TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue their final homestand of the 2021 regular season with the 2nd of 3 games against the Oakland Athletics (1-0)...will also welcome the Los Angeles Angels to T-Mobile Park (3 G, 10/1-10/3)...are coming off an 8-2 road trip against Kansas City (2-1), Oakland (4-0) and Los Angeles-AL (2-1)...tonight's game will be televised on **ROOT SPORTS NW**, as well as broadcast on **710 ESPN** and the **Mariners Radio Network**.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners defeated the Athletics last night by a 13-4 score...have won 8 of their last 9 games and 9 of their last 11...are 17-8 over their last 25 games, 24-14 over their last 38, 28-15 over their last 43, 31-21 over their last 52, 36-24 over their last 60, 42-28 over their last 70, 53-34 over their last 87, 56-35 over their last 91 and 66-44 over their last 110...are 33-22 in day games and 54-48 at night...are 43-33 at T-Mobile Park and 44-37 on the road...are 71-25 when scoring at least 4 runs and 16-45 when scoring 3 or fewer runs...are 58-9 when out-hitting their opponent.

- **Debuts** - RHP **Matt Brash** was selected from Triple-A Tacoma today...when he debuts will become the 11th Mariners player to make Major League debut this season and 63rd Mariners player overall.
- **Joy Division** - Seattle is 44-27 (.620) against the American League West Division this season.
- **Series Record** - The Mariners own an 18-9-2 series record since June 14, winning or splitting 20 of their last 29...the Mariners own a 26-19-5 record in 50 series this season.
- **The Comebacks** - The Mariners last night earned their 39th comeback victory of the season.
- **1-Run Games** - Seattle is 33-18 (.647) in 1-run games, leading MLB with 33 one-run victories.

SEVENTEEN AGAIN...the Mariners (87-70) are a season-high 17 games above .500...they are 17 games above for the first time since Aug. 26, 2018 when they were 74-57...with a win tonight, the Mariners would be 18 games above .500 for the first time since Aug. 25, 2018 when they were 74-56.

'A' PLUS...the Mariners have won 10 consecutive games against the Athletics since July 23, tying the franchise record for most consecutive wins against a single opponent...the Mariners also defeated the Kansas City Royals in 10 straight games from June 14-Sept. 24, 1985 and the Baltimore Orioles in 10 straight games from June 22, 2000-May 31, 2001.

OFFENSIVE FIREPOWER...Seattle scored a season-high 13 runs last night in the 13-4 win and their most runs in a game since June 23, 2019 in a 13-3 win vs. Baltimore...the Mariners recorded 14 hits, tied for their 2nd-most in a game this season...Seattle had 5 players register a multi-hit game, tied for their 2nd-most this season and trailing only June 25 at Chicago-AL when 6 players registered at least 2 hits.

MULTI-HOMER MITCH...Mitch Haniger hit 2 three-run home runs in last night's win, recording a career-high 6 RBI in the process...Mitch also has a career-high 94 RBI on the season, surpassing the 93 RBI he had in 2018...it was Haniger's 6th career multi-homer game and 4th this season, becoming the first Mariners player with 4+ multi-homer games in a season since Nelson Cruz tallied 4 in 2018...it was the Mariners 10th individual multi-homer performance of the season...Haniger now has 99 career home runs.

FIVE FOUR FRANCE...Ty France reached base safely 5 times last night, going 4-for-4 with 3 runs scored, his 30th double of the season, tying a career-high 4 RBI and 1 walk...he is batting .295 (163x553) with 81 runs, 30 doubles, 1 triple, 18 home runs, 72 RBI and 43 walks this season...since the All-Star Break, he is batting .332 (86x259) with 42 runs, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 10 home runs, 35 RBI and 17 walks, with his 86 hits leading the American League since the break...he ranks 2nd in the Majors with 26 hit-by-pitches...he is rated by *FanGraphs* as the **best defensive first baseman in the Majors** (min. 800 innings at first base).

J.P. THE CATALYST...J.P. Crawford went 3-for-5 with 3 runs scored and an RBI last night...he's reached base safely in 6 of 10 plate appearances over his last 2 games...in 26 games since August 30, he is batting .321 (35x109) with 22 runs, 7 doubles, 3 home runs, 14 RBI and 13 walks, getting on-base at a .390 clip, slugging .468 with an .858 OPS.

KELENIC IN SEPTEMBER...Jarred Kelenic reached base 3 times last night, going 2-for-3 with 2 runs scored and a walk...in 24 September games, he is batting .250 (22x88) with 17 runs, 4 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 16 RBI and 10 walks, getting on-base at a .327 clip, slugging .557 with an .883 OPS...among **American League rookies in the month**, he ranks 1st in runs (17), 1st in home runs (7), 1st in total bases (49) and T1st in RBI (16) with Bobby Dalbec-BOS.

