TODAY'S GAME: The Giants continue their quick three-game series with the A's tonight here at Oracle Park after taking last night's opener...the Giants enter today having won nine of their last 10 games and 21 of their last 28 contests.

BEST IN SHOW: The Giants enter today's game with the best overall winning percentage in the Majors at 49-26 (.653)...the .653 winning percentage through 75 games is tied for the second-best in the SF-era (1958-pres.) behind only the 1993 Giants (50-25, .667)...the 1971 Giants were also 49-26 after 75 games.

JUMPMAN: The Giants enter today's game 23 games over .500...the last time SF was 23 games over .500 was July 15, 2016 following a loss to the Padres in San Diego in the first game after the All-Star break that dropped SF to 57-33...the last time SF was 24 games over .500 was July 10, 2016 after defeating Arizona, 4-0 on the last day before the All-Star break.

GIANTS IN JUNE: SF is 15-6 (.714) this month, the second-best record in the Majors behind the Astros (18-4, .818).

BATTLE OF THE BAY: The Giants and A's meet for the first of their two series in 2021 this weekend...SF went 1-5 against Oakland last season and are just 4-9 in their last 13 games at Oracle Park vs the Athletics...the Giants have not won a series at home vs. the A's since sweeping them in a three-game set in 2015...since 2016, the Giants have only won one series vs. the A's home or away and that came when the Giants swept a brief two-game set in Oakland in 2019.

HOME ON THE RANGE: SF improved to 25-10 (.714) at Oracle Park with last night's win over Oakland...since being swept by the Dodgers here May 21-23, the Giants have gone 11-3 in their last 14 home games...the Giants .714 overall home winning percentage is best in the Majors entering play today.

LEAD STORY: IF Brandon Crawford leads the Giants in home runs (16), RBI (50), walks (28, tied with **Brandon Belt** and **Mike Yastrzemski**) and runs (40)...according to *Stats, LLC*, Crawford is one of five players in the Majors leading his team in home runs, RBI, runs and walks and the only one of those five to play in the NL...Crawford enters today's game with 614 career RBI, one behind **IF JT Snow** (615) for ninth-most in SF-era history.

FILL IN THE BLANKS: SF recorded its 11th shutout of the season yesterday, most in the Majors...the White Sox, Dodgers, Yankees and Cardinals are all tied for second-most with eight...the Giants did not have a single shutout in last year's 60-game season...the 11 shutouts by the Giants staff this year are most since they held the opponent scoreless in 15 games in 2018...the most such games in the SF-era in a single season is 20, back in 1968.

KEEP IN ROLLING: The Giants have either won or split their last nine series dating to May 25, tied for the second-longest streak in the Majors this year...only the Yankees (10 straight) have had a longer streak this year.

IT. IS. OUTTA. HERE.: C Curt Casali homered for SF last night, giving the Giants 112 on the season, most in MLB...the team's 112 homers through 75 games are third-most in club history through 75 games behind the 2000 Giants (115) and the 1947 Giants (113).

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHING MATCHUP

LHP Alex Wood starts for San Francisco in the middle game of this series and is aiming to bounce back from a tough last outing on Saturday vs. Philadelphia...Wood allowed six runs (four earned) in 3.0 innings in SF's 13-6 loss here at Oracle...Wood has a 7.88 ERA (21er, 24.0ip) in his last five starts dating to May 27...in three career starts vs. Oakland, Wood owns a 7.04 ERA (12er, 15.1ip).

RHP Frankie Montas makes his 16th start of the season for Oakland and is coming off one of his roughest outings of the year...last time out in Texas on Monday, Montas allowed a season-high eight runs on a season-high tying nine hits in the A's 8-3 loss to the Rangers...today's outing marks Montas' first career outing against the Giants and no one on the Giants active roster has ever faced Montas in their Major League career.

LAST TIME OUT: Logged his shortest outing of the season after lasting only 3.0 innings while allowing six runs (four earned) to the Phillies last Saturday at Oracle Park...it was only the ninth time in Wood's career (150 games started) that he's pitched 3.0 innings or fewer.

VS. OAKLAND: Faces the Athletics for the fourth time in his career and for the first time since 2018 with the Dodgers...in his three career starts vs. the A's, Wood is 1-2 with a 7.04 ERA (12er, 15.1ip)...his lone win against the A's came back in 2014 while he was pitching for Atlanta.

TOUGH GO: Over his last five starts, Wood has allowed 23 runs (21 earned) in 24.0 innings, compiling a 7.88 ERA while striking out 23 and walking 10...opposing batters are hitting .269 off Wood in that time...over his first seven starts, Wood fashioned a 1.93 ERA (9er, 42.0ip) with 42 strikeouts and a .217 batting average against.

