LEADING OFF: Today, the Angels play the third (0-2) of six games on a Bay Area road trip to Oakland (0-2; May 27-30) and San Francisco (May 31-June 1)...Angels went 5-5 on last homestand against the Cleveland Indians (1-3), Minnesota Twins (1-1 doubleheader split), Oakland Athletics (1-2) and Texas Rangers (2-0)...Angels went 2-4 on last road trip to Houston (1-2) and Boston (1-2), earning their victories in the first and last games of the trip.

WELCOME BACK FANS! Last Friday, the Angels announced Angel Stadium will return to full capacity beginning June 17 vs. Detroit...Single game tickets for all remaining regular season home games are now on sale to the general public... Beginning on June 17th, in accordance with the updated California and MLB health guidelines, guests will be required to wear a mask unless they are prepared to provide proof of full vaccination or a recent negative Covid test...A complete listing of protocols and stadium policy information is available at angels.com/protocols.

ROSTER MOVES: Today the Angels selected the contract of INF **Kean Wong**...In a corresponding move, C **Drew Butera** was designated for assignment following last night's game... Yesterday, the Angels recalled LHP **José Suarez** and C **Anthony Bemboom** from Triple-A Salt Lake...Additionally, INF **José Iglesias** was placed on the 10-day injured list with a left hamstring strain (retro to May 26).

REHAB ASSIGNMENT: Both C **Max Stassi** and RHP **Chris Rodriguez** are on a rehab assignment with Triple-A Salt Lake... Stassi went 2-for-3 with a double and one RBI last night and caught five innings in his second appearance with the Bees... Rodriguez worked a scoreless inning, allowing one walk in his start on the mound last night.

RO SHOW: **Jose Rojas** has hit 12 doubles this season, which is second most in Angels history after 38 career games; only **Howie Kendrick** (13) had more...Last Friday night vs. Oakland, Rojas registered his first two career outfield assists...He was the first Angels outfielder with multiple assists in a game since Justin Upton on April 18, 2018 vs. Boston.

WINS AND LOSSES: Angels have lost two straight following a three game win streak to conclude the last homestand...The three-game streak matched longest streak of season - also won three in a row April 3-5)...LAA is currently seven games under .500 (22-29) and look to avoid matching season-low eight games under .500 (19-27 on May 22).

FOUR SCORE: Angels are 21-8 when scoring 4+ runs this season and are 1-21 when scoring three-or-fewer.

LEAGUE LEADERS:

Shohei Ohtani is tied for the Major League lead in extra-base hits (29), is tied for third with 15 home runs, fourth with a .616 slugging percentage, tied for fourth with three triples, tied for fifth with 109 total bases and is tied for seventh with 38 RBI.

Jared Walsh ranks seventh in the American League in OPS (.931), eighth in batting average (.309), ninth in slugging (.560), 10th in RBI (37) and is tied for 10th in total bases (98).

THAT'S RIGHT: Angels have recorded 16 of their 22 wins this season in games against a right-handed starting pitcher... *Angels have won four of last five games vs. a left-handed starter after starting 2-7 against them*...Halos are 6-11 this season when the opposing primary pitcher is left-handed (6-8 vs. left-handed starters; plus three games where left-handed primary pitcher followed a right-handed starter).

LINEUP SHUFFLE: Angels have used six different players as the leadoff hitter across the last 16 games after **David Fletcher** served as leadoff man in each of first 35 games this season.

PARTY STARTER: Sunday, **Justin Upton** made his first career start from the leadoff spot in his 1,778th career Major League game...Upton hit leadoff home runs back-to-back days Tuesday and Wednesday, becoming the first LAA player to accomplish the feat since rookie Mike Trout on Sept. 8-9, 2012.

GLOVE HURTS: Angels have made a Major League leading 42 errors this season...Halos are 6-18 when committing an error in 2021...LAA has had five games this season with 3+ errors (most in Majors)...Halos committed 36 errors during 60-game 2020 season.

VS. OAKLAND: Today's game marks the sixth (1-4) of 19 meetings this season between the Angels and A's (10 at Angel Stadium & nine at the Coliseum)...Angels lost two of three meetings at Angel Stadium this past weekend.

AGAINST THE A'S: In 37 career games against the A's, **David Fletcher** is batting .321 (42/131) with seven doubles, one home run and 11 RBI...**Shohei Ohtani** has hit eight career home runs against the A's, which is his second most against any opponent (has 9 HR vs. Texas).

HOO-RAY GOOSE: Last week, **Phil Gosselin** earned his Bachelor's Degree in Economics from the University of Virginia.