LT...Luis Torrens went 2-for-5 with 2 RBI last night...in 74 games since being recalled from Triple-A Tacoma on June 15, Torrens is batting .264 (62x235) with 29 runs, 10 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 41 RBI and 24 walks, getting on-base at a .330 clip, slugging .481 with an .810 OPS.

SADLER TIES TEAM RECORD...Casey Sadler has not allowed a run over his last 25 appearances since July 27, tying Shigetoshi Hasegawa's franchise record 25-game scoreless streak (6/3-8/17/2003)...it's also the 3rd-longest streak in the Majors this season, trailing Andrew Chafin-CHC (26 G, 5/8-7/21) and Josh Taylor-BOS (26 G, 4/30-7/5)...Sadler's streak has spanned 23.2 innings, walking 4 and striking out 18 during the streak...opponents are batting just .132 (10x76) against him in that stretch...on the season, Sadler's 0.74 ERA is lowest in the Majors among pitchers with at least 30.0 innings pitched this season.

DOMINATING THE ZONE...the Mariners pitching staff has the 2nd-lowest walks-per-9 innings ratio (2.67) in the American League since Aug. 1, trailing only Tampa Bay (2.65)...Seattle pitchers have surrendered 140 walks in that span, 3rd-fewest in the AL behind Tampa Bay (135) and Oakland (138)...Mariners starters have allowed 4 or fewer runs in 14 of their last 15 outings and 3 or fewer in 12 of their last 15.

WINNING MONTHS...the Mariners are 16-8 in 24 September games and have clinched their 4th consecutive winning month...the Mariners went 14-12 (.538) in June, 14-10 (.583) in July and 15-13 (.536) in August...Seattle last recorded 4 consecutive winning months from June-Sept. 2009...this season, the Mariners have put together a winning record in 5 of 6 months, going 15-12 (.556) in April and 13-15 (.464) in May...the Mariners have put together a winning record in 6 of their last 7 months, going 12-11 (.522) in Sept. 2020.

WHERE WE'RE GOING...the Mariners went 19-6 (.760) over their final 25 road games this season...the .760 winning percentage since Aug. 8 ranks best in the AL and 3rd-best in MLB to San Francisco (.818, 18-4) and St. Louis (.815, 22-5)...the 19-6 record is the Mariners best 25-game stretch on the road since going 19-6 over 25 road games from May 16-July 3, 2003...the Mariners have won 6 of their last 8 road series.

AS YOU KNOW...Mitch Haniger hit his 36th and 37th home runs of the season last night...his 37 homers are 7th-most in the American League, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...that Haniger's 37 home runs in a season are 3rd-most all-time for a player who did not appear in a game in any professional league the previous year?...Haniger trails only Hall of Famer Willie Mays, who hit 41 home runs in 1954 after missing the 1953 season serving in the Korean War for the U.S. Army, and Hall of Famer Ted Williams, who hit 38 home runs in 1946 after missing the 1943-45 seasons serving in World War II for the U.S. Navy and the U.S. Marine Corps...statistic via Stats by STATS.

ABOUT ANDERSON...

- 31-year-old left-hander is making his 112th career start (116th appearance), his 30th start of 2021 (12th with Seattle) and 2nd start against the Athletics this season.
- Acquired by the Mariners from PIT July 28 in exchange for minor leaguers Carter Bins (c) and Joaquin Tejada (rhp).
- Originally drafted by MIN in the 50th round of the 2008 MLB Draft but did not sign...selected 3 years later (2011) by COL in the 1st round (20th overall) out of the Univ. of Oregon.
- Made his Major League debut June 12, 2016 vs. SD, tossing 6.1 innings and allowing 1 run on 6 hits; 0 walks & 6 SO.
- Played 3 collegiate seasons at Oregon where he went 17-17 with a 3.60 ERA (117 ER, 292.1 IP) with 107 walks and 285 strikeouts in 47 career appearances (46 starts)...set UO records in single-game strikeouts (14), single-season innings pitched (107.2), single-season strikeouts (114), career starts (46) and career strikeouts (285).
- Has appeared in parts of 6 Major League seasons with Colorado (2016-19), San Francisco (2020), Pittsburgh (2021) and Seattle (2021).

LAST OUTING...L #2 on 9/25 at Los Angeles...allowed 9 runs on 9 hits and 1 walk in just 2.0+ innings of work.

VS. OAKLAND...is 2-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1 ER, 12.2 IP) with 4 walks and 11 strikeouts in 2 career appearances vs. the A's...has made 1 start against the A's this season (Sept. 20 at OAK), earning the win with 7.0 IP of 1-run ball, while striking out 7 and walking 1.