FLIP THE SCRIPT: This month, Wood has increased his changeup usage while throwing fewer sliders...Wood's slider was a big part of his game in April (38.8%) and May (29.8%) but has been less so this month as he's only throwing it 20.9 percent of the time...his changeup usage has gone up each month since the season began: April (20.4%), May (23.0%) and June (29.0%).

FIRST TAKES: Opposing batters are hitting .160 (16x100) with three XBH off Wood the first time through the order with a .452 OPS...the second time through, however, those numbers jump up to a .295 BAA (28x95) with 13 XBH and a .922 OPS.

INNING BREAKDOWNS: In line with the above, Wood owns a 1.13 ERA (3er, 24.0ip) with a 4.17 K/BB (25 K, 6 BB) ratio in innings 1-2 this year...from the 3rd inning on, Wood has a 5.79 ERA (27er, 42.0ip) and a 2.67 K/BB ratio (40 K / 15 BB)

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider, Sinker, Cutter
Last Game: 6/19 vs. PHI; 1.0ip, 1h, 2 so (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in eight of his last nine appearances dating to May 23...has posted a 1.69 ERA in that span (2er, 10.2ip).
- ▶ Left-handers are 2-for-their-last-18 (.111) off him...overall, LHH are 11-for-42 (.262), while RHH are 13-for-53 (.245) off him.

#59 JOHN BREBBIA ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-seam FB, Slider, Changeup
Last Game: 6/23 at LAA; 1.0ip, 1bb, 1so (5 pitches)

- ▶ Has made two appearances since being reinstated from the 60-day IL on June 20th (2.0ip, 0h, 1bb, 1so).
- ▶ Began the year on the 60-day IL after recovering from Tommy John surgery on June 1 of last year.
- ▶ Made eight appearances (two starts) with Sacramento on a rehab assignment...was 1-0 with a 3.86 ERA and 11 strikeouts in 7.0 IP.
- ▶ In three seasons with St. Louis from 2017-2019 Brebbia was 6-7 with a 3.14 ERA (61er, 175.0ip) and 198 strikeouts in 161 games.
- ▶ Signed by SF to a Major League contract on December 21.

#66 JARLÍN GARCÍA ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Changeup, Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 6/23 at LAA; 1.0ip, 0h, 1r, 0er, 1so (12 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 1.46 ERA (2er, 12.1ip) with 14 strikeouts in his last 11 outings.
- ▶ Has held lefties to one hit in their last 19 ABs dating to May 22.
- ▶ Hitters are just 3-for-28 (.107) with 11Ks off his slider this season.

#52 DOMINIC LEONE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Four-Seam FB, Sinker
Last Game: 6/23 at LAA; SV, 1.0ip, 2h, 1r, 0er, 1so (15 pitches)

- ▶ Has not allowed a run in nine of his 11 games overall with SF since being recalled.
- ▶ Batters are just 7-for-41 (.171) off him.
- ▶ LHH have just one hit in 17 ABs off him.
- ▶ Batters are hitless with eight strikeouts in 14 at-bats off his slider.
- ▶ Selected from Triple-A Sacramento on June 1 and has appeared in 11 games with SF...has a 1.54 ERA (3er, 11.2ip) with three walks and 14 strikeouts overall.

#56 ZACK LITTELL ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-seam FB, Slider, Splitfinger
Last Game: 6/23 vs LAA; 1.0ip, 2bb, 1so (19 pitches)

- ▶ Has allowed five runs on six hits over his last five games...had allowed a combined four runs in 20 games (18.1ip) prior to that.
- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in 20 of 25 outings.
- ▶ Opponents are 4-for-27 off him with RISP.
- ▶ Has used his four-seam fastball 52.7% of the time...opponents are 8-for-37 (.216) with 12 strikeouts.

#17 JAKE MCGEE ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider
Last Game: 6/25 vs. OAK; SV, 1.0ip, 1so (9 pitches)

- ▶ Has a 1.47 ERA (3er, 18.1ip) with 19 Ks over his last 19 games.
- ▶ Posted a 0.63 ERA and is 11-for-11 in save chances in 15 games at home, compared to a 5.29 ERA and 4-for-6 in save chances on the road.
- ▶ Opponents are hitting .350 (7-for-20) off him with RISP.
- ▶ Before he takes the mound he looks at the inside his hat where he has written inside: "Feel the ball. Take a Breath. Pound the zone." Plus the names of his wife, Morgan, and daughter, Rowen.

#71 TYLER ROGERS ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Sinker, Slider
Last Game: 6/25 vs. OAK; 1.0ip, 1h, 2so (16 pitches)

- ▶ Has seven saves in his last 17 games.
- ▶ After allowing six runs over four games from May 28-June 9, Rogers has not allowed a run in his last six appearances dating to June 12 (6.0ip, 4h, 6so).
- ▶ Left-handers are just 7-for-63 (.111) off him with no extra base hits.
- ▶ His 36 appearances are tied for the third-most in the Majors.
- ▶ Is 9-for-13 in save opportunities overall.