DOWN ON THE FARM: Inland Empire's **Ryan Smith** was named the Low-A West Pitcher of the Week for May 17-23 after tossing six scoreless innings with 13 strikeouts in his May 21 start vs. Modesto...Salt Lake's **Packy Naughton** carried a no-hitter through 7.2 innings on Sunday at Las Vegas...**Jo Adell** is tied for the lead in all of Minor League Baseball with 10 home runs this season for Salt Lake.

TROUT TO THE IL: Last Tuesday, the Angels placed OF **Mike Trout** on the injured list with a right calf strain...An estimated return to play is 6-8 weeks...At the time of his IL placement, he led the Majors in OBP (.466) and OPS (1.090) and ranked fourth (led A.L.) in slugging percentage (.624).

ACROSS THE BAY: Following the current series in Oakland, the Angels will continue the road trip with a pair of games against the San Francisco Giants (May 31-June 1)...The Angels and Giants will meet a total of four times this season (teams will meet again June 22-23 at Angel Stadium following the upcoming weekend series in San Francisco)...Last season, the Giants won the season series 3-1; teams split a pair of games at Angel Stadium (Aug. 17-18, 2020) and Giants swept two game set at Oracle Park (Aug. 19-20, 2020).

Pitching to a 0.90 ERA (10 IP - 1 ER) across last two starts

- TODAY'S GAME:** Making seventh start of the season and fourth on the road...Is in 10th Major League season.
- BACK ON THE MOUND:** Today marks second start since being reinstated from the injured list...Missed 14 games on IL with a right middle finger blister...Made return in first game of May 20 doubleheader.
- TERRIBLE TWOS:** Has yielded seven of his 17 runs this season in the 2nd inning.
- LAST TIME OUT:** Earned the win in last start on May 20 at Angel Stadium in first game of doubleheader vs. Twins...Tossed 5.0 innings and allowed one earned run on four hits with no walks and four strikeouts.
- LEFT OUT:** Has held left-handers to a .200 average (9/45) this season.
- UNDER THREE:** Since start of 2020, has allowed three-or-fewer runs in 12 of last 16 starts...Has registered quality starts in three of last eight starts.
- TURN THE PAGE:** Owns a 3.58 career ERA in month of May (156 IP - 62 ER), compared with a 5.39 (123.2 IP - 74 ER) mark in March/April.
- VS. OAKLAND:** In 10 career starts vs. Athletics, is 4-3 with a 2.18 ERA (62 IP - 15 ER) and 50 strikeouts... The 2.18 ERA is his lowest against any A.L. opponent...Is making first start vs. A's since Sept. 11, 2018 for Baltimore at Camden Yards...Seeking first win vs. Oakland since June 9, 2017 with Rays at Tropicana Field.
- AT OAKLAND COLISEUM:** In four career games at the Coliseum, is 1-2 with a 2.03 ERA (26.2 IP - 6 ER) and 22 strikeouts...Today's game is first appearance in Oakland since May 6, 2018 for Baltimore...Earned only win at the ballpark on Aug. 1, 2012 for Tampa Bay.
- 10 K:** Talled eighth career 10+ strikeout game on April 12 at KC and first since July 29, 2014 for Rays vs. MIL.
- A NEW ANGEL:** Acquired by Angels from Baltimore on Feb. 2, 2021 in exchange for INF Jahmai Jones.
- REUNITED:** Cobb reunited with his first Major League manager, Joe Maddon...Made 81 starts for Tampa Bay between 2011-14 under Maddon, and went 35-23 with a 3.21 ERA (498.2 IP - 178 ER) and 426 strikeouts.
- 2020 RECAP:** Made 10 starts for Orioles in 2020, going 2-5 with a 4.30 ERA (52.1 IP - 25 ER) and 38 strikeouts... Led Orioles pitching staff in innings pitched, tied for the Club lead with 10 starts and ranked second in strikeouts...Went 1-1 with a 2.61 ERA (19.2 IP - 6 ER) across his first four starts.
- A TRUE PRO:** Awarded 2017 Paul C. Smith Champion Award by the Tampa Bay Chapter of the BBWAA, given to the Rays player who best exemplifies the spirit of true professionalism on and off the field.
- CAREER NOTES:** Originally selected by Tampa Bay in fourth round of 2006 First-Year Player Draft out of Vero Beach HS (Vero Beach, FL)...Made Major League debut with Tampa Bay on May 1, 2011 vs. Angels at Tropicana Field...Pitched with Rays from 2011-17 before signing as a free agent with Baltimore before the 2018 season.