GIMME FIVE...pitched at least 5.0 innings in each of his first 25 starts this season and each of his previous 27 starts dating back to Sept. 20, 2020...his 25-game streak of 5.0+ IP is the 2nd-longest in the Majors this season, trailing only Walker Buehler (27 GS) while ranking ahead of rankie Montas (24 GS).

FIRST 10 IN SEATTLE...allowed 3 runs or less in 9 of 10 starts with the Mariners and 2 or less in 6 of 10 starts...pitched to a 3.38 ERA (21 ER, 56.0 IP)...the Mariners were 6-4 in Anderson's first 10 games.

VALUE...has tallied 2.2 WAR (0.9 since joining the Mariners) (*Fangraphs*) this season ranking for 2nd-most among all Mariners pitchers...he trails only **Chris Flexen** (3.1) while tied with Logan Gilbert (2.2) and ranking ahead of **Paul Sewald** (1.5), **Drew Steckenrider** (1.2), and **Yusei Kikuchi** (1.1).

WELCOME TO SEATTLE...Acquired by Mariners from Pittsburgh July 28 in exchange for minor leaguers Carter Bins (c) and Joaquin Tejada (rhp).

SEE YA STEEL CITY...ND in his last outing with Pittsburgh July 20 vs. Arizona...tossed 6.0 innings and allowed 3 runs on 7 hits with 1 walk and 6 strikeouts, using only 77 pitches (56 strikes)...start marked the 100th of his career.

JULY GUY...holds a career record of 6-2 with a 3.02 ERA (31 ER, 92.1 IP) with 26 walks and 73 strikeouts in the month of July...the 3.02 ERA is his lowest in any month during his career, ranking ahead of his 3.09 ERA in September...in 4 starts in July this season, was 2-0 with a 3.09 ERA (8 ER, 23.1 IP) with 3 walks and 17 strikeouts.

PIRATE'S LIFE...made 18 starts with the Pirates in 2021 before being acquired by the Mariners at the trade deadline...with Pittsburgh, went 5-8 with a 4.35 ERA (50 ER, 103.1 IP) with 25 walks and 86 strikeouts...signed with the Pirates as a free agent on Feb. 17.

SNAKE CHARMER...went the distance pitching for the Giants in a 5-1 win over the Diamondbacks on Aug. 22, 2020 to record his first career complete game...tossed 9.0 innings and allowed 1 run (unearned) on 3 hits with no walks and 4 strikeouts...also marked his first win of the 2020 season.

#100...made his 100th career start (104th appearance) on July 20, 2021 at Arizona with Pittsburgh.

#500...recorded his 500th career strikeout on August 5, against the Yankees when he got Gleyber Torres to strike out swining for the 1st out of the 4th inning.

POST-SEASON...made his first post-season start in Game #2 of the 2018 NLDS with the Rockies at Milwaukee...tossed 6.0 strong innings, surrendering only 1 run on 4 hits with 2 walks and 5 strikeouts...has made one other post-season appearance, tossing 1.0 inning in relief in the 2017 NLWC with Colorado at Arizona...overall, is 0-1 with a 3.86 ERA (3 ER, 7.0 IP) with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts in post-season play.

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTING PITCHER: RHP LOGAN GILBERT (6-5, 4.83)

24-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 24th career start tomorrow vs. Oakland and 4th against the Athletics this season...Seattle is 15-8 in his first 23 starts, including winning 11 consecutive from 5/25-7/30...ND in last start on 9/24 at LAA (5.1,5,4,4,3,4,HR)...W#6 on 9/19 at KC (7.0,3,1,1,1,5)...ND in Mariners 5-4 win against Boston on 9/13 matching career high in strikeouts (6.0,5,2,2,1,9, 1 HR)...went 4-0 with 2.66 ERA (14 ER, 47.1 IP) in 9 starts, 5/25-7/18...1st Major League win June 6 at LAA, tossing 5.0 innings and allowing only 1 run on 4 walks & 7 strikeouts...first quality start on May 31 vs. OAK (6.0,5,2,2,1,5,HB); left game with a 4-1 lead...ND in Mariners 4-3 win at OAK on May 25 (4.0,4,2,2,0,4,HB)...lost his **MLB debut** May 13 vs. CLE, allowing 4 ER, incl. 3 ER on pair of HR; K'd side in his final inning...**CAREER:** selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau...has appeared in parts of 2 Minor League seasons in the Mariners organization (2019 & 2021), going 11-5 with a 2.12 ERA (33 ER, 140 IP) with 33 walks and 170 strikeouts in 27 career starts...vs. **OAK** 0-0 with a 4.97 ERA (7 ER, 12.2 IP) in previous 3 starts against Oakland this season.
