from Triple-A Salt Lake on May 3...Is in third Major League season with LAA.
- LAST TIME OUT:** Did not factor in decision in first start of the year on Monday vs. Cleveland after tossing 4+ innings and allowing two earned runs on six hits with one walk and two strikeouts.
- THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME:** In career, has pitched to a 3.78 ERA (47.2 IP – 20 ER) at Angel Stadium, compared with a 7.26 ERA (39.2 IP – 32 ER) on the road.
- FIRST SAVE:** Earned first career save on May 7 vs. Dodgers after working final 3.1 innings of Angels 9-2 victory...Marked Angels first 10+ out save since Jerome Williams (4 IP) on July 30 at Texas and first at home since Chris Bootcheck (4 IP) on May 28, 2005 vs. Kansas City.
- IN THE WIN COLUMN:** Earned first Major League win on Sept. 23, 2020 at San Diego after tossing three scoreless innings in relief...The win came in his 18th career Major League appearance...His 70.1 career innings entering the game were the most in Angels history at the time of earning a first career win.
- SEEKING A WINNING START:** Is seeking first Major League victory as a starter...His 16 consecutive starts without a win to begin his Major League career is the longest streak in Angels history and also the longest to begin any Angels tenure; If he does not earn a victory today, a 17 start winless stretch would match the Angels record for any point in a career (Andy Hassler had 17 game streak in 1975-76)....*Angels Hall of Famer Dean Chance went winless through his first 10 career starts in 1961-1962, but would go on to win the A.L. Cy Young in 1964.*
- GOING OFFSPEED:** This season, opponents are hitting .243 (10/41) against his off-speed pitches...For his career, opponents are 39-for-197 (.198) vs. his off-speed pitches, including a .161 (10/62) average against his slider and .207 (19/92) mark vs. his change-up.
- VS. OAKLAND:** Tonight marks second career appearance vs. Athletics...Is 0-1 with a 2.70 ERA (3.1 IP - 1 ER) after only previous outing in start on Sept. 4, 2019 at the Coliseum.
- AT ANGEL STADIUM:** In 12 career games (eight starts) at The Big A, is 0-4 with a 3.78 ERA (47.2 IP - 20 ER)... This season is 0-0 with a 2.89 ERA (9.1 IP - 3 ER) after three games (one start)...Has allowed three-or-fewer runs in seven of eight home starts...Finest home performance came on Aug. 28, 2019 vs. Texas (5 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 9 SO).
- 2020 IN REVIEW:** Appeared in nine games (six starts) for Angels in 2020, going 1-5 with a 5.65 ERA (36.2 IP - 23 ER) and 33 strikeouts...Also spent time at Angels Alternate Training Site in Long Beach, CA.
- K COLLECTION:** Had 8+ strikeouts in two of his first five Major League outings...Only other pitchers to do that in Angels history are Bo Belinsky and Jered Weaver.
- DEBUT DAY:** Made MLB debut Aug. 5, 2019 at Cincinnati...His eight strikeouts were the second most in a Major League debut in Angels history (Rudy May had 10 SO on April 18, 1965 vs. Tigers)...The game was his first time entering game following an Opener in professional career...Tied Major League record for most strikeouts by a reliever in an MLB debut (Astros Joe Musgrove – Aug. 2, 2016 vs. TOR & Pirates Barry Jones – April 20, 1986 at Cubs)...Became second player in Angels history to make his Major League debut in a National League ballpark, joining Sean O'Sullivan (June 16, 2009 at SF).
- CAREER NOTES:** Originally drafted by Houston in 11th round of 2015 First-Year Player Draft out of Mission Viejo HS (CA), which is located just 20 miles from Angel Stadium...Acquired by Angels on July 26, 2018 in exchange for C Martin Maldonado.
